

SUBJECT: Your Meeting with Kuwaiti Prime Minister and Crown Prince Sa'ad Al-Abdullah Al-Salim Al Sabah, Tuesday, July 12 at 11.30 a.m.

1. WHERE DOES THE RELATIONSHIP STAND?

- o U.S.-Kuwaiti cooperation in the escort operation has strengthened the bilateral relationship.
- o Kuwait provides important political, logistical, and financial support to our forces in the Gulf.
- o Kuwait's request for F-18 aircraft is a political act signifying Kuwait's desire for a long-term military supply relationship with the U.S. and its willingness to share the burden for its own and Gulf defense.
- o Both countries support efforts in the UN to bring Iran to the negotiating table.
- o We share a concern for the need to combat terrorism and a policy of no negotiations with or concessions to terrorists.
- o Kuwait and the U.S. have a common interest in the stability of the world financial community.

2. WHAT DO WE WANT?

- o Kuwaiti pressure on hesitant members of the UNSC to press forward on an enforcement resolution for 598.

3. WHAT DOES SA'AD WANT?

- o A firm U.S. commitment to Kuwait's stability and security.

- o A detailed assessment of the peace process and its prospects for success.
- o Guarantees for the security of their investments in the U.S.

4. WHAT CAN BE ACHIEVED?

- o Reaffirm our commitment to our Gulf policy and to U.S.-Kuwaiti cooperation in furthering that policy.
- o Underscore our commitment to providing Kuwait the means to defend itself.
- o Foster greater understanding of our position on the peace process and an international conference.
- o Formalize counterterrorism cooperation.
- o Secure a commitment to aiding national reconstruction in Afghanistan and the GOK's commitment not to expand relations with the Kabul regime.
- o Exchange views on responsible petroleum and financial policies.
