2. WHILE LUKEWARM TO THE IDEA, THE GON WOULD GIVE SERIOUS CONSIDERATION TO PARTICIPATION IN A MULTINATIONAL FORCE IN THE BEIRUT AREA. PROSPECTS FUR A POSITIVE GON RESPONSE WOULD BE CONSIDERABLY ENHANCED IF THE DURATION WERE LIMITED, THE -ANDATE CLEARLY EXCLUDED A CUMBAT ROLE, AND OTHER EC CONTRIBUTORS TOUK PART. SOME SORT OF UN APPROVAL WOULD ALSO BE HELPFUL. GIVEN APPROACHES TO OTHER EC STATES, WE PRESUME DUTCH HAVE ALREADY HEARD OF DUR EFFORTS TO OBTAIN ADDITIONAL PARTICIPATION IN THE LEBANON MNF. WE RECOMMEND THAT, IN ANY CASE, THE DUTCH BE AMONG

THOSE COUNTRIES APPROACHED.

3. PER REF TELECON, WE HAVE NOT RAISED MEN PROPOSAL WITH GON. POSSIBLE NEW ROLE FOR PART OF DUTCH UNIFIL CONTINGENT HAS, HOWEVER, RISEN HERE SINCE BEIRUT MASSACRE. DURING A SEPTEMBER 20 MEETING ON ANOTHER SUBJECT WITH MFA HEAD OF IO PULITICAL AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY AFFAIRS DIVISION (ETTEMA), HE VOLUNTEERED FOLLOWING SHOULD UN SECGEN REQUEST UNIFIL CONTRIBUTORS TO TAKE SOME STEPS IN AND AROUND BEIRUT. ETTEMA SAID DUTCH WERE NOT ENTHUSIASTI€ ABOUT MOVING INTO BEIRUT AREA AND WOULD PREFER TO SEE SOMEONE ELSE CARRY RESPONSIBILITY. AT SAME TIME, GON, WHICH ETTEMA IMPLIEE HAD BEEN CONSIDERING ITS REACTION TO A PROSPECTIVE REQUEST, HAD REACHED NO FINAL DECISION ON MATTER. HE ADDED THAT THE DUTCH COULD CONCEIVABLY DESPATCH A COMPANY OF 120 - 200 MEN FOR THEIR UNIFIL CONTINGENT OF 800 TO BEIRUT FOR A SHORT PERIOD.

BOTH PRESIDENT MUBARAK AND FOREIGN MINISTER HASSAN ALI YESTERDAY PROCLAIMED THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE RETURN OF MULTI-NATIONAL FORCES TO BEIRUT AND EXPRESSED SUPPORT FOR THE U.S. POSITION STATED IN PRESIDENT REAGAN'S SEPT. 20 ADDRESS. GENERAL REACTION HAS ALSO BEEN FAVORABLE, AND THE PRESIDENTIAL ADDRESS RECEIVED EXTENSIVE REPORTING INCLUDING TAPED RE-BROADCAST IN FULL. ANTI-AMERICAN TONE OF RECENT PRESS COMMENTARIES WAS NOTICEABLY ABSENT FROM TODAY'S COLUMNS AND EDITORIALS, ALTHOUGH ISRAEL CONTINUES TO BE THE TARGET OF FIERCE ATTACKS. END SUMMARY.

3. SPEAKING WITH REPORTERS ON HIS DEPARTURE FROM YESTERDAY'S NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY CONFERENCE SESSION, PRESIDENT MUBARAK SAID THAT THE RETURN OF THE MULTI-NATIONAL PEACEKEEPING FORCE TO BEIRUT IS THE BEST SOLUTION FOR THE SITUATION IN LEBANON, AT LEAST FOR THE TIME BEING.
