-- THE NATURE OF THE POSSIBLE MILITARY ACTION WAS NOT CLEAR BUT CRAXI BELIEVED IT MIGHT BE DIFFICULT TO LIMIT IT, ON THE GROUND OR POLITICALLY, TO THE PERPETRATORS OF THE ATROCITY AGAINST THE U.S. MNF CONTINGENT. THIS WAS SO, IN CRAXI'S VIEW, BECAUSE SOME CIVILIAN BYSTANDERS MIGHT BE HURT AND BECAUSE ANY MILITARY ACTION, AT THIS TIME WHEN PROSPECTS FOR A NEGOTIATED SOLUTION IN LEBANON REMAINED SLIM, COULD BE SEIZED AS A PRETEXT TO WITHDRAW FROM NEGOTIATIONS AND MIGHT CONCEIVABLY TRIGGER MORE VIOLENCE.

--CRAXI FULLY UNDERSTOOD WHY THE UNITED STATES WAS CONTEMPLATING SUCH MEASURES. HOWEVER, THE MEASURES COULD AFFECT OTHER MNF PARTNERS AS WELL, WHICH ALSO DICTATED CAUTION.

--CRAXI HIMSELF HAD RECEIVED REPORTS ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF FURTHER TERRORIST ACTS. HE THOUGHT THAT THE MNE SHOULD PAY UTMOST ATTENTION TO SELF-DEFENSE AND PROTECTIVE MEASURES, AND SHOULD OF COURSE PLAN TO COUNTER-ATTACK DURING ANY TERRORIST ATTACK.

--HOWEVER, WHILE CRAXI WAS VERY SYMPATHETIC TO THE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE HE THOUGHT THAT MILHTARY ACTION AT THIS MOMENT COULD BE VERY DANGEROUS FOR THE REASONS STATED ABOVE.

2. PADINI SAID THAT AS OF NOW HE AND THE PRIME MINISTER WERE THE ONLY PERSONS IN THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT AWARE OF THE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE; HE ASSUMED CRAXI MIGHT INFORM THE FOREIGN MINISTER.

DEAR PRIME MINISTER:

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

WE UNDERSTAND THAT THE ITALIAN EMBASSY INFORMED THE DEPARTMENT TODAY, DECEMBER 17. THAT A CRAXI LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT HAD BEEN SENT TO US ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 15, AND THAT THE ITALIAN EMBASSY IS NOT SEND-ING THE LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT. WE RECEIVED A XEROX COPY OF THE LETTER WITH A З. NOTE FOR THE AMBASSADOR. AN EMBASSY TRANSLATION FOLLOWS: QUOTE: DEAR RON; ON RETURNING FROM MY VISITS, WHICH I MADE TOGETHER WITH FOREIGN MINISTER ANDREOTTI DURING THE PAST WEEKS TO CATRO RIYADH, ALGIERS AND TUNIS, I WISH TO SHAR WITH YOU SOME IMPRESSIONS AND JUDGEMENTS TAKEN PAR-I WISH TO SHARE TICULARLY FROM THE TALKS I HAD WITH PRESIDENT MUBARAK, KING FAHD, WITH PRESIDENT BENDJEDID, WITH PRESIDENT BOURGHIBA AND WITH PRIME MINISTER M'ZALI AND WITH ARAFAT. FROM MY EXCHANGES OF VIEWS, VERY INTENSE AND DEEP, THERE EMERGED AN ANXIOUS AND WORRYING (PREOCCUPATO E PROCCUPANTE) PICTURE OF THE SITUATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST, CONCERNING ABOVE ALL THE ARAB-ISRAELI DISPUTE AND THE PALESTINE QUESTION, WHICH REMAIN -- FOR ALL THE GOVERNMENTS CONSULTED -- THE CENTRAL POINT OF THE REGION'S PROBLEM. OUR INTERLOCUTORS KEPT EXPRESSING TO US THEIR STRONG UNEASE AT THE PROLONGED STAGNATION IN THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS. THEY PERCEIVED IN THAT A IN THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS. THE FERCENCE TO THAT A HIGH POTENTIAL OF DANGER AND OF RISK ON TWO POINTS. ON THE ONE HAND, BECAUSE THE STALEMATE FEEDS FEELINGS OF FRUSTRATION IN THE ARAB POPULATIONS AND, FAVORING THE DIFFUSION OF POLITICAL AND RELIGIOUS RADICALISM, DECLASSIFIED COMES TO REPRESENT A GROWING THREAT TO THE STABILITY NLRR M08-222 62079

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AND SECURITY OF THE MODERATE ARAB COUNTRIES. ON THE OTHER HAND, BECAUSE IT <u>RE-ENFORCES THE INFLUENCE</u> OF <u>THE MOST INTRANSIGENT ARAB GOVERNM</u>ENTS AGAINST THE NEGOTIATION OPTION.

I WAS ABLE TO GATHER, <u>PARTICULARLY FROM THE EGYPTIANS</u> AND SAUDIS, THE CLEAREST SYMPTOMS OF DISCOMEORT FOR WHAT THEY JUDGE AS A LACK OF INITIATIVE ON THE PART OF THE WESTERN COUNTRIES -- AND THE UNITED STATES PRI-MARILY -- FOR A RESUMPTION OF THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS. MUBARAK AND FAHD EXPRESSED THEMSELVES IN BITTER TONES. WHICH SEEMED TO ME ALL THE MORE NOTEWORTHY IN VIEW OF THEIR VISIBLY RESERVED AND TEMPERED SENTIMENTS OF GREAT FRIENDSHIP, LOYAL AND SINCERE, TOWARD YOU AND YOUR COUNTRY.

