



On behalf of all the members of our Association, I would like to express my heartfelt concern for your health and safety after last Monday's senseless incident.


We are heartened and indeed amazed with the daily reports of your speedy improvement, and we hope and pray for your complete recovery and return to full strength and full schedule in the near future.

Painful coughs ahead, veteran warns Reagan

NEW YORK (UPI) — President Reagan's prognosis may be excellent, but his recovery is going to be extremely painful.

In 1967, I went through the same surgery as the president, after being shot in the left lung while in combat in Vietnam. Like the president, my left lung collapsed and was re-inflated with tubes.

Doctors explained that my recovery would depend to a large extent on my willingness to exercise the lung. And that meant self-induced coughing — deep-down coughs, which start at the bottom of the chest cavity.

The natural coughing reflex, doctors said, would also expel the blood and phlegm that accumulate in the lung after such a wound.

Part of the pain from the coughing came from the broken and bruised ribs that were the result of both the trauma of the wound itself and the surgical procedure which involved doctors conducting their cleanup procedures through the ribs.

In order to facilitate my recovery, doctors didn't leave me to my own devices, so far as coughing went. They put me on a regularly scheduled

"coughing" timetable, and assigned a nurse to me to insure that I didn't try to get away with just lightly clearing my throat.

As I recall, the schedule require me to spend 10 or 15 minutes coughing every two hours, day and night. I came to dread the sessions because the pain was excruciating, especially in the days immediately following surgery.

At one point, I recall being awakened at three or four in the morning for my coughing sessions. I crankily told the corpsman to bugger off — I was in no mood for the pain.

The next day, my doctor, a captain, told me, a lieutenant, that if I ever refused to cough again, he would order me to undergo a court martial.

So I coughed. Fortunately, day by day, the pain receded as my lung recovered. The total recovery period was about two months.

I don't envy President Reagan his coughing session. While they are vital to his recovery, the pain will be a regular part of his life in the days and weeks ahead. And he will have to do it on his own — his doctors are not going to threaten him with a court martial if he doesn't cough.
