1. IAEA HAS CIRCULATED TO ALL MEMBERS TRANSLATION OF
LETTER FROM ARGENTINIAN IAEA GOVERNOR CASTRO MADERO
DRAWING ATTENTION TO INDICATIONS THAT BRITISH FLEET IN
SOUTH ATLANTIC MAY CONTAIN "NUCLEAR MATERIAL FOR
MILITARY PURPOSES." ALTHOUGH IT CALLS ON AGENCY TO
"ACT...TO PROMOTE PEACE AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION,"
IT IS NOT EVIDENT THAT ARGENTINES DESIRE ANYTHING
FURTHER FROM IAEA THAN LETTER'S CIRCULATION.

SECRETARIAT IS NOW CONSIDERING ITS IMPLICATIONS.

2. TEXT OF LETTER WAS CONTAINED IN ONE FROM ARGENTINE
AMBASSADOR IN VIENNA DATED APRIL 16 (RECEIVED BY IAEA
SECRETARIAT APRIL 20) WHICH REQUESTED ITS CIRCULATION.
TEXT FOLLOWS:

I AM WRITING TO INFORM YOU OF THE CONCERN FELT BY THE
ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT AT THE POSSIBILITY THAT NUCLEAR
MATERIALS MAY BE PRESENT ON THE BRITISH FLEET WHICH IS
SAILING TOWARDS THE SOUTH ATLANTIC.

REPORTS IN THE MEDIA, WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN DENIED, INDICATE
THAT NUCLEAR MATERIAL FOR MILITARY PURPOSES IS PRESENT ON
THE ENGLISH SHIPS, WHOSE MOVEMENTS HAVE BEEN PROMPTED BY
THE DISPUTE CONCERNING SOVEREIGNTY OVER THE FALKLAND
ISLANDS.

THE PURPOSE OF THE AGENCY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE II
OF ITS STATUTE, IS TO SEEK TO ACCELERATE AND ENLARGE THE
CONTRIBUTION OF ATOMIC ENERGY TO PEACE, HEALTH AND
PROSPERITY THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. IT IS LIKEWISE THE

STEEL, THE LIBERAL LEADER, SAID THAT THE WISHES OF THE ISLANDERS SHOULD NOT BE MADE PARAMOUNT", AND CONCLUDED THAT "THESE DISAGREEMENTS MAY BECOME GREATER IF ARMED CONFLICT OCCURS." 2. TODAY'S EDITORIALS FOCUS ON HOW BEST THE GOVERNMENT CAN CONTINUE THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS IN WHICH THEY DISPLAY DIFFERING VIEWS ON WHAT SHOULD CONSTITUTE THE GOVERNMENT'S NEGOTIATING STANCE. WHILE THE POPULARS ALL ADHERE DOGGEDLY TO THE LINE THAT ARGENTINE TROOPS MUST BE UNCONDITIONALLY WITHDRAWN AS AN ABSOLUTE PREREQUISITE TO FURTHER TALKS, THE QUALITIES ARE AGAIN SPLIT OVER HOW RESOLUTELY THE UK SHOULD PURSUE HER INTERESTS AND HONOR IN THE CRISIS. THE TIMES NOTED THAT WHILE BRITAIN WILL UNDOUBTEDLY SUFFER IN HER RELATIONS WITH LATIN AMERICA, ANY DAMAGE TO UK INTERESTS MUST BE WEIGHED AGAINST THE LARGER INTEREST OF INTERNATIONAL LAW. THE GUARDIAN, HOWEVER, THINKS THAT PRINCIPLE AND REALITY DO NOT SIT EASILY, ESPECIALLY WHEN ONE IS DIVORCED FROM THE OTHER. IT SAYS THAT MR. HAIG HAS ACHIEVED A GREAT DEAL, EXCEPT FOR THOSE WHOSE NEGOTIATING EXPECTATION WERE PITCHED BEYOND REALITY, AND THAT SINCE SHE CAN NEVER CALM THOSE BACKBENCHERS WHO BACK RE-INVASION, MRS. THATCHER SHOULD THINK ABOUT DAMAGE LIMITATION WITH TOLERABLE HONOR. 2. WINDING UP A TWO AND ONE HALF HOUR URGENCY DEBATE IN THE EP PLENARY IN STRASBOURG ON APRIL 21, EC COUNCIL PRESIDENT TINDEMANS PAID WARM TRIBUTE TO SECRETARY HAIG'S EFFORTS TO ACHIEVE A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT IN THE FALKLAND ISLANDS DISPUTE. TO THOSE EURO-MP'S WHO QUESTIONED WHY THE EC HAD NOT MADE A MEDIATION EFFORT, TINDEMANS SAID THAT IT WAS HARDLY POSSIBLE FOR THE EC TO MEDIATE BETWEEN ONE OF ITS MEMBER STATES AND A FOREIGN POWER. ACCORDING TO B.A. DAILY "LA NACION", SAINT JEAN AND SECRETARY OF THE PRESIDENCY GENERAL IGLESIAS DESCRIBED IN CONSIDERABLE DETAIL THE CONTENTS OF "WORKING PAPERS" DISCUSSED WITH THE SECRETARY, GALTIERI'S CONVERSATIONS WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN AND ALLEGED PRESSURE THAT THE USG WAS

7. ARGENTINE GOVERNOR OF THE MALVINAS, GENERAL MARIO BENJAMIN MENENDEZ TOLD THE PRESS APR 20 "I AM NOT LEAVING THE ISLANDS." IN A PARTICULARLY TOUGH STATEMENT, MENENDEZ SAID THAT HIS SOLDIERS ARE "EAGER TO ENTER INTO COMBAT TO DEFEND ARGENTINE SOVEREIGNTY" AND "THEY ARE PREPARED TO FACE WHATEVER MAY COME." HE NOTED THAT "GENERAL GALTIERI AND THE JUNTA DESIGNATED ME AS GOVERNOR. I DID NOT COME AS A TOURIST. I AM NOT LEAVING."

8. LOCAL TV AND RADIO IS REPORTING THAT THE BRITISH FLEET HAS REDUCED ITS SAILING SPEED TO EIGHT KNOTS, PRESUMABLY TO ALLOW MORE TIME FOR THE SECRETARY'S EFFORTS TO BEAR FRUIT.
