MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

PAUSE IN THE FIGHTING, NOR HAD ANY DEADLINE OF ANY KIND BEEN SET.... THE UNITED STATES' POSITION ON THE CRISIS REMAINED UNCHANGED. 'WE GIVE OUR FULL SUPPORT TO THE NON-FIRST USE OF FORCE TO RESOLVE DISPUTES OF THIS KIND.'" THE FINANCIAL TIMES SAYS, "(HAIG) EMPHASIZED IN THE CLEARST POSSIBLE TERMS THAT THE WITHDRAWAL OF ARGENTINE FORCES FROM THE FALKLANDS WAS THE ONLY WAY FURTHER BLOODSHED ON THE ISLANDS COULD BE AVOIDED. 6. THE FUTURE; LONG-TERM MILITARY IMPLICATIONS ARE BEING EXAMINED WITH SOME CONCERN. THE TIMES DEFENSE CORRESPONDENT HENRY STANHOPE NOTES THAT NATO SO FAR HASN'T BEEN OVERLY PERTURBED BY THE WITHDRAWAL OF BRITISH FORCES TO THE SOUTH ATLANTIC.
