ON MONDAY MORNING, MAY 24

1. SUMMARY: IN A DAY OF LOW-KEY DEBATE, UGANDA, ZAIRE, KENYA, LAOS, LIBERIA, GREECE AND CHINA ADDRESSED THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

2. UGANDAN PERMREP SAID HIS COUNTRY VOTED FOR 502 BECAUSE IT OPPOSES THE USE OF FORCE. SINCE APRIL 3 THE CRISIS HAS ESCALATED. HE REAFFIRMED 502 IN ALL ITS ASPECTS, BUT SAID UGANDA CANNOT ACCEPT THE USE OF FORCE TO SOLVE DISPUTES. AS AN SC MEMBER, UGANDA CALLS ON THE PARTIES TO CEASE ALL HOSTILITIES AND RESUME NEGOTIATIONS; AND URGES THE SC TO CALL ON THE SYG TO RESUME HIS MEDIATION IN THE CONTEXT OF 502. UGANDAN POSITION IS THAT NEGOTIATIONS ARE THE ONLY WAY TO RESOLVE THE CONFLICT.

3. PERMREP OF ZAIRE SAID TWO FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES GUIDE ZAIRE'S APPROACH: NON-USE OF FORCE AND PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES. THE MALVINAS WAR IS IN A NEW AND CRITICAL PHASE. ZAIRE WELCOMED THE UK STATEMENT THAT NUCLEAR WEAPONS WOULD NOT BE USED. HOWEVER, ONE PARTY HAS AND THE OTHER IS DEVELOPING SUCH WEAPONRY. AN IMPERFECT SETTLEMENT OUT OF COURT IS OFTEN BETTER THE SAFEGUARDS OF SMALL STATES, BUT SUCH LAW IS UNPERFECTED AND IS NOT ENFORCEABLE. A NEW INTERNATIONAL ORDER IS NEEDED BASED ON THE NORMATIVE LAW OF UN RESOLUTIONS LIKE 1514 (DECOLONIZATION). UK HAS DECOLONIZED WORLDWIDE AND MUST DO SO HERE, BUT ITS HAND IS BEING FORCED BY A

USE OF FORCE IS, AS ARGENTINA HAS SAID IN THE PAST, CONTRARY TO THE CHARTER. ARGENTINA CANNOT IMPOSE ITS CLAIMS ON THE PEOPLE OF THE FALKLANDS. KENYA'S VIEW IS THAT WHILE TERRITORIES MAY BE BOUGHT AND SOLD, PEOPLE CANNOT.

5. LAO P.D.R. REP MADE AN UTTERLY PREDICTABLE DIATRIBE, EMPHASIZING COLONIAL NATURE OF FALKLANDS CRISIS.

6. LIBERIAN REP SAID THERE IS SOME MERIT ON EACH SIDE AND THE NATIONAL HONOR OF EACH PARTY INVOLVED MUST BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT. THE CRISIS MUST BE HANDLED WITHIN THE RULE OF LAW. LIBERIA REGRETS PANAMA'S DEROGATORY REFERENCE TO FEMALE GLANDS.

7. GREEK REP STATED HIS COUNTRY TAKES NO POSITION ON THE SOVEREIGNTY ISSUE, BUT INVASION CANNOT BE CONDONED.

8. CHINESE PERMREP, SPEAKING IN HIS NATIONAL CAPACITY, SAID THE PARTY WITH SUPERIOR MILITARY CAPACITY HAS TAKEN A TOUGH STAND. THE MALVINAS ARE A LEGACY OF COLONIALISM. THE U.N. HAS ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS ON THE DECOLONIZATION OF THE FALKLANDS. ESCALATION THREATENS THE PEACE. NEGOTIATIONS COULD ACHIEVE A FAIR SETTLEMENT OF THE DISPUTE. CHINA HOPES THE SYG WILL REMAIN (SIC.) ACTIVE IN SETTLING THE DISPUTE. THE SC SHOULD SUPPORT HIM.

5. WITH THAT OUR TWO COUNTRIES SHOWED THE WORLD
COMMUNITY THAT TO PERSIST NOWADAYS IN COLONIAL
SITUATIONS OR IN SITUATIONS OF TERRITORIAL
OCCUPATION,

BESIDES BEING MORALLY HURTFUL, CONSTITUTES
AN UNLAWFUL ACT WHICH VIOLATES THE PEACEFUL
COEXISTENCE AMONG NATIONS AND BECOMES A PRIMARY
CAUSE FOR FURTHER CONFLICTS. IT MEANS THAT,
IN THE COMMUNITY OF THE AMERICAS AND IN THE WORLD
COMMUNITY, COLONIALISM, THE ALIGNMENT (SIC;
ALIENATION ?) OF THE PATRIMONIAL RESOURCES OF EACH
NATION, AS WELL AS ECONOMIC INEQUALITY AND

OCCUPATION OF THE MALVINAS AND THEIR DEPENDENCIES.
ARGENTINA'S CONDUCT IN ORDER TO REVINDICATE
ITS HONOR AND NATIONAL INTERESTS HAS NOT BEEN
THE CAUSE BUT RATHER HAS BEEN THE RESULT

8. ARGENTINA HAS ACTED IN THE LEGITIMATE DEFENSE OF ITS HISTORIC RIGHTS AND HAS DONE SO IN ORDER TO DIRECT ITS CASE AS INDICATED BY LAW AND INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS. THE USE OF VIOLENCE HAS CHARACTERIZED THE BRITISH RESPONSES NOT ONLY IN THE UNACCUSTOMED MOBILIZATION OF FORCE BUT ALSO IN THE HUMILIATING INTENSIFICATION OF MILITARY PRESSURE AND IN THE ORCHESTRATION OF ACTS OF ECONOMIC AGGRESSION DURING THIS NEW PERIOD OF NEGOTIATIONS. THE EXCESSIVE USE OF FORCE HAS ONCE AGAIN PLACED IN DOUBT THE SINCERITY OF THE BRITISH DISPOSITION TO WORK OUT A DIPLOMATIC SOLUTION.

