SUBJECT: PRESS CONFERENCE ON SECRETARY HAIG'S VENEZUELAN STOPOVER

FOLLOWING IS AN ENGLISH TRANSLATION OF REMARKS MADE BY VENEZUELAN FOREIGN MINISTER JOSE ALBERTO ZAMBRANO VELASCO AND U.S. AMBASSADOR WILLIAM H. LUERS, APRIL 15 AT THE AIRPORT PRESS CONFERENCE WHICH FULLOWED THE DEPARTURE FROM VENEZUELA OF SECRETARY OF STATE ALEXANDER HAIG:

(BEGIN TRANSLATION)

-- ZAMBRAND: I HAVE HAD THE UPPORTUNITY TO TALK WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE DURING HIS FUEL STOP IN CARACAS EN ROUTE TO BUENOS AIRES, WHERE HE WILL CUNTINUE ADVANCING HIS EFFORTS TOWARD PEACE BETWEEN ARGENTIAN AND GREAT BRITAIN.

- I HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO HEEAR THE PRESENTATION OF SOME OF THE FACTORS WHICH FORM THE CORE OF THE POSSIBLE SOLUTION. OF COURSE I ALSO EXPRESSED THE VIEWS WHICH VENEZUELA HAS BEEN SUSTAINING. ALL OF THIS ALLOWED US TO MAKE A MOST CONSTRUCTIVE ANALYSIS OF THE SITUATION AND EMPHASIZE OUR HOPE THAT HE WILL BE ABLE TO RESOLVE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE THIS CONFRONTATION AFFECTING DUR HEMISPHERE. WE ALSO REVIEWED SOME QUESTIONS

RELATED TO THE REGION AND TO DUR CURRENTLY EXCELLENT BILATERAL

-- LUERS: THE VISIT OFFERED US THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONTINUE THE CONVERSATIONS WE HAVE MAINTAINED WITH VENEZUELA, CONSULTING AND EXCHANGING IDEAS ABOUT THE PROBLEMS OF THE NATIONS IN THIS HEMISPHERE.

-- IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE LISTENED TO THE MINISTER IN ORDER TO KNOW VENEZUELA'S POSITION AND ITS VIEWS ON THE PROBLEMS WE ARE NOW FACING.

-- QUESTION: IS THERE ANY POSSIBILITY THAT VENEZUELA MIGHT SOFTEN ITS POSITION OF FIRM SUPPURT FOR ARGENTINA?
-- LUERS: WE DID NOT CONSIDER THIS POSITION. THIS WAS AN EXCHANGE OF IDEAS IN WHICH THE MINISTER EXPRESSED THE POSITION OF VENEZUELA, ITS CONCERNS AND ITS INTERESTS, AS DID WE ALSO.
-- QUESTION: WHAT DID THE SECRETARY SAY REGARDING THE POSSIBILITY THAT ARGENTINA DOES'T ACCEPT HIS PROPOSALS?
-- LUERS: NO, WE DID NOT TALK ABOUT THIS. HE IS WORKING HARD TO SUCCEED, BECAUSE ALL OF US KNOW THIS IS A VERY IMPORTANT MOMENT. BOTH OF US, THE MINISTER AND I, WERE HIGHLY IMPRESSED WITH HIS SERIOUSNESS AND HIS DETERMINATION TO WORK VERY HARD TO ACHIEVE HIS GOLAS.

