RED FLAGS

- Perceived Administration softness on Red China and equivocation on previously denounced SALT II causing growing unrest among conservative and pro-defense organizations.
- Unconvinced social issue conservatives looking for evidence of sustained Administration pressure on Congress in behalf of Tuition Tax Credits, School Prayer, and Right to Life.
- Conservative movement and new right groups view Senate Finance Committee revenue bill as a destructive reversal of the President's economic program.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Most conservative organizations, whether multi-issue or focussed-issue, are financially much better prepared for 1982 elections than they were the 1980 elections.
- Conservative organizations generally enthusiastic about President's support for Balanced Budget Amendment.


