S. TEXT OF SOVIET REPLY FOLLOWS:

AS HAS BEEN REPORTED BY TASS ON JANUARY 7, 1983, THE SOVIET SATELLITE COSMOS 1402 WITH A NUCLEAR POWER PLANT ON BOARD, ON COMPLETING ITS MISSION, HAS CEASED, ON COMMAND FROM THE EARTH, ACTIVE EXISTENCE ON DECEMBER 28, 1982. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGULAR INTERNATIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS THE SATELLITE WAS EQUIPPED WITH A SYSTEM MAKING IT POSSIBLE TO PUT ITS POWER PLANT INTO A BURIAL ORBIT AND A BACK-UP SYSTEM TO SEPARATE THE ACTIVE REACTOR CORE FOR ITS SUBSEQUENT COMBUSTION IN THE DENSE LAYERS OF THE ATMOSPHERE.

THE POWER PLANT, HOWEVER, FAILED TO MOVE INTO A BURIAL ORBIT. ACCORDING TO THE FLIGHT PROGRAM, THE BACK-UP SAFETY SYSTEM FRACTURED THE SATELLITE INTO THREE PIECES, ONE OF WHICH BURNT UP ON DECEMBER 3D, 1982 ON ENTRY INTO THE DENSE LAYERS OF THE ATMOSPHERE. THE TWO REMAINING PIECES ARE THE BASIC PART OF THE SATELLITE'S STRUCTURE AND THE ACTIVE CORE OF THE REACTOR SEPARATED THEREFROM.

ACCORDING TO PRELIMINARY ESTIMATES THE BASIC PART OF THE SATELLITE STRUCTURE WILL ENTER THE DENSE LAYERS OF THE ATMOSPHERE IN LATE JANUARY, THE ACTIVE CORE REACTOR WILL DO SO IN MID FEBRUARY.

THE POWER PLANT OF THE SATELLITE INCLUDES A SMALL NUCLEAR REACTOR OF THE USUAL FYPE, WHOSE ACTIVE CORE IS AN ASSEMBLY OF URANIUM-BASED HEAT-GENERATING ELEMENTS ENRICHED WITH URANIUM-235. PRIOR TO THE FRAGMENTATION OF THE SATELLITE COSMOS 1402. THE REACTOR WAS TURNED OFF ON COMMAND FROM THE EARTH. AT THE PRESENT TIME THE RADIOACTIVE DECAY OF FISSION FUEL PRODUCTS HAS CHARACTERISTICS USUAL FOR HEAT-GENERATING ELEMENTS REMOVED FROM AN INOPERATIVE REACTOR. ON BURNING IN THE DENSE LAYERS OF THE ATMOSPHERE THE ACTIVE CORE OF THE REACTOR DISINTEGRATES INTO SMALL DISPERSION DEBRIS, WHICH IN CASE OF A FALLOUT WILL PRODUCE A RADIOACTIVE SITUATION WITHIN THE LIMITS RECOMMENDED BY THE INTERNATIONAL RADIOLOGICAL

THE BASIC STRUCTURAL MATERIAL OF THE SATELLITE IS STAINLESS STEEL. THERE ARE ELEMENTS CONTAINING BERYLLIUM.

IF ANY ELEMENTS OF THE SATELLITE SURVIVE AFTER HAVING BEEN SUBJECTED TO AERODYNAMIC DRAG THE LEVEL OF OUTSIDE RADIATION PRODUCED BY THEM, WITHOUT PROLONGED DIRECT CONTACT, WILL PRESENT NO HAZARD TO PEOPLE OR THE ENVIRONMENT. ALSO, BECAUSE OF THEIR LOW CAPACITY TO BE DISSOLVED, THEIR ENTRY INTO FOOD CHAINS IS PRACTICALLY RULED OUT.

FOR 48 HOURS FOLLOWING THE SEPARATION OF THE SATELLITE INTO PIECES RADIO COMMUNICATION WAS MAINTAINED WITH THE BASIC PART OF ITS STRUCTURE, WHEREBY IT WAS CONFIRMED—FIRST, THAT THE REACTOR WAS ACTUALLY TURNED OFF, SECOND, THAT THE ACTIVE CORE WAS SEPARATED. FURTHER RADIO CONTACTS WITH THE SATELLITE'S PIECES ARE NOT CONTEMPLATED. AT THE PRESENT TIME THESE PIECES ARE BEING MONITORED TO FORECAST THE MOST PROBABLE TIME AND AREAS OF THEIR ENTRY INTO THE DENSE LAYERS OF THE ATMOSPHERE. THE SOVIET UNION INTENDS TO KEEP THE INTERESTED COUNTRIES INFORMED OF THE RESULTS OF THE SAID FORECASTS.

WE HOPE THAT THE U.S. SIDE, IN ITS TURN, WILL INFORM THE SOVIET SIDE OF THE RESULTS OF THE OBSERVATIONS WITH RESPECT TO THAT SATELLITE'S PIECES, CONDUCTED BY U.S. SPECIALISTS IN THE ZONE COVERED BY THE U.S. MONITORING SYSTEMS.VY
