- 3. A SPUKESMAN FOR MUTUAL SAID THE TAPES WOULD BE BROADCAST OVER THE RADIO NETWORK BEGINNING TOMORROW. A PARTIAL TRANSCRIPT WAS RELEASED BY THE NETWORK.
- 4. ACCORDING TO MR. ANDERSON, MR. REAGAN IS QUOTED AS SAYING: "IN THOSE TALKS, IF IT'S HELPFUL AT ALL DON'T HOLD BACK ON MAKING ME THE BAD GUY AND INSISTING ON RESTRAINT IF THAT'S NECESSARY."
