DURING MEETING SEPT 20, ACTING FOREIGN MINISTER MESTIRI TOLD ME THAT WITHIN THE TUNISIAN GOVERNMENT REACTION HAS BEEN DECIDEDLY POSITIVE TO PRESIDENT REAGAN'S STATEMENT ON BEIRUT AND TO THE ADDITIONAL POINTS MADE IN SECRETARY SHULTZ'S LETTER TO PRIME MINISTER MZALI (REFTEL). MZALI PERSONALLY TELEPHONED THE TEXT OF BOTH TO BOURGUIBA IN PARIS. ACCORDING TO MESTIRI, BOURGUIBA HAD BEEN ENCOURAGED BY THE PRESIDENT'S STRONG REACTION TO THE MASSACRES AND HIS INSISTENCE ON ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL. BOURGUIBA HAD ALSO APPRECIATED OUR DETERMINATION NOT TO BE DIVERTED FROM PURSUING THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE PROCESS. MESTIRI COMMENTED THAT A STIFFENED U.S. POSITION VIS-A-VIS ISRAEL WOULD BE AN IMPORTANT ELEMENT IN ENABLING TUNISIA TO MAINTAIN ITS MODERATE POSTURE ON THE ARAB-ISRAELI ISSUE.
3. ON OTHER ASPECTS OF THE LEBANESE SITUATION, I SAID I WAS PLEASED THE TUNISIAN GOVERNMENT HAD REFRAINED FROM JOINING CERTAIN OTHER PARTIES IN BLAMING THE U.S. FOR THE MASSACRES BY VIRTURE OF THE ALLEGEDLY PREMATURE WITHDRAWAL OF OUR FORCES FROM BEIRUT, MESTIRI THOUGH WE HAD IN FACT PULLED OUT TOO SOON, BEFORE THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT WAS ABLE TO ASSERT EFFECTIVE CONTROL THROUGHOUT THE CITY; HOWEVER, HE ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THE MULTINATIONAL FORCE (MNF) HAD NOT BEEN SENT IN FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING INTERNAL SECURITY AND THAT DECISIONS ON MNF DURATION HAD BEEN
