The economic attaché from the Soviet embassy has requested a meeting with Martin Feldstein. The general consensus here, at is that Feldstein should not meet with such a low-ranking officer, but should offer that the attaché meet with one of Feldstein's junior assistants.

This is a matter of reciprocity. The access of our officers in Moscow to high Soviet officials is extremely limited, and until it improves, we should not give the Soviets here any special favors.
