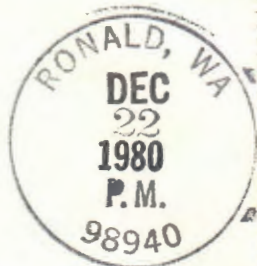

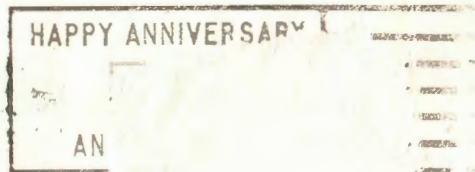


I am wondering whether President Reagan will reinstitute the popular practice during the Ford Administration of having regular "Congressional hours" for miscellaneous presentations and the like.
