CHINESE ELITE PERCEPTIONS OF THE TAIWAN ISSUE

Summary

This report is on Chinese elite views of the Taiwan issue as it affects U.S.-PRC bilateral relations.* The data are from interviews of 141 Americans and foreigners with extensive contacts in China who served as "surrogates" for their Chinese counterparts. The major findings which reflect both Chinese elite opinion and insights of the respondents are:

- o China's top leaders and influential elites regard Taiwan as the crucial foreign policy issue in the U.S.-PRC relationship. The impasse over Taiwan outranks by far all other policy differences in its potential for disrupting future U.S.-Chinese relations.
- o For PRC leaders, Taiwan's "restoration to the motherland" is essential to unify China and end foreign intervention. U.S. support for the Kuomintang regime, in their view, enables Taiwan to survive in the international community.
- o Chinese officials see the Taiwan issue as a measure of U.S. reliability and of its commitment to develop a mutually beneficial relationship.
- o PRC spokesmen warn that China will react adversely to continued American military arms sales to Taiwan, at the risk of harming U.S.-PRC relations and even at an economic cost to the PRC.
- o The Chinese elite in general share the official view that permanent separation of Taiwan from the mainland is unacceptable. However, few expect unification soon or want the Taiwan issue forced to the point of endangering improved relations with the U.S.
- o Elites are puzzled by the U.S. position on Taiwan, having meager understanding of U.S. foreign policy formulation and the interplay of domestic political forces.
- o The belief that the U.S. alone impedes unification rests on an assumption among Chinese leaders and elite that the people of Taiwan are eager for unification. Only a few Foreign Ministry officials and foreign affairs scholars realize that this is not the case.

*A larger USICA report on Chinese perceptions of the United States will be issued in the near future.

According to the respondents, the PRC's chief motives in pressing the Taiwan problem to the forefront of public attention at this time are:

- o A belief that the road to Taiwan leads through Washington.
- o A desire to underscore the PRC's firm opposition to U.S. arms sales to Taiwan.
- o The conviction that PRC prestige is at stake.
- o The fear that sentiment for Taiwan independence may grow and block unification with the passing from power of Chiang Ching-kuo.

Most respondents, particularly those with contacts among senior-level leaders in Beijing, concur that PRC official warnings should be taken seriously. Several foresee the PRC "painting itself into a corner" with no possible retreat, by stiffening its opposition to U.S. arms sales to Taiwan.

Inasmuch as the Taiwan issue could arouse nationalistic, even xenophobic emotions, the author of this report postulates that the PRC Government, if it desired, could muster mass support over Taiwan.

Note: Interviews on which this report is based were conducted from September through December 1981. Analysis of the data was completed on March 31, 1982.
