- 2. CHARGE MADE DEMARCHE REF A TO USA DEPARTMENT CHIEF MAY 5 AND HANDED OVER TEXT AS NONPAPER. HE ALSO NOTED OTHER DISCUSSIONS WE WERE HAVING OVER THIS ISSUE. MINISTRY HAD ITS INFORMATION FROM COMPETENT SOVIET AUTHORITIES, THAT THE MFA'S NOTE HAD GIVEN THE COORDINATES OF THE INCIDENT, AND THAT THE VIOLATION HAD CONTINUED THE NEXT DAY. IT WAS FOR THIS REASON THAT THE SOVIET UNION HAD MADE ITS STRONG PROTEST. THE NOTE CLAIMS THAT THE U.S. SHIP REMAINED IN SOVIET WATERS SOME NINE AND ONE-QUARTER HOURS, DID NOT RESPOND TO SOVIET WARNINGS, AND TOOK "PROVOCATIVE ACTIONS" AGAINST THE SOVIETS.
