2. SUMMAR: DIRECTOR OF AMERICAN UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL (AUH) MUNTHIR KUZAYLI, AND DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES FOR AMERICAN UNIVERSITY OF BEIRUT (AUB), GEORGE SAYEGH, CAME TO YARZE RESIDENCE TODAY, AUGUST 7, FOR DISCUSSION OF AUH/AUB PROBLEMS (TELEPHONES NOT WORKING). THEIR MAIN PURPOSE WAS TO ASK FOR HELP IN TWO SPECIFIC AREAS: (1) HOSPITAL NEEDS 400 CUBIC METERS OF WATER A DAY AND WILL HAVE TO CEASE OPERATIONS IF WEST BEIRUT WATER SUPPLY IS NOT TURNED ON, AND (2) HOSPITAL NEEDS MINIMUM 10,000 LITERS OF GAS OIL A DAY. THIS COULD BE DELIVERED BY ONE TANKER TRUCK. THEY ARE CONFIDENT THEY COULD GUARANTEE DELIVERY AND THAT THE PLD WILL NOT DIVERT. I TOLD KUSAYLI AND SAYEGH THAT AMBASSADOR HABIB, SENIOR OFFICIALS IN WASHINGTON AND OUR AMBASSADOR IN TEL AVIV WERE MAKING EXTENSIVE EFFORTS ON BEHALF OF AUB. WE HAD MADE A SPECIAL PLEA THAT A TRUCK OF GAS OIL A DAY BE ALLOWED IN UNDER SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS. FURTHERMORE, WE HOPED THE WATER PROBLEM WOULD BE SOLVED LATER TODAY, IF THE ISRAELIS, AS PROMISED, OPEN THE WATER MAIN. (NOTE: I UNDERSTAND NOW (2000 HOURS LOCAL) THAT LINE HAS BEEN OPENED.) I ALSO SAID WE WOULD STRESS TO THE ISRAELIS THE GREAT IMPORTANCE THAT THE USG AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ATTACH TO AUB/AUH AND ASK THEM TO SPARE THEM FROM PHYSICAL DAMAGE. THEY SHOULD MAKE THE SAME POINT TO THE PLD. THEY ASSURED ME THEY WERE MAKING POINT DAILY TO PLD. END SUMMARY.

3. CONDITIONS AT AUH: AUH IS NOW THE ONLY WEST BEIRUT HOSPITAL IN FULL OPERATION. IT HAS 400 EMPLOYEES OUT OF 450 THERE. THE AVERAGE DAILY CENSUS IS 300 OF WHICH ABOUT

200 ARE WAR CASUALTIES. WHEN SHELLING OR BOMBING IS GOING ON, LARGE NUMBERS OF PEOPLE TAKE REFUGE IN THE AUH BASEMENT AND SPREAD THROUGH THE BUILDING. KUZAYLI YESTERDAY SPUKE WITH PLO OFFICIALS AND FATAH HAS PROMISED TO KEEP REFUGEES/SQUATTERS OUT, SO THE HOSPITAL CAN OPERATE. PHYSICAL DAMAGE TO THE HOSPITAL HAS BEEN LIMITED, MOSTLY BROKEN GLASS. MORTAR SHELL STRIKE AROUND IT WHEN FIGHTING IS GOING ON AND OCCASIONALLY PIECES OF SHRAPNEL FLY INTO PATIENTS' ROOMS, THERE IS NO MAJOR DAMAGE AS YET. OF OTHER HOSPITALS IN BEIRUT, BARBIR HAD 30 PATIENTS BUT HAS BEEN SO HEAVILY DAMAGED THAT IT CANNOT HANDLE FULL PATIENT LOAD AND IS IN FACT DETERIORATING DAILY. MAQASSAD IS COMPLETELY OUT OF OPERATION, ALTHOUGH THERE ARE 12 PATIENTS STILL THERE (BARBIR AND MAQASSAD ARE LITERALLY ON THE FIRING LINE).

