RESIDENCE OF CYPRIOT FOREIGN MINISTER ROLANDIS, NICOSIA.

SEN. PERCY: I PUT THE QUESTION TO QADDUMI: ARE YOU ABLE TO GIVE ME AN UNEQUIVOCAL ANSWER THAT THE PLO AUTHORITIES WILL DO EVERYTHING WITHIN THEIR POWER TO FULLY IMPLEMENT THEIR END OF THE AGREEMENT REACHED IN THE HABIB PLAN FOR DIS-ENGAGEMENT AND WITHDRAWAL OF PLO FORCES FROM BEIT?

QADDUMI: ABSOLUTELY, WE INTEND TO LIVE UP TO THE LETTER AND SPIRIT OF THE AGREEMENT.

SEN. PERCY: LOOKING BEYOND THE WITHDRAWAL FROM BEIRUT, WHAT ARE THE PRINCIPAL OBJECTIVES AND CONCERNS OF THE PLO?

QADDUMI: MOST OF ALL, TO RETURN TO LIVE IN OUR HOMELAND. SPEAKING FOR MYSELF AND MANY OTHER PALESTINIANS, THIS IS OUR GREATEST DESIRE. I, FOR EXAMPLE, AM FROM JAFFA. BEGIN IS FROM POLAND. I WANT TO RETURN TO MY HOME.

SEN. PERCY: EVEN IF IT MEANS LIVING UNDER THE ISRAELIS?

QADDUMI: YES.

SEN. PERCY: ARE YOU SAYING THIS WITH THE FEELING THAT ULTIMATELY IF YOU AND OTHER RETURN TO YOUR HOMETLAND, YOU WILL OUTNUMBER THE ISRAELIS?

QADDUMI: OF COURSE. IN A FEW YEARS THERE WILL BE 7-8 MILLION PALESTINIANS. OUR NUMBERS AND STRENGTH WILL INCREASE. WE HAVE WORLD OPINION WITH US AND WE KNOW THIS. WE ARE IMPATIENT FOR A SOLUTION BUT STILL WILLING TO BE PATIENT, KNOWING THAT IN THE END OUR JUST CAUSE WILL PREVAIL.

SEN. PERCY: FROM A PRACTICAL STANDPOINT, WHAT ARE YOUR PRIORITIES IN SEEING THIS COURSE OF ACTION TO FRUITION?

QADDUMI: MY OWN FIRST PRIORITY IS SIMPLY TO RETURN TO MY HOMETLAND. THE SECOND OBJECTIVE WOULD BE TO HAVE GAZA AND THE WEST BANK BECOME A CONFEDERATED STATE. THE THIRD OBJECTIVE WOULD BE TO HAVE GAZA AND THE WEST BANK BECOME A CANTON, SUCH AS IN SWITZERLAND. WE FEEL CONFIDENT OF OUR CASE BECAUSE WE ARE CONVINCED THAT ISRAEL CANNOT MAINTAIN ITSELF AS A JEWISH STATE WITHOUT SOME KIND OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PALESTINIANS.

SEN. PERCY: IN RECENT COMMUNICATIONS WHICH I HAVE RECEIVED FROM THE PLO REPRESENTATIVE AT THE UNITED NATIONS, HE MENTIONED SEVERAL OPTIONS, INCLUDING A SOVEREIGN STATE FOR THE PALESTINIANS AS AN ENTITY, OR A HOMETLAND. BOTH HE AND ARAFAT KNOW THAT I HAVE NEVER SUPPORTED A SOVEREIGN STATE FOR PALESTINIANS AND HAVE MAINTAINED THIS POSITION CONSISTENTLY AND PUBLICLY FOR A DECADE. I HAVE TAKEN THIS POSITION IN EVERY ARAB STATE I HAVE VISITED. MOREOVER, HEADS OF MANY ARAB STATES ARE CONCERNED ABOUT AN INDEPENDENT SOVEREIGN STATUS FOR PALESTINIANS. SOME HAVE OPENLY EXPRESSED CONCERN AS TO THE TREND WHICH WOULD BE TAKEN BY SUCH A STATE, (I.E. ARMS FROM USSR AND TRAINING FROM LIBYA). UNDER PLO LEADERSHIP, IT MIGHT BECOME MORE OF A THREAT TO ARAB OIL STATES THAN TO ISRAEL. (THIS COMMENT DID NOT SURPRISE QADDUMI.) I HAVE CONSISTENTLY SUPPORTED A HOMETLAND OR "ENTITY" FOR PALESTINIANS. PALESTINIAN MAYORS FROM GAZA AND THE WEST BANK WITH WHOM I HAVE MET HAVE SAID THAT FEDERATION WITH JORDAN WOULD RECEIVE OVERWHELMING SUPPORT IN A PLEBISCITE, IF THIS COULD BE ACHIEVED WITHIN THEIR LIFE TIMES, IN CONTRAST WITH A SOVEREIGN STATE, WHICH IS NOT FEASIBLE FOR GENERATIONS, IF EVER.

QADDUMI: WE WOULD ACCEPT ENTITY, OR HOMETLAND, STATUS AND FEDERATION WITH JORDAN.

SEN. PERCY: WHAT CONCERNS DO YOU HAVE ABOUT LEBANON?

QADDUMI: WE ARE DEEPLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE REFUGEES WHO REMAIN IN LEBANON, LARGELY WOMEN AND CHILDREN. WE ARE ALSO DEEPLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE ESTIMATED 27,000 CIVILIAN CASUALTIES IN LEBANON. BY OUR ESTIMATE, 17,000 ARE DEAD

WADDUMI: THE ISRAELIS WOULD HAVE LOST AT LEAST THREE TIMES THEIR CURRENT DEAD AND WOUNDED. CIVILIAN CASUALTIES WOULD HAVE BEEN THREE TIMES THOSE ALREADY SUFFERED TO DATE. WE HAVE NO DOUBT THAT ISRAEL INTENDED TO ENTER WEST BEIRUT AND HAD THIS AS PART OF ITS PLAN, WHICH WAS FRUSTRATED BECAUSE OF THE REVULSION OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY. BUT PRIMARILY WE CREDIT PRESSURE FROM THE UNITED STATES FOR PREVENTING THIS FURTHER GENOCIDE.

SEN. PERCY: WHAT DEGREE OF CONFIDENCE DO YOU HAVE THAT THE EVACUATION WILL BE COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY?

WADDUMI: WE HAVE CONSIDERABLE CONFIDENCE THAT THE MULTI-NATIONAL FORCE WILL MEET ITS COMMITMENTS ON SCHEDULE.

SEN. PERCY: ARE THERE ANY OTHER POINTS YOU WOULD LIKE TO RAISE?

WADDUMI: WE URGE THE UNITED STATES TO DO EVERYTHING IT CAN TO CAUSE ISRAEL TO RELEASE THE 10-15,000 PRISONERS WHICH WE ESTIMATE THEY ARE HOLDING AND TO ENSURE THAT THE INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS IS GRANTED IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO SEE THAT THEY ARE NOT BEING MISTREATED. MUST ARE NOT FIGHTERS BUT INNOCENT CIVILIANS.
