I am attaching (Tab A) talking points from the Secretary of State. I concur in these positions.

I suggest you consider these additional points, including two icebreakers:

--Ambassador Chai (rhymes with eye) cancelled a trip to Arden, New York, where he was to meet with a group of U.S. "experts" on China. They were meeting in the old Harriman mansion for a 4-day talk fest on the "China factor."

--Mr. Ji (pronounced Gee), who is here from Beijing (Peking), attended Harvard University (Vice President Bush attended Yale) and Ji was very close to former Premier Chou En-lai (pronounced Joe En-lie) who with former President Nixon reopened relations between our two countries in 1971.

-- And you are pleased to inform the Chinese that we are granting today a number (11) of export licenses for sophisticated electronic equipment which will be sent to China. None of these would be approved for export to the USSR. Your staff will provide the Chinese with details as we proceed to grant additional export licenses.

-- The meeting will take place in the Cabinet Room. Attending for the U.S. side will be The Vice President, Secretary Haig, Ed Meese, Jim Baker, Dick Allen, Jim Lilley, Ambassador Holdridge, and Vivian Chang (State Department Interpreter).

--It is important that, during the meeting, you address Ambassador Chai at least as much as you do Mr. Ji, who speaks English very well. Your tendency will be to respond to Ji, but please look at Ambassador Chai as you talk.

The meeting is set for 4:15 pm, Thursday, 19 March in the Cabinet Room. Attending will be the President, Secretary Haig, yourself, Ambassador Holdridge, me, and Vivian Chang (the State interpreter). On the Chinese side it will be Ambassador Chai, Mr. Ji, and their interpreter Zhou, for a total of nine.

So far we have kept the appointment off the President's schedule per our earlier understanding. If questions come up about this we will say that the meeting was arranged at the last minute so that Mr. Ji could be included before he left town.

I will meet Ambassador Chai at the Northwest Gate at 4:10 pm, ride with him to the West Lobby where we will meet you. You will chat with him there for a minute and then escort him to the Cabinet Room. Holdridge will be with you. According to our current understanding, Secretary Haig will be in the Cabinet Room.

I have included in the talking points for the President a nice little package of technology which we have gotten ready in a rush for this meeting. I hope it helps.
