SUBJECT: Falklands/Malvinas Contingencies

Here is our current forward thinking -- a joint effort by ARA, S/P, PM, EUR, L and IO -- just in case good offices as presently constituted do not convince the Argentines or deter the British. The scenarios and options do not yet carry recommendations.

Sections I and II contain background information on the situation we are likely to confront if negotiations collapse. Section III, beginning on page 4, contains our thoughts on U.S. alternatives before and after hostilities begin.

SUBJECT: Your Breakfast Meeting with British Foreign
Minister Pym (Friday, April 23 - 8:00 p.m.)

Per your guidance earlier this evening, we have put together the attached talking points which you may wish to discuss with Francis Pym during your breakfast meeting with him tomorrow morning. The main thrust of these points -- off-the record and exploratory -- is to get the Brits focussed on an alternative approach to the crisis as a way of overcoming the present impasse. If nothing else, it may have some positive shock value.