9. THE CAUSE OF COLONIALISM, AND THE USE OF FORCE INVARIABLY ASSOCIATED WITH IT, IS A BAD CAUSE. WE LATIN AMERICANS HAVE HAD TO LAMENT THAT OUR FRIENDS IN THE UNITED STATES NOW FIND THEMSELVES IDENTIFIED WITH THAT CAUSE ON ACCOUNT OF THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE VIOLENCE WHICH THE BRITISH ARE CARRYING OUT AGAINST ARGENTINA. TO AID THE USE OF FORCE WITH ACTIONS IS NOT THE BEST WAY TO DEFEND THE PRINCIPLE OF LAW. RATHER IF THAT DECISIVE SUPPORT HAD NOT BEEN GIVEN, IT WOULD HAVE BEEN MORE FEASIBLE TO ACHIEVE A NEGOTIATED AGREEMENT FOR THE PEACEFUL SOLUTION OF THAT DISPUTE. THE SEARCH FOR A WORTHY AND JUST SOLUTION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PRINCIPLE OF LAW, REQUIRES THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL BACKING FOR THE EXERCISE OF FORCE BY THE UNITED KINGDOM, WHICH HAS MADE IT (THE EXERCISE OF FORCE) INTO ITS PRINCIPAL

10. TO ATTEMPT TO END THE QUARREL BY MILITARY MEANS WILL RESULT ONLY IN BURDENING THE PRESENT WITH INSULTS AND INJURIES AND IN DARKENING THE FUTURE WITH FRUSTRATIONS, RESENTMENTS AND RENEWED DISPUTES WHICH WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCE OF THE ERRORS THAT ARE NOW BEING COMMITTED.

11. ONE OF THESE ERRORS HAS BEEN THAT OF ABANDONING THE DOCTRINE WHICH PRESIDENT MONROE ENUNCIATED A CENTURY AND A HALF AGO AND WHICH, DEFENDED BY ADAMS, JEFFERSON AND CLAY, WAS THE INSPIRATION AND GUIDE FOR THE FOREIGN POLICY OF SUBSEQUENT GENERATIONS OF NORTH AMERICANS. THAT DOCTRINE, WHICH ON OCCASION WAS BADLY INTERPRETED OR BADLY USED TO JUSTIFY NORTH AMERICAN INTERVENTIONS IN OUR COUNTRIES-- INTERPRETATION OR BAD USE WHICH WE WILL ALWAYS REJECT-- WAS THE BULWARK FOR DEMOCRACY AND FOR THE UNITY OF THE PEOPLES OF THE NEW WORLD AGAINST THE EXPANSIONIST DESIGNS OF EXTRA-CONTINENTAL POWERS. AS SUCH IT WAS THE FOUNDATION FOR HEMISPHERIC RELATIONS THAT WERE WITHOUT PRECEDENT IN THE HISTORY OF PEOPLES, AS IT UNITED NORTH AND SOUTH IN ONE SET OF LIBERTARIAN DESIRES.

12. AS THE MONROE DOCTRINE HAS TODAY BEEN BROKEN BY THOSE WHO OUGHT TO HAVE BEEN ITS PRINCIPAL GUARDIANS, THE INTERESTS OF THE PEOPLES OF THE TWO AMERICAS NOW CONFRONT EACH OTHER, BY VIRTUE OF THIS PECULIAR IDENTIFICATION OF THE UNITED STATES WITH THE DEATH RATTLES OF EUROPEAN COLONIALISM. ALTHOUGH IT MAY SEEM PARADOXICAL, FROM NOW ON, WE LATIN AMERICANS MUST BE THE INHERITORS AND SPOKESMEN OF THAT WISE PRINCIPLE WHICH IN TIMES PAST ILLUMINATED NORTH AMERICAN POLICY. THAT FACT NATURALLY AFFECTS THE UNDERSTANDING WHICH WE SHALL HAVE IN THE FUTURE OF HEMISPHERIC RELATIONS.

13. RECOGNIZING THE AUTHENTIC RIGHTS WHICH ARGENTINA HAS TO RECOVER THE MALVINAS AND THEIR DEPENDENCIES, MY GOVERNMENT HAS ALWAYS SUPPORTED THEIR DECOLONIZATION, WITHOUT ABANDONING OUR ATTACHMENT TO PEACE, WE REPEAT THAT THE ONLY WAY TO SET THE SOLUTION ON A JURIDICAL PATH IS THROUGH THE RECOGNITION OF ARGENTINE SOVEREIGNTY AND THE DETERMINATION OF THE RESIDUAL RIGHTS WHICH ITS OCCUPANTS MAY HAVE ACQUIRED.
