1. ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. DEPUTY ASSISTANT SECRETARY EAGLEBURGER CALLED IN ISRAELI CHARGE NETANYAHU AFTERNOON OF SEPTEMBER 1 TO CONFIRM THE FACT THAT THE PRESIDENT WOULD BE DELIVERING HIS STATEMENT ON HIS MIDDLE EAST INITIATIVE THAT EVENING AND GENERALLY TO DISCUSS STATUS OF THE INITIATIVE.

3. EAGLEBURGER READ THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER TO BEGIN TO NETANYAHU (WHO HAD RECEIVED FROM JERUSALEM ONLY THE SUBSTANTIVE POSITIONS ADOPTED BY THE PRESIDENT). EAGLEBURGER THEN ADDRESSED THE PRIME MINISTER'S REACTION TO THE LETTER, NOTING IN PARTICULAR HIS REQUEST FOR A DELAY IN THE PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT UNTIL THE ISRAELI CABINET COULD MEET. HE SAID THE PRESIDENT HAD HOPED TO BE ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE THE PRIME MINISTER'S REQUEST, BUT THERE HAD BEEN SO MUCH COMMENTARY ON THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER IN THE ISRAELI MEDIA THAT HE FELT HE HAD TO DELIVER HIS STATEMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

4. NETANYAHU SAID THAT HE WAS INSTRUCTED ONLY TO SAY THAT A PUBLIC STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT TAKING POSITIONS WITH WHICH ISRAEL DISAGREES PUTS INTO QUESTION THE ENTIRE ROLE OF THE U.S. AS AN HONEST BROKER. ELABORATING ON HIS OWN, HE ADDED THAT THIS IS ESPECIALLY TRUE WHEN THE TIMING OF THE STATEMENT IS PRESENTED TO ISRAEL AT THE LAST MINUTE, BEFORE THE PRIME MINISTER HAS HAD A CHANCE TO CONSULT WITH THE CABINET AND PROVIDE HIS CONSIDERED VIEWS ON THE U.S. INITIATIVE.

5. SPEAKING PERSONALLY, NETANYAHU DESCRIBED THE U.S. POSITION AS HE UNDERSTOOD IT AS SAYING IN EFFECT THAT THE NEGOTIATING PARTIES HAVE "A BIG SANDBOX" TO PLAY IN IF THEY WISH, BUT THE U.S. WILL ONLY PLAY WITH THEM IN ONE CORNER. HE SAID HE WOULD NOT BE SURPRISED HIMSELF IF THE PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT MET WITH TOTAL REJECTION.

6. ADDRESSING THE ISRAELI CONCERN ABOUT THE TIMING OF THE SPEECH, EAGLEBURGER NOTED THAT AMBASSADOR LEWIS HAD DELIVERED A PRIVATE LETTER TO THE PRIME MINISTER AND THAT NOTHING HAD BEEN SAID ABOUT IT IN WASHINGTON. THAT LETTER, NEVERTHELESS, BECAME THE SUBJECT OF INTENSIVE COMMENTARY IN ISRAEL WHICH WAS, OF COURSE, REFLECTED IN THE AMERICAN MEDIA. THIS PUT THE PRESIDENT IN A POSITION WHERE HE HAD NO CHOICE BUT TO DELIVER HIS STATEMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, IF ONLY TO CORRECT SOME OF THE ERRONEOUS IMPRESSIONS WHICH WERE BEING CONVEYED ABOUT OUR INITIATIVE. EAGLEBURGER STRESSED THAT THE PRESIDENT HAD NOT PLANNED TO DELIVER HIS STATEMENT ON SEPTEMBER 1 AND THE DECISION TO DO SO HAD NOT BE MADE UNTIL TODAY.

7. NETANYAHU PROBED TO LEARN EXACTLY WHAT THE PRESIDENT PLANNED TO DEAL WITH IN HIS STATEMENT, WITH EMPHASIS ON THE MANNER IN WHICH HE INTENDED TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE OF A SETTLEMENTS FREEZE. ON THIS POINT, HE WAS REASSURED THAT THE PRESIDENT WOULD SUPPORT A FREEZE ON ADDITIONAL SETTLEMENTS IN THE CONTEXT OF THE TRANSITIONAL PERIOD. NETANYAHU EXPRESSED PARTICULAR CONCERN ABOUT THE POSSIBLE PUBLIC RELEASE OF THE FULL TEXT OF THE PRESIDENT'S POSITIONS AND WAS ASSURED THAT THIS WASNOT TOUR INTENTION.

8. EAGLEBURGER ADDRESSED THE POSSIBILITY OF "TOTAL REJECTION" BY ISRAEL OF THE PRESIDENT'S INITIATIVE AND SAID THAT THIS WAS OBVIOUSLY A DECISION FOR THE SOVEREIGN GOVERNMENT OF ISRAEL TO MAKE. ISRAEL SHOULD NOT BE SURPRISED, HOWEVER, IF SUCH A DECISION IS NOT TAKEN WELL HERE.