IN CAIRO AND RIYADH THERE WAS THUS A VERY VIVID EXPEC-TATION, AFTER THE PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS IN ISRAEL AND THE PRESIDENTIAL ONES IN THE UNITED STATES, OF A VIGOR-OUS RESUMPTION OF THE WESTERN INITIATIVE FOR A PLAN OF NEGOTIATIONS. I NOTED EVERYWHERE HOW THE EXTRAORDINARY AFFIRMATION THAT YOU RECEIVED FROM THE AMERICAN ELEC-TORATE WAS VALUED AND WELCOMED AS A VERY POSITIVE ELE-MENT. THEY RECALLED WITH FAVOR THE REAGAN PLAN OF SEPTEMBER 1982, AND THE REAFFIRMATION THAT YOU MADE IN YOUR SPEECH AT THE UN LAST SEPTEMBER WAS APPRECIATED.

THEY EXPECT NOW, IN THE FORM OF APPROPRIATE ACTS AND DECISIONS. THAT YOU WILL COMPLETE YOUR CONSTRUCTIVE DESIGN FOR THE MIDDLE EAST. A CONFIDENT EXPECTATION IS THEREFORE TURNED PRIMARILY TOWARD THE UNITED STATES, WHOSE ROLE CONTINUES TO BE CONSIDERED FUNDAMENTAL FOR THE ACHIEVEMENT OF A JUST AND GLOBAL PEACE SOLUTION. BUT THEY TURN ALSO TOWARD THE COUNTRIES OF THE EURO-PEAN COMMUNITY AND TO ITALY, WHICH IS PREPARING TO

ASSUME THE PRESIDENCY AND WHOSE TRADITIONAL COMMITMENT IN THE MIDDLE EAST HAS RECEIVED FULL AND EXPLICIT RECOGNITION.

IT SEEMED TO ME THAT, IN THE FRAMEWORK OF A MORE INCI-SIVE WESTERN ACTION IN THE MIDDLE EAST, THE CAIRO GOVERNMENT IS MOVING DECISIVELY, TAKING COURAGE FROM THE PROGRESSIVE REINSERTION OF EGYPT IN THE ISLAMIC AND ARABIC CONTEXT. THE OBJECTIVE THAT CAIRO POINTS TO (AND FOR WHICH RIYADH ALSO IS AVAILABLE, ALTHOUGH AT THE SAME TIME MAINTAINING A MORE CAUTIOUS POSITION) BT

AS CONCERNS THE MODERATE ARAB COUNTRIES, THEY DID NOT UNDERESTIMATE THE ROLE AND IMPORTANCE OF SYRIA, EVEN KNOWING OF THE DIFFERING SYRIAN POSITIONS. NO ONE INTENDS TO BEGIN A NEGOTIATION WITH PRECONCEIVED ELE-MENTS OF HOSTILITY WITH REGARD TO THE COUNTRIES OF THE AREA, THESE ALSO BEING PART OF THE CONTROVERSY. IN OU AREA, THESE ALSO BEING PART OF THE CONTROLLAST. VIEW, MAINTAINING A DIALOGUE WITH DAMASCUS THUS REMAINS VIEW. IMPORTANT, WHICH ON THE AMERICAN SIDE WAS EFFICACIOUSLY UNDERTAKEN AND FROM WHICH CAN EMERGE IN THE FIRST PLACE A CONSTRUCTIVE SYRIAN CONTRIBUTION TO THE SOLUTION OF THE LEBANESE PROBLEM. BUT THE REAL IMPULSE TO NEGOLIATE, I BELIEVE I CAN SAY, SHOULD BE CONFERRED UPON, AT LEAST IN AN INITIAL PHASE, EGYPT AND JORDAN, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE PLO HERE, THEN, WAS THE UTILITY I OBSERVED, WHILE I WAS IN TUNISIA, OF <u>MEETI</u>NG, ALONG WITH MINISTER ANDREOTTI, WITH THE PALESTINIAN LEADER. WHAT LED ME IN PARTICULAR TO SEE ARAFAT AND TO AGREE TO HAVE WITH HIM A FRANK AND CLOSE ARAFAT AND TO AGREE TO HAVE WITH HIM A FRANK AND CLOSE CONVERSATION WAS MY STRONG INTEREST, AND I THINK A LEGITIMATE SCRUPLE, TO SCRUTINIZE HIS IDEAS, HIS POLI-TICAL PERCEPTION OF THE MOST RECENT EVENTS WHICH INVOLVED THE PLO, AND ABOVE ALL THE NECESSITY TO VERIFY THE STRENGTH AND RELIABILITY OF THE SIGNS OF DIALOGUE AND NEGOTIATION WHICH, EVEN WITH CONTRASTS AND AMBIGUITIES, IN MY VIEW EMERGED IN AMMAN. THE MEETING OF THE PNC IS CERTAINLY THE FRUIT OF PRESS-

THE MEETING OF THE PNC IS CERTAINLY THE FRUIT OF PRESS-ING APPEALS DIRECTED T<u>O ARAFAT FOR HIM TO OVERCOME EVERY</u> <u>DELAY AND TO ASSUME THE INITIATIVES LINKED TO DIALOGUE</u> <u>AND NEGOTIATION: REALISTIC INITIATIVES, ABOVE ALL IN</u> THE SEARCH FOR A BASIC UNDERSTANDING, CERTAINLY ESSEN-TIAL, WITH THE HASHEMITE SOVEREIGN. AN APPEAL WHICH ARAFAT ACCEPTED, STRIVING FOR THE CONVOCATION OF THE PALESTINE NATIONAL COUNCIL AND HAVING IT TAKE PLACE IN AMMAN, WHICH REPRESENTS AN OBVIOUSLY POLITICAL CHOICE.

