

Swiss Deputy FM, Edouard Brunner, will be in Washington October 2-7 and has requested a meeting with Admiral Poindexter. Brunner is a staunch friend of the United States and a valued interlocutor on European security issues (especially CDE and CSCE). Although he is the deputy FM, in fact he functions more as the Minister (FM Aubert's position is more ceremonial).

Brunner met with Bud last year but that was primarily because the meeting fell a month before the Reagan-Gorbachev Summit in Geneva. We do not recommend that JMP see him this time, but do feel it would be very useful for you to chair a session in the Situation Room on European security issues ~~with Brunner~~. Bill Cockell and ~~Sven Kraemer~~ would attend, and Jack Matlock would meet with him later to discuss East-West issues.

There will be a fairly large dinner for Brunner on October 2nd which I will attend. The Swiss Embassy Charge, David de Pury, is having a smaller dinner October 6, to which you have been invited (on my recommendation).

I. PURPOSE

To meet briefly with Swiss Justice Minister and future President of Switzerland.

II. BACKGROUND

Ed Meese has asked to bring in Mrs. Elizabeth Koop, currently the Swiss Justice Minister, who is visiting the AG to sign an MOU on judicial and SEC cooperation. Under the Swiss rotating Presidency she is expected to become the President of Switzerland in 1990. She is the first woman to attain cabinet rank and will be the first female President of the Swiss Confederation. A leader of the centrist Liberal party, Switzerland's largest, Mrs. Koop -- a distant relative of Under Secretary of Defense Fred Ikle -- is well-disposed toward the U.S.
