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MOSCOW: REAGAN STATEMENTS ON C. AMERICA 'UNPRECEDENTED HYPOCRISY'

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(FROM "THE WORLD TODAY" PROGRAM PRESENTED BY POLITICAL OBSERVER GEORGIY ZUBKOY)

(TEXT) MANY REPORTS AND REACTIONS WHICH HAVE ARRIVED FROM OVERSEAS TODAY ARE CONNECTED WITH THE EVENTS IN CENTRAL AMERICA. THE WHITE HOUSE AND THE PENTAGON ARE STEPPING UP THEIR ACTIONS THERE. THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER RANGER AND SEVEN OTHER U.S. WARSHIPS ARE THE U.S. PATROLLING CLOSE TO THE SHORES OF CENTRAL AMERICA. BATTLESHIP NEW JERSEY IS HEADING THERE FROM THAILAND. IT IS ACCOMPANIED BY FOUR WARSHIPS. ANOTHER NAVAL GROUP, HEADED BY THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER CORAL SEA, WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE CARIBBEAN MAJOR MANEUVERS WILL COMMENCE IN CENTRAL AMERICA IN AUGUST. IT SER. IS EXPECTED THAT THEY WILL LAST FOR AT LEAST HALF A YEAR AND THAT UP TO 5,000 U.S. SERVICEMEN WILL TAKE PART IN THEM. HONDURAS HAS BEEN DRAWN INTO THE MANEUVERS. GENERAL VESSEY, CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF, HAS ARRIVED IN HONDURAS IN ORDER TO DISCUSS MATTERS INVOLVED IN THE PARTICIPATION OF THE HONDURAS MILITARY IN THESE PROYOCATIVE, LARGE-SCALE MANEUVERS. THOSE ARE THE LATEST EVENTS.

AS WE KNOW, THE PRESIDENTS OF VENEZUELA, COLOMBIA, MEXICO AND PANAMA HAVE PUT FORWARD AN INITIATIVE FOR A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT OF CONFLICTS IN CENTRAL AMERICA. PRESIDENT REAGAN HAS SENT AN ANSWERING MESSAGE TO THE HEADS OF THESE STATES. IN THE MESSAGE AND AT HIS PRESS CONFERENCE IN WASHINGTON REAGAN ALLEGED THAT HE WAS INTERESTED IN THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE SOLUTION OF THE PROBLEMS IN CENTRAL AMERICA ON THE BASIS, AS HE PUT IT, OF RESPECT FOR THE PRINCIPLES OF NONINTERFERENCE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF OTHER COUNTRIES.

SUCH DECLARATIONS BY THE HEAD OF THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION CAN ONLY BE DESCRIBED AS UNPRECEDENTED HYPOCRISY. HAVE THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER RANGER, THE BATTLESHIP NEW JERSEY AND THE AIRCRAFT CARRIER CORAL SEA BEEN SENT TO THE SHORES OF NICARAGUA AND OTHER CENTRAL AMERICAN COUNTRIES TO RESPECT THE PRINCIPLES OF NONINTERFERENCE? IS THAT WHY THE PENTAGON IS TURNING HONDURAS INTO A BRIDGEHEAD FOR ITS AGGRESSION? IS THAT WHY THE 6-MONTH LONG BIG PINE-2 MANEUVERS ARE BEING HELD? NO. THE FACTS INDICATE SOMETHING ELSE. IT IS NOT THE PRINCIPLES OF NONINTERFERENCE BUT THE POLICY OF THE BIG STICK AND GUNBOAT DIPLOMACY WHICH ARE TYPICAL OF THE ACTIONS OF THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION.
