WITH REGARD TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RESOLUTION 521, THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT WELCOMES THE RAPIDITY WITH WHICH THE UNITED NATIONS OBSERVERS WERE PLACED IN BEIRUT, IN SUFFICIENT NUMBERS. THESE UBSERVERS WILL BE ABLE TO PLAY A VALUABLE ROLE IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS. FRENCH GOVERNMENT WILL ENSURE THAT THE MULTINATIONAL FORCE ACTS IN LIAISON WITH THEM AND, IN PARTICULAR, ASSISTS IN THE MISSION ENTRUSTED TO THEM BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT, WHOSE POLICIES ARE BASED ON THE PURPOSES AND PRINCIPLES OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER AND WHICH, AS YOU KNOW, ATTACHES GREAT IMPORTANCE TO THE ROLE OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION, WILL NOT FAIL TO REMAIN IN CLOSE LIAISON WITH YOU.

I SHOULD BE GRATEFUL IF YOU WOULD ARRANGE FOR THIS LETTER TO BE DRAWN TO THE ATTENTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL AND OF ALL THE COUNCIL MEMBERS.

--MILSON'S RESIGNATION FOLLOWS WEEKS OF RUMORS ABOUT A SERIOUS RIFT BETWEEN HIM AND SHARON. THE JERUSALEM POST AND THE PRO-PLO AL FAJR REPORT THAT DEFENSE MINISTRY SOURCES CLAIMED AFTER THE RESIGNATION THAT MILSON HAD OB-JECTED TO "FURTHER RELAXATIONS IN POLICY" WHICH SHARON OSTENSIBLY WANTED TO INTRODUCE IN THE UCCUPIED TERRITURIES.