9. NETANYAHU POINTED OUT THAT THE PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT WILL HAVE A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON THE ISRAELI REACTION. THAT IMPACT COULD BE POSITIVE OR NEGATIVE, BUT CERTAINLY THE TIMING OF THE SPEECH IS A NEGATIVE FACTOR. EAGLEBURGER RESPONDED BY REITERATING THE INTENSITY AND SUBSTANTIVE NATURE OF THE LEAKS IN ISRAEL HAD FORCED THE

PRESIDENT REAGAN EXPLAINED HIS MIDDLE EAST POLICIES IN A SPEECH IN LOS ANGELES LAST NIGHT, CALLING FOR RENEWED LINKS BETWEEN JORDAN AND THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES AND A HALT TO CONTINUING JEWISH SETTLEMENT OF THE DISPUTED AREAS. SECRETARY OF DEFENSE WEINBERGER REMAINED IN ISRAELI TODAY FOR FURTHER CONSULTATIONS WITH ISRAELI OFFICIALS AND WILL FLY TO EGYPT ON FRIDAY. THE PLO EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MET IN ATHENS WHERE CHAIRMAN YASSER ARAFAT LANDED SEPTEMBER 1 AFTER A THREE DAY VOYAGE FROM BEIRUT. SHULTZ

AL QUDS STRESSES, HOWEVER, THAT ANY NEW AMERICAN PROPOSAL TO ACHIEVE A LASTING SOLUTION TO THE ARAB-ISRAELI DISPUTE MUST BE BASED ON AN ULTIMATE RECOGNITION OF PALESTINIAN SELF-DETERMINATION. AL QUDS WONDERS WHETHER THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION CAN WITHSTAND THE "PRESSURES THAT WILL UNDOUBTEDLY BE EXERTED BY THE PRO-ISRAELI LOBBY IN THE UNITED STATES" TO REJECT ANY COMPROMISE SOLUTION WHICH REQUIRES AN ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL FROM OCCUPIED TERRITORIES CAPTURED IN 1967. IN THE SAME VEIN, AL QUDS BANNERS PRESIDENT REAGAN'S REPORTED "DEMAND" FOR "AN IMMEDIATE HALT IN SETTLEMENT ACTIVITY", BUT EXPRESSES DOUBTS THAT THE ISRAELIS WILL RESPOND FAVORABLY. FINALLY, AL QUDS CALLS ON "ALL ARAB GOVERNMENTS TO SHOULDER THEIR NATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES...AND TO OVERCOME THEIR DISPUTES IN ORDER NOT TO LEAVE THE ARENA EMPTY ONLY FOR THE U.S. TO PRESENT THE SOLUTIONS IT DESIRES." AL QUDS ADDS THAT ALL TOO OFTEN AT HISTORIC MOMENTS SUCH AS THE PRESENT THE ARAB COUNTRIES HAVE SATISFIED THEMSELVES WITH REJECTIONIST VIEWS AT THE EXPENSE OF THE PALESTINIANS WITHOUT PRESENTING A REALISTIC ALTERNATIVE.

THE FOLLOWING ARE THE MAJOR POSITIONS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES:

1. JERUSALEM

"PARTICIPATION BY THE PALESTINIAN INHABITANTS OF EAST JERUSALEM IN THE ELECTION FOR THE WEST BANK-GAZA AUTHORITY"

NO MENTION WHATSOEVER IS MADE IN THE CAMP DAVID AGREEMENT TO SUCH A VOTING RIGHT. THE SINGLE MEANING OF SUCH A VOTE IS THE REPARTITION OF JERUSALEM INTO TWO AUTHORITIES, THE ONE OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND THE OTHER--OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL OF THE AUTONOMY. JERUSALEM IS NOWHERE MENTIONED IN THE CAMP DAVID AGREEMENT. WITH RESPECT TO THE CAPITAL OF ISRAEL LETTERS WERE FORWARDED AND ATTACHED TO THE AGREEMENT. IN HIS LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, MR. JIMMY CARTER, THE PRIME MINISTER OF ISRAEL, MR. MENACHEM BEGIN, STATED THAT "JERUSALEM IS ONE CITY, INDIVISIBLE, THE CAPITAL OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL." THUS SHALL IT REMAIN FOR ALL GENERATIONS TO COME.

2. SECURITY

"PROGRESSIVE PALESTINIAN RESPONSIBILITY FOR INTERNAL SECURITY BASED ON CAPABILITY AND PERFORMANCE"

IN THE CAMP DAVID AGREEMENT IT IS STATED:

"A WITHDRAWAL OF ISRAELI ARMED FORCES WILL TAKE PLACE AND THERE WILL BE A REDEPLOYMENT OF THE REMAINING ISRAELI FORCES INTO SPECIFIED SECURITY LOCATIONS. THE AGREEMENT WILL ALSO INCLUDE ARRANGEMENTS FOR ASSURING INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL SECURITY AND PUBLIC ORDER."

--

IT IS, THEREFORE, CLEAR THAT IN THE CAMP DAVID AGREEMENT NO DISTINCTION IS MADE BETWEEN INTERNAL SECURITY AND EXTERNAL SECURITY. THERE CAN BE NO DOUBT THAT WERE INTERNAL SECURITY NOT TO BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ISRAEL, THE TERRORIST ORGANIZATION CALLED PLO--EVEN AFTER ITS DEFEAT BY THE IDF IN LEBANON--WOULD ACT TO PERPETRATE CONSTANT BLOODSHED, SHEDDING THE BLOOD OF JEWS AND ARABS ALIKE. FOR THE CITIZENS OF ISRAEL THIS IS A QUESTION OF LIFE AND DEATH.

3. A REAL SETTLEMENT FREEZE