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IT IS NOT MY INTENTION TO ENTER INTO THE MERIT OF THE DECISIONS REACHED IN AMMAN. HOWEVER, IT IS EVIDENT THAT ARAFAI HAS SUUGHT TD CARRY OUT THE FIRST STEPS ON A PATH, WHICH IF TRAVELLED WITH CONSISTENCY AND CONVICTION, CAN CREATE CONDITIONS MORE FAVORABLE FOR A POLITICAL SOLUTION OF THE ARAB-ISRAELI CONFLICT. I SAID FIRST STEPS BECAUSE THE ROAD TO TRAVEL IS STILL LONG AND CERTAINLY FULL OF UNKNOWNS. BUT THEY ARE, HOWEVER, CERTAINLY NOT WRONG STEPS AND ONES WHICH MERIT ATTENTION AND CONSIDERATION, FOR THE DIFFICULT CHALLENGES WHICH ARAFAT HAS DECIDED TO FACE IN A RELATIVELY SHORT PERIOD OF TIME; THE CHALLENGE OF SYRIA, WHICH DID NOT WANT THE PNC TO TAKE PLACE; THE CHALLENGE OF HUSSEIN, WHO WARNED THE PLO TO UNDERTAKE DEFINITIVELY THE NEGO-TIATION OPTION, WHICH PRESENTS DIFFICULT COMPROMISES AT THE END.

NOT ALL THE QUESTIONS WERE ANSWERED AT AMMAN; AMBIGUI-TIES AND CONTRADICTIONS REMAIN. FOR MY PART, I SAID CLEARLY TO ARAFAT THAT THE PROGRESS MADE IN AMMAN WAS NOT SUFFICIENT AND THAT NEW GESTURES SHOULD BE MADE SO THAT THE PLO CAN MAKE DEFINITIVE AND IRREVERSIBLE THE CHOICE OF NEGOTIATIONS AND THE ABANDONMENT OF ARMED STRUGGLE. I SPECIFIED THAT, IN MY JUDGEMENT, IT WAS NECESSARY FOR THIS PURPOSE TO REACH A COMPREHENSIVE JORDANIAN-PALESTINIAN AGREEMENT, THE ESSENTIAL DRIVING FORCE TO PUT BACK IN MOTION A REAL PACIFICATION PROCESS, AN AGREEMENT THE CONTENTS OF WHICH COULD PRESENT LIKE-WISE UNEQUIVOCAL ANSWERS TO ALL ASPECTS CONNECTED TO THE ARAB-ISRAELI CRISIS. THUS NOT ONLY THE QUESTIONS PERTINENT TO JORDANIAN-PALESTINIAN RELATIONS, WITHIN A FUTURE INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK STILL TO BE OUTLINED AND MADE PRECISE, BUT ALSO THE TYPE AND FORM OF RELA-TIONS TO INITIATE WITH ALL STATES OF THE REGION AND

THE SPECIFIC QUESTIONS REGARDING THE SECURITY, RECOG-NITION AND THE RIGHTS OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL. I SPECI-FIED THAT UNTIL AN ACCEPTABLE JORDANIAN-PALESTINIAN PLATFORM IS ELABORATED, IT WILL BE EXTREMELY DIFFICULT FORMALLY TO CARRY OUT THOSE STEPS AND TO ASSURE THE SUPPORT THAT WOULD GIVE THE PUSH AND FORCE NECESSARY TO THE PROSPECT OF A RIGOROUS NEGOTIATING PROCESS.