4. UTILITIES: THE POWER PLANT ON THE AUB CAMPUS FURNISHES POWER FOR BOTH THE UNIVERSITY AND THE HOSPITAL. POWER USAGE ON THE CAMPUS IS KEPT VERY LOW, SO THAT THE PLANT IS PRIMARILY FURNISHING POWER TO THE HOSPITAL. THE PLANT USES 10,000-12,000 LITERS OF GAS OIL A DAY. THERE IS A WATER TANK IN THE HOSPITAL THAT AS OF 1700 HOURS TODAY HAD A THREE DAY SUPPLY OF WATER. THERE IS ALSO A LARGE WATER RESERVOIR UNDER THE TENNIS COURTS ON THE MAIN CAMPUS. THIS WATER IS INCREASINGLY BRACKISH BUT IS MADE USEABLE (BUT NOT POTABLE) BY CHEMICAL TREATMENT. AUB SCIENTISTS ESTIMATE THAT BY AUGUST 15 THIS BRACKISH WATER WILL BE SO SALTY IT CAN NO LONGER BE TREATED. AS NOTED IN PARA 1, MINIMUM HOSPITAL NEED WOULD BE 400 CUBIC METERS. I QUESTIONED THEM VERY CAREFULLY WHETHER THE HOSPITAL WOULD BE TAKEN CARE OF IF THE ISRAELIS PERMIT WATER INTO WEST BEIRUT, EVEN IF THEY DO NOT PERMIT ELECTRICITY. BOTH MEN AFFIRMED THAT THIS WAS SO, AS LONG AS THEY HAVE FUEL FOR THE AUB/AUH POWER PLANT. I TOLD THEM THAT THE ISRAELIS HAD PROMISED WATER AND THAT WE WOULD KEEP AFTER THEM ON THE SUBJECT.

5. MEDICINES AND OXYGEN: AUH IS IN GOOD SHAPE ON MEDICINES AS THE

ISRAELIS HAVE GENERALLY ALLOWED SUPPLIES THROUGH. WITH THE RECENT EIGHT TRUCK DELIVERY, THERE IS NO CURRENT PROBLEM. THE ISRAELIS HAVE ALSO ALLOWED DELIVERIES OF OXYGEN CYLINDERS FROM EAST BEIRUT TO TAKE CARE OF MINIMUM NEEDS (THIS IS IN CONTRAST TO ICRC REPORT).

6. OUTSIDERS ON CAMPUS: AT ANY ONE TIME THERE ARE ABOUT 100 "ARMED ELEMENTS", MOSTLY FATAH, ON CAMPUS. THERE ARE NO HEAVY WEAPONS, ANTI-AIRCRAFT, ETC. TODAY THE HEALTH COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL MOVEMENT PUT SOME CONVALESCENTS IN THE PENROSE DORMITORY AND TACKED UP A RED CRESCENT/RED

AT 2010, ISRAELI TANK/ARTILLERY POSITIONS IN BI'ABDA AND SOUTH OF THE AIRPORT BEGAN CONCENTRATED SHELLING OF THE BURJ AL-BARAJINAH AND LAYLAKAH AREAS, THE FIRING LASTED ABOUT 10 MINUTES, AND WAS FOLLOWED BY ONLY AN OCCASIONAL EXPLOSION UNTIL 2330 WHEN THERE WAS A SECOND ISRAELI BARRAGE OF ABOUT 15 MINUTES DURATION.
3. AT APPROXIMATELY 0100 AND AGAIN AT 0130 LOCAL AUGUST 8, PROJECTILES HIT IN THE VICINITY OF THE RESIDENCE. THERE WAS NO DAMAGE.

CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS ISRAELI BATTERIES SHELLED SEVERAL REFUGEE CAMPS SOUTH OF BEIRUT. IDF POSITIONS AROUND WEST BEIRUT REMAIN UNCHANGED. ISRAELI RADIO REPORTS THAT THE IDF HAS FURTHER RESTRICTED UNIFIL'S MOVEMENTS IN SOUTHERN LEBANON; THE UNIFIL COMMANDER HAS VIGOROUSLY PROTESTED THESE RESTRICTIONS. ISRAELI TROOPS RESTORED MAIN WATER SUPPLIES TO WEST BEIRUT FOR THE FIRST TIME IN TWO WEEKS, THOUGH THEY KEPT THE ELECTRICITY SHUT OFF. HEALTH AUTHORITIES HAD WARNED THAT CONTINUED INTERRUPTION OF THE WATER SUPPLY COULD LEAD TO EPIDEMICS SINCE ARTESIAN WELL WATER HAD BECOME SALTY AND CONTAMINATED.

3. DIPLOMATIC DEVELOPMENTS: THE ISRAELI CABINET MET THIS MORNING TO REVIEW THE SITUATION IN LEBANON AND TO HEAR REPORTS FROM THE PRIME MINISTER, THE FOREIGN MINISTER, THE DEFENSE MINISTER AND THE CHIEF OF MILITARY

INTELLIGENCE. BEGIN REPORTED ON THE LETTER HE HAD RECEIVED FROM THE SECRETARY AND THE CABINET APPROVED THE CONTENTS OF HIS REPLY. HALFWAY THROUGH THE MEETING, DEFENSE MINISTER SHARON LEFT FOR A MEETING IN BEIRUT WITH AMBASSADOR HABIB.