- -- QUESTION: WHAT KIND OF PROPOSALS IS THE SECRETARY TAKING WITH HIM?
- -- LUERS: WE CAN NOT ENTER INTO THUSE DETAILS.
- -- QUESTION: ARE THERE CERTAIN CONDITIONS FOR REACHING AN AGREEMENT?
- -- LUERS: WELL, WE CAN NOT REALLY TALK IN DEPTH ABOUT WHAT THE SECRETARY SAID...
- -- QUESTION: DO YOU BELIEVE ARGENTINA AND ENGLAND CAN REACH AN AGREEMENT?
- -- LUERS: WELL, FROM OUR MEETING, WE KNOW THE ASPECTS OF THE PROBLEMS BEING FACED BY THE NEGOTIATURS AT THIS VERY MOMENT. BUT WE CAN NOT TALK ANY FURTHER...
- -- QUESTION: CHANCELLOR WAS THE SECRETARY MORE OPTIMISTIC THAN HE WAS AT FIRST?
- -- ZAMBRAND: I WANT TO TELL YOU THAT INSTEAD OF RECOUNTING THE CONVERSATIONS, IT IS MURE IMPORTANT TO REFLECT ON THE QUESTIONS ARISING FOR OUR COUNTRY OUT OF THIS CONFRONTATION. IT IS EVIDENT THAT VENEZUELAN PUBLIC OPINION HAS A VERY SPECIAL SENSITIVITY ABOUT THIS PROBLEM BECAUSE WE HAVE ALSO SUFFERED SITUATIONS SIMILAR TO THUSE EXPERIENCED BY ARGENTINA. AND FURTHERMORE, IN DIFFICULT MOMENTS, VENEZUELA RECEIVED THE SUPPORT OF ARGENTINA WHEN THE DRAGO DOCTRINE WAS FORMULATED AT THE BEGINNING OF THIS CENTURY, WHEN DUR COUNTRY WAS A VICTIM OF ACTS BY EUROPEAN COUNTRIES. I BELIEVE THAT OUR POLICIES DRIENTED TOWARDS THE CARIBBEAN, TOWARDS THE ANDEAN PACT, AND TOWARDS THE INTEGRATION OF CONTINENTAL UNITY, ARE FUNDAMENTAL ELEMENTS THAT HAVE WEIGHT IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES AND THEY MUST BE SO CONSIDERED. WE ARE CONVINCED THAT WE MUST AVOID ANY CONFRONTATION AND MUST SEARCH FOR PEACEFUL SOLUTIONS AS SECRETARY HAIG IS DOING. THIS IS A WORK WE MUST STIMULATE IN ORDER TO FIND SATISFACTORY AND PRACTICAL SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEMS AND IN THIS WAY ERADICATE THE PHANTOM OF WAR AND THE SEQUENCE OF DISASTERS WHICH WOULD CERTAINLY AFFECT NOT ONLY THOSE COUNTRIES INVOLVED IN THE CONFRONTATION, BUT THE WHOLE

-- ZAMBRAND: I HAVE SAID WE ARE NOT UNDERTAKING TO RECOUNT THE CONVERSATIONS BUT RATHER WE ARE REFLECTING ON THESE THEMES SO WE CAN FIND THE CONSTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS WE ALL

-- UQESTION: THERE IS AN EVIDENT CONTRADICTION BETWEEN THE POSITIONS OF VENEZUELA AND THE UNITED STATES. VENEZUELA CONTINUES SUPPORTING THE ARGENTINIAN POSITION. THE UNITED STATES APPARENTLY REMAINS NEUTRAL IN THIS CRISIS. IS THERE A POSSIBILITY OF DETERIORATION IN THE RELATIONS BETWEEN VENEZUELA AND THE UNITED STATES BECAUSE OF THIS?

-- ZAMRANO: WE ARE GOING TO CONCENTRATE ON THE POSITIVE PART, ON THE CONSTRUCTIVE PART, AND THIS IS PRECISELY THE SEARCH FOR PEACE. THIS IS THE KIND OF EFFORT THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE IS MAKING AND HE DESERVES ALL OUR SUPPORT.

-- QUESTION: ARE YOU MORE OPTIMISTIC NOW THAT YOU HAVE TALKED TO HAIG? OR MORE PESSIMISTIC?

-- ZAMBRAND: THIS IS NOT A QUESTION OF BEING OPTIMISTIC OR PESSIMIS

THIS IS A VERY FLUID SITUATION AND IT IS NECESSARY TO CONSIDER IT VERY CAREFULLY, TO ANALYZE IT STEP BY STEP AND OF COURSE, WITH A COOL MIND AND CLEAR IDEAS.

-- QUESTION: WHAT WOULD BE THE BASIS FOR A PEACEFUL AGREEMENT? -- ZAMRAND: I AM NOT NEGOTIATING AND OF COURSE I CAN NOT SAY ANYTHING ABOUT OUR CONVERSATIONS WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE BECAUSE THESE ARE VERY PRIVATE CUNVERSATIONS ABOUT THE NEGOTIA-TIONS.

-- QUESTION: COULD THERE BE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN BOTH COUNTRIES? -- ZAMBRAND: MAY OF THE ELEMENTS AT STAKE HAVE APPEARED IN THE WORLD MEDIA. SO I SHOULD REFER YOU TO THEM. (END TRANSLATION) LUERS