US, XF SUBJECT: PRIME MINISTER'S LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT I CAN TELL YOU THAT ARAFAT AGREED WITH THIS ANALYSIS AND COMMITTED HIMSELF TO WORK OUT PROPOSALS THAT RES-POND TO THE EXIGENCIES PUT FORWARD AND OF WHICH HE IN ANY CASE WAS AWARE. THE LEADER OF THE PLO NEVERTHE-LESS THOUGHT IT IMPORTANT TO EMPHASIZE HOW FAR HE HAD COME ALONG ALREADY ON THIS PATH, NOT ONLY TO INDICATE HAD THAT EVERY FUTURE CLARIFYING GESTURE REQUIRES A CONSO-LIDATION OF HIS POSITION, BUT ALSO SIGNALS THAT IT CAN DEMONSTRATE WITHIN THE PLO, AND OUTSIDE IT, THAT THE OPTION OF DIALOGUE PAYS OFF, THAT IT CAN BE THE TRUE PATH TO A GLOBAL, LASTING AND JUST SOLUTION. THE WESTERN COUNTRIES, HE SAID, WITH WHICH THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE INTEND TO MAINTAIN SOLID AND FUNCTIONING TIES OF FRIENDSHIP AND COLLABORATION, <u>CANNOT</u>, HOWEVER, REMAIN INDIFFERENT TO ALL OF THAT WHICH, THROUGH GRAVE DIFFI-CULTIES AND MORTAL RISKS, HE AND THE PLO HAVE SUCCEEDED IN DOING. IN THAT REGARD, HE TOLD ME IN CONFIDENCE THAT THE UNDERSTANDING REACHED BETWEEN HIMSELF AND KING HUS-SEIN IS DEEPER THAN APPEARS PUBLICLY AND THAT HE HOPED THAT FUTURE FAVORABLE EVENTS COULD ILLUMINATE ALL OF ITS IMPORTANCE AND FULL SIGNIFICANCE. HE THOUGHT IT IMPORTANT TO ADD THAT THE DEMONSTRATION OF COURAGE THAT THE PLO SUCCEEDED IN GIVING BY LIBERATING ITSELF FROM CONDITIONING FORCES, PULLING ITSELF THUS OUT OF A POLI-TICAL SERVITUDE AND MANIPULATION THAT COULD HAVE EXACER-BATED THE STALLED SITUATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST, WITH A GRAVE RISK OF INSTABILITY AND NEW CONFLICTS, WAS CER-TAINLY NOT A SECONDARY FACTOR. HE INTENDED TO PURSUE PATIENT WORK IN PURSUIT OF AN ARAB CONSENSUS; HE UNDER-LINED THE IMPORTANCE OF THE EGYPTIAN ROLE, AND HE SHOWE HE SHOWED HIMSELF CONFIDENT OF BEING ABLE TO COUNT ON THE EVERMORE CONVINCED SUPPORT OF THE COUNTRIES THAT TRULY WANT TO WORK FOR THE PACIFICATION OF THE MIDDLE EAST. HE CLEARLY DEMONSTRATED IN OUR MEETING THE ABILITY TO BE OPEN. IF CONDITIONS WILL ALLOW HIM TO BE, TO UNEQUIVOCAL ACTS OF RECOGNITION OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL, BUT THAT, HE SAID, WOULD OCCUR ONLY IN THE MOMENT IN WHICH THERE WILL EMERGE WITH CLARITY THE READINESS OF EVERYONE TO PUT THEIR OWN CARDS ON THE NEGOTIATING TABLE IN THE TORMENTED AND CRUEL GAME THAT UNFORTUNATELY HAS BEEN PLAYED IN THE MIDDLE EAST FOR TOO MANY YEARS.

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I DID NOT, NEVERTHELESS, HIDE FROM ARAFAT MY PROFOUND RESERVATIONS AND PERPLEXITY OVER THE VIABILITY OF THE HYPOTHESIS OF AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE, TO TAKE PLACE EVENTUALLY UNDER THE AEGIS OF THE UN. I TOLD HIM IN ALL FRANKNESS THAT TO INSIST ON THIS OPTION WOULD MEAN TO DELAY THE POSSIBILITY OF BEGINNING THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS, WHILE IT MUST BE IN THE COMMON INTEREST TO SEEK REALISTIC AND PRAGMATIC WAYS SUCH AS THAT OF SMALL STEPS AND OF DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS.

ARAFAT DID NOT APPEAR TO ME TO BE INDIFFERENT TO THIS LINE OF REASONING, OBJECTING ONLY WITH REGARD TO HIS LACK OF FAITH IN ISRAEL'S REAL WILL TO MOVE TOWARD A BEASONABLE COMPROMISE. FOR THIS REASON HE SEES AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE AS A MEANS OF EXERCISING STRONGER AND MORE CONCENTRIC PRESSURE ON ISRAEL IN ORDER TO ATTENUATE ITS INTRANSIGENCE AND RENDER THE GOVERNMENT IN TEL AVIV MORE OPEN TO A COMPROMISE ACCEPTABLE TO THE ARAB COUNTRIES. HERE, PERHAPS, IS A FURTHER REASON TO REFLECT ON THE NEED TO IMPROVE THE CLIMATE OF CONFIDENCE WITH GESTURES THAT COULD INDICATE A READINESS TO SEEK POINTS OF CONSENSUS ON WHICH TO CONSTRUCT A MORE SOLID BASIS OF UNDERSTANDING. PERMIT ME THEN, DEAR PRESIDENT AND FRIEND, TO PUT BEFORE YOU AN INVITATION TO UNITE OUR EFFORTS TO ENCOURAGE A PROCESS OF MOVEMENT BY WHICH TO RE-ENFORCE THE SIGNALS OF DIALOGUE, AND TO PREDISPOSE OURSELVES TO EVALUATE IN A TIMELY FASHION THE MEANS AND THE FORMS FOR AN INITIA-TIVE OF OUR OWN, TO ADOPT AT A MOMENT IN WHICH THE FRAME OF REFERENCE WILL BE CLEARER AND THE TERRAIN WILL BE FREED OF AMBIGUITIES AND CONTRADICTIONS.

I BELIEVE THAT THE KNOWLEDGE THAT THE UNITED STATES AND EUROPE HAVE MANY FRIENDS AMONG THE ARAB COUNTRIES

SHOULD PUSH US IN THIS DIRECTION. OUR DUTY IS TO NOT DISAPPOINT THESE FRIENDS AND TO SHOW THEM THE MAXIMUM OPENNESS AND READINESS TO UNDERSTAND THEIR EXPECTATIONS IN A FRAMEWORK OF JUSTICE AND SECURITY FOR ALL. BUT WE CERTAINLY CANNOT HIDE FROM OURSELVES THE FACT THAT IN THE ARAB WORLD THERE ARE ALSO COUNTRIES THAT SHOW A HOSTILITY THAT CAN UNDERMINE THE PROSPECT OF PEACE AND JUSTICE WHICH INSPIRE US AND WE MUST NOT FURNISH THEM BT

THANK YOU FOR YOUR DECEMBER 16 LETTER CONVEYING YOUR

IMPRESSIONS FROM YOUR RECENT TRIPS TO THE MIDDLE EAST AND NORTH AFRICA, AND YOUR THOUGHTS ON THE ARAB-ISRAELI PEACE PROCESS.

IT REMAINS OUR BELIEF THAT THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROGRESS TOWARD A DURABLE PEACE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN ISRAEL AND ITS ARAB NEIGHBORS RESTS WITH THE PARTIES THEMSELVES, AND WE CONTINUE TO MAKE THIS POINT WITH THE PARTIES IN THE REGION. ITALY, WITH ITS SPECIAL INSIGHT ON THE MEDITERRANEAN LITTORAL, CERTAINLY UNDERSTANDS OUR APPROACH.

AS WE SET OUR COURSE FOR THE IMPORTANT WORK OF PEACE YET TO BE ACCOMPLISHED IN THE MIDDLE EAST, WE SHOULD REMEMBER THAT HIGHLY PUBLICIZED ACTIONS BY OUTSIDE POWERS, BEFORE THE PARTIES IN THE REGION HAVE TAKEN THE NECESSARY DECISIONS TO MOVE TOWARD NEGOTIATIONS, WOULD

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#### BE PREMATURE AND UNPRODUCTIVE.

DERECT NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN ISRAEL AND JORDAN IS THE ESSENTIAL STEP TO MOVE THE PEACE PROCESS FORWARD. AND I BELIEVE THAT ANYONE WHO WOULD WANT TO MAKE A POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION TO THE PEACE PROCESS SHOULD ENCOURAGE ISRAEL AND JORDAN TOWARD THAT GOAL. WE SHALL WATCH. WITH PARTICULAR INTEREST, KING HUSSEIN'S EFFORT TO ACQUIRE PALESTINTAN SUPPORT FOR HIS ENTRY INTO PEACE NEGOTIATIONS.

FOR OUR PART, WE HAVE MADE CLEAR OUR COMMITMENT TO THE POSITIONS SET FORTH IN MY SEPTEMBER 1, 1982 MIDDLE EAST INITIATIVE. THOSE POSITIONS, BASED UPON UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 242. AND FULLY CONSISTENT WI H THE CAMP DAVID FRAMEWORK, CONTINUE TO BE REALISTIC AND WORKABLE, AND COULD POINT THE WAY TO AN EQUITABLE SETTLEMENT.

WE LOOK FORWARD TO CLOSE CONSULTATIONS WITH ITALY DURING ITS PRESIDENCY OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY.

QUOTE: ON RETURNING FROM MY VISITS, WHICH I MADE TOGETHER WITH FOREIGN MINISTER ANDREOTTI DURING THE PAST WEEKS TO CAIRO, RIYADH, ALGIERS AND TUNIS, I WISH TO SHARE WITH YOU SOME IMPRESSIONS AND JUDGEMENTS TAKEN PARTICULARLY FROM THE TALKS I HAD WITH PRESIDENT MUBARAK, KING FAHD, WITH PRESIDENT BENDJEDID, WITH PRESIDENT BOURGHIBA AND WITH PRIME MINISTER M'ZALI AND WITH ARAFAT. FROM MY EXCHANGES OF VIEWS, VERY INTENSE AND DEEP, THERE EMERGED AN ANXIOUS AND WORRYING (PREOCCUPATO E PROCCUPANTE) PICTURE OF THE SITUATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST. CONCERNING ABOVE ALL THE ARAB-ISRAELI DISPUTE AND THE PALESTINE QUESTION, WHICH REMAIN -- FOR ALL THE GOVERNMENTS CONSULTED -- THE CENTRAL POINT OF THE REGION'S PROBLEM. OUR INTERLOCUTORS KEPT EXPRESSING TO US THEIR STRONG UNEASE AT THE PROLONGED STAGNATION IN THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS. THEY PERCEIVED IN THAT A HIGH POTENTIAL OF DANGER AND OF RISK ON TWO POINTS. ON THE ONE HAND, BECAUSE THE STALEMATE FEEDS FEELINGS OF FRUSTRATION IN THE ARAB POPULATIONS AND. FAVORING THE DIFFUSION OF POLITICAL AND RELIGIOUS RADICALISM, COMES TO REPRESENT A GROWING THREAT TO THE STABILITY AND SECURITY OF THE MODERATE ARAB COUNTRIES. ON THE CTHER

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HAND, BECAUSE IT REINFORCES THE INFLUENCE OF THE MOST INTRANSIGENT ARAB GOVERNMENTS AGAINST THE NEGOTIATION OPTION.

I WAS ABLE TO GATHER. PARTICULARLY FROM THE EGYPTIANS AND SAUDIS. THE CLEAREST SYMPTOMS OF DISCOMFORT FOR WHAT THEY JUDGE AS A LACK OF INITIATIVE ON THE PART OF THE WESTERN COUNTRIES--AND THE UNITED STATES PRIMARILY--FOR A RESUMPTION OF THE NEGOTIATING PROCESS. MUBARAK AND FAHD EXPRESSED THEMSELVES IN BITTER TONES. WHICH SEEMED TO ME ALL THE MORE NOTEWORTHY IN VIEW OF THEIR VISIBLY RESERVED AND TEMPERED SENTIMENTS OF GREAT FRIENDSHIP, LOYAL AND SINCERE, TOWARD YOU AND YOUR COUNTRY.

IN CAIRO AND RIYADH THERE WAS THUS A VERY VIVID EXPECTATION, AFTER THE PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS IN ISRAEL AND THE PRESIDENTIAL ONES IN THE UNITED STATES. OF A VIGOROUS RESUMPTION OF THE WESTERN INITIATIVE FOR 6.4 A PLAN OF NEGOTIATIONS. I NOTED EVERYWHERE HOW THE EXTRAORDINARY AFFIRMATION THAT YOU RECEIVED FROM THE AMERICAN ELECTORATE WAS VALUED AND WELCOMED AS A VERY POSITIVE ELEMENT. THEY RECALLED WITH FAVOR THE REAGAN PLAN OF SEPTEMBER 1982, AND THE REAFFIRMATION THAT YOU MADE IN YOUR SPEECH AT THE UN LAST SEPTEMBER WAS AP RECIATED.

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THEY EXPECT NOW, IN THE FORM OF APPROPRIATE ACTS AND Ć DECISIONS. THAT YOU WILL COMPLETE YOUR CONSTRUCTIVE DESIGN FOR THE MIDDLE EAST. A CONFIDENT EXPECTATION IS THEREFORE TURNED PRIMARILY TOWARD THE UNITED STATES.  $\mathbb{C}$ WHOSE ROLE CONTINUES TO BE CONSIDERED FUNDAMENTAL FOR

THE ACHIEVEMENT OF A JUST AND GLOBAL PEACE SOLUTION. ( . BUT THEY TURN ALSO TOWARD THE COUNTRIES OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY AND TO ITALY. WHICH IS PREPARING TO ASSUME THE PRESIDENCY AND WHOSE TRADITIONAL COMMITMENT IN THE MIDDLE EAST HAS RECEIVED FULL AND EXPLICIT RECOGNITION.

IT SEEMED TO ME THAT, IN THE FRAMEWORK OF A MORE INCISIVE WESTERN ACTION IN THE MIDDLE EAST. THE CAIRO GOVERNMENT IS MOVING DECISIVELY. TAKING COURAGE FROM THE PROGRESSIVE REINSERTION OF EGYPT IN THE ISLAMIC AND ARABIC CONTEXT. THE OBJECTIVE THAT CAIRO POINTS TO (AND FOR WHICH RIYADH ALSO IS AVAILABLE, ALTHOUGH AT THE SAME TIME MAINTAINING A MORE CAUTIOUS POSITION) IS A DEFINITIVE CLARIFICATION WITHIN THE PLO. WHICH WILL 1 ALLOW THE PALESTINIAN MOVEMENT TO DEFINE WITHOUT RETICENCE AND AMBIGUITY A POSITION OF NEGOTIATION AND OF AN UNDERSTANDING WITH JORDAN.

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AS CONCERNS THE MODERATE ARAB COUNTRIES, THEY DID NOT UNDERESTIMATE THE ROLE AND IMPORTANCE OF SYRIA, EVEN KNOWING OF THE DIFFERING SYRIAN POSITIONS. NO ONE INTENDS TO BEGIN A NEGOTIATION WITH PRECONCEIVED ELEMENTS OF HOSTILITY WITH REGARD TO THE COUNTRIES OF THE AREA, THESE ALSO BEING PART OF THE CONTROVERSY. IN OUR VIEW, MAINTAINING A DIALOGUE WITH DAMASCUS THUS REMAINS IMPORTANT, WHICH ON THE AMERICAN SIDE WAS EFFICACIOUSLY UNDERTAKEN AND FROM WHICH CAN EMERGE IN THE FIRST PLACE A CONSTRUCTIVE SYRIAN CONTRIBUTION TO THE SOLUTION OF THE LEBANESE PROBLEM. BUT THE REAL IMPULSE TO NEGOTIATE, I BELIEVE I CAN SAY, SHOULD BE CONFERRED UPON, AT LEAST IN AN INITIAL PHASE, EGYPT AND JORDAN, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE PLO.

HERE, THEN, WAS THE UTILITY I OBSERVED, WHILE I WAS IN TUNISIA, OF MEETING, ALONG WITH MINISTER ANDREOTTI, WITH THE PALESTINIAN LEADER. WHAT LED ME IN PARTICULAR TO SEE ARAFAT AND TO AGREE TO HAVE WITH HIM A FRANK AND CLOSE CONVERSATION WAS MY STRONG INTEREST, AND I THINK A LEGITIMATE SCRUPLE, TO SCRUTINIZE HIS IDEAS, HIS POLITICAL PERCEPTION OF THE MOST RECENT EVENTS WHICH INVOLVED THE PLO, AND ABOVE ALL THE NECESSITY TO VERIFY THE STRENGTH AND RELIABILITY OF THE SIGNS OF DIALOGUE AND NEGOTIATION WHICH, EVEN WITH CONTRASTS AND AMBIGUITIES, IN MY VIEW EMERGED IN AMMAN.

THE MEETING OF THE PNC IS CERTAINLY THE FRUIT OF PRESSING APPEALS DIRECTED TO ARAFAT FOR HIM TO OVERCOME EVERYDELAY AND TO ASSUME THE INITIATIVES LINKED TO DIALOGUE AND NEGOTIATION: REALISTIC INITIATIVES, ABOVE

ALL IN THE SEARCH FOR A BASIC UNDERSTANDING, CERTAINLY ESSENTIAL, WITH THE HASHEMITE SOVEREIGN. AN APPEAL WHICH ARAFAT ACCEPTED, STRIVING FOR THE CONVOCATION OF THE PALESTINE NATIONAL COUNCIL AND HAVING IT TAKE PLACE IN AMMAN, WHICH REPRESENTS AN OBVIOUSLY POLITICAL CHOICE.

IT IS NOT MY INTENTION TO ENTER INTO THE MERIT OF THE DECISIONS REACHED IN AMMAN. HOWEVER, IT IS EVIDENT THAT ARAFAT HAS SOUGHT TO CARRY OUT THE FIRST STEPS ON A PATH, WHICH IF TRAVELLED WITH CONSISTENCY AND CONVICTION, CAN CREATE CONDITIONS MORE FAVORABLE FOR A POLITICAL SOLUTION OF THE ARAB-ISRAELI CONFLICT. SAID FIRST STEPS BECAUSE THE ROAD TO TRAVEL IS STILL LONG AND CERTAINLY FULL OF UNKNOWNS. BUT THEY ARE. HOWEVER, CERTAINLY NOT WRONG STEPS AND ONES WHICH MERIT ATTENTION AND CONSIDERATION, FOR THE DIFFICULT CHALLENGES WHICH ARAFAT HAS DECIDED TO FACE IN A RELATIVELY SHORT PERIOD OF TIME; THE CHALLENGE OF SYRIA, WHICH DID NOT WANT THE PNC TO TAKE PLACE; THE CHALLENGE OF HUSSEIN, WHO WARNED THE PLO TO UNDERTAKE DEFINITIVELY THE NEGOTIATION OPTION. WHICH PRESENTS DIFFICULT COMPROMISES AT THE END.

NOT ALL THE QUESTIONS WERE ANSWERED AT AMMAN; AMBIGUITIES AND CONTRADICTIONS REMAIN. FOR MY PART, I

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SAID CLEARLY TO ARAFAT THAT THE PROGRESS MADE IN AMMAN WAS NOT SUFFICIENT AND THAT NEW GESTURES SHOULD BE MADE SO THAT THE PLO CAN MAKE DEFINITIVE AND IRREVERSIBLE THE CHOICE OF NEGOTIATIONS AND THE ABANDONMENT OF ARMED STRUGGLE. I SPECIFIED THAT, IN MY JUDGEMENT, IT WAS NECESSARY FOR THIS PURPOSE TO REACH A COMPREHENSIVE JORDANIAN-PALESTINIAN AGREEMENT, THE ESSENTIAL DRIVING FORCE TO PUT BACK IN MOTION A REAL PACIFICATION PROCESS, AN AGREEMENT THE CONTENTS OF WHICH COULD PRESENT LIKEWISE UNEQUIVOCAL ANSWERS TO ALL ASPECTS CONNECTED TO THE ARAB-ISRAELI CRISIS. THUS NOT ONLY THE QUESTIONS PERTINENT TO JORDANIAN-PALESTINIAN RELATIONS, WITHIN A FUTURE INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK STILL TO BE OUTLINED AND MADE PRECISE, BUT ALSO THE TYPE AND FORM OF RELATIONS TO INITIATE WITH ALL STATES OF THE REGION AND THE SPECIFIC QUESTIONS REGARDING THE SECURITY, RECOGNITION AND THE RIGHTS OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL. I SPECIFIED THAT UNTIL AN ACCEPTABLE JORDANIAN-PALESTINIAN PLATFORM IS ELABORATED, IT WILL BE EXTREMELY DIFFICULT FORMALLY TO CARRY OUT THOSE STEPS AND TO ASSURE THE SUPPORT THAT WOULD GIVE THE PUSH AND FORCE NECESSARY TO THE PROSPECT OF A RIGOROUS NEGOTIATING PROCESS. I CAN TELL YOU THAT ARAFAT AGREED

WITH THIS ANALYSIS AND COMMITTED HIMSELF TO WORK OUT PROPOSALS THAT RESPOND TO THE EXIGENCIES PUT FORWARD AND OF WHICH HE IN ANY CASE WAS AWARE. THE LEADER OF THE PLO NEVERTHELESS THOUGHT IT IMPORTANT TO EMPHASIZE HOW FAR HE HAD COME ALONG ALREADY ON THIS PATH. NOT ONLY TO INDICATE THAT EVERY FUTURE CLARIFYING GESTURE REQUIRES A CONSOLIDATION OF HIS POSITION. BUT ALSO SIGNALS THAT IT CAN DEMONSTRATE WITHIN THE PLO, AND OUTSIDE IT, THAT THE OPTION OF DIALOGUE PAYS OFF. THAT IT CAN BE THE TRUE PATH TO A GLOBAL, LASTING AND JUST  $C_{r}$ SOLUTION. THE WESTERN COUNTRIES, HE SAID, WITH WHICH THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE INTEND TO MAINTAIN SOLID AND FUNCTIONING TIES OF FRIENDSHIP AND COLLABORATION.

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CANNOT, HOWEVER, REMAIN INDIFFERENT TO ALL OF THAT WHICH, THROUGH GRAVE DIFFICULTIES AND MORTAL RISKS, HE AND THE PLO HAVE SUCCEEDED IN DOING. IN THAT REGARD. HE TOLD ME IN CONFIDENCE THAT THE UNDERSTANDING REACHED BETWEEN HIMSELF AND KING HUSSEIN IS DEEPER THAN APPEARS PUBLICLY AND THAT HE HOPED THAT FUTURE FAVORABLE EVENTS COULD ILLUMINATE ALL OF ITS IMPORTANCE AND FULL SIGNIFICANCE. HE THOUGHT IT IMPORTANT TO ADD THAT THE DEMONSTRATION OF COURAGE THAT THE PLO SUCCEEDED IN GIVING BY LIBERATING ITSELF FROM CONDITIONING FORCES, PULLING ITSELF THUS OUT OF A POLITICAL SERVITUDE AND MANIPULATION THAT COULD HAVE EXACERBATED THE STALLED SITUATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST, WITH A GRAVE RISK OF INSTABILITY AND NEW CONFLICTS. WAS CERTAINLY NOT A SECONDARY FACTOR. HE INTENDED TO PURSUE PATIENT WORK IN PURSUIT OF AN ARAB CONSENSUS; HE UNDERLINED THE IMPORTANC OF THE EGYPTIAN ROLE, AND HE SHOWED HIMSELF CONFIDENT OF BEING ABLE TO COUNT ON THE EVERMORE CONVINCED SUPPORT OF THE COUNTRIES THAT TRULY WANT TO WORK FOR THE PACIFICATION OF THE MIDDLE EAST. HE CLEARLY DEMONSTRATED IN OUR MEETING THE ABILITY TO BE OPEN, IF CONDITIONS WILL ALLOW HIM TO BE, TO UNEQUIVOCAL ACTS OF RECOGNITION OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL. BUT THAT, HE SAID, WOULD OCCUR ONLY IN THE MOMENT IN WHICH THERE WILL EMERGE WITH CLARITY THE READINESS OF EVERYONE TO PUT THEIR OWN CARDS ON THE NEGOTIATING TABLE IN THE TORMENTED AND CRUEL GAME THAT UNFORTUNATELY HAS BEEN PLAYED IN THE MIDDLE EAST FOR TOO MANY YEARS.

I DID NOT, NEVERTHELESS, HIDE FROM ARAFAT MY PROFOUND RESERVATIONS AND PERPLEXITY OVER THE VIABILITY OF THE HYPOTHESIS OF AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE, TO TAKE PLACE EVENTUALLY UNDER THE AEGIS OF THE UN. I TOLD HIM IN ALL FRANKNESS THAT TO INSIST ON THIS OPTION WOULD MEAN TODELAY THE POSSIBILITY OF BEGINNING THE

NEGOTIATING PROCESS, WHILE IT MUST BE IN THE COMMON INTEREST TO SEEK REALISTIC AND PRAGMATIC WAYS SUCH AS THAT OF SMALL STEPS AND OF DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS.

ARAFAT DID NOT APPEAR TO ME TO BE INDIFFERENT TO THIS LINE OF REASONING, OBJECTING ONLY WITH REGARD TO HIS LACK OF FAITH IN ISRAEL'S REAL WILL TO MOVE TOWARD A REASONABLE COMPROMISE. FOR THIS REASON HE SEES AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE AS A MEANS OF EXERCISING STRONGER AND MORE CONCENTRIC PRESSURE ON ISRAEL IN ORDER TO ATTENUATE ITS INTRANSIGENCE AND RENDER THE GOVERNMENT IN TEL AVIV MORE OPEN TO A COMPROMISE ACCEPTABLE TO THE ARAB COUNTRIES. HERE, PERHAPS, IS A FURTHER REASON TO REFLECT ON THE NEED TO IMPROVE THE CLIMATE OF CONFIDENCE WITH GESTURES THAT COULD INDICATE A READINESS TO SEEK POINTS OF CONSENSUS ON WHICH TO CONSTRUCT A MORE SOLID BASIS OF UNDERSTANDING. PERMIT ME THEN, DEAR PRESIDENT AND FRIEND, TO PUT BEFORE YOU AN INVITATION TO UNITE OUR EFFORTS TO ENCOURAGE A PROCESS OF MOVEMENT BY WHICH TO REINFORCE THE SIGNALS OF DIALOGUE, AND TO PREDISPOSE OURSELVES TO EVALUATE IN

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A TIMELY FASHION THE MEANS AND THE FORMS FOR AN INITIATIVE OF OUR OWN, TO ADOPT AT A MOMENT IN WHICH THE FRAME OF REFERENCE WILL BE CLEARER AND THE TERRAIN WILL BE FREED OF AMBIGUITIES AND CONTRADICTIONS.

I BELIEVE THAT THE KNOWLEDGE THAT THE UNITED STATES AND EUROPE HAVE MANY FRIENDS AMONG THE ARAB COUNTRIES SHOULD PUSH US IN THIS DIRECTION. OUR DUTY IS TO NOT DISAPPOINT THESE FRIENDS AND TO SHOW THEM THE MAXIMUN OPENNESS AND READINESS TO UNDERSTAND THEIR EXPECTATIONS IN A FRAMEWORK OF JUSTICE AND SECURITY FOR ALL. BUT WE CERTAINLY CANNOT HIDE FROM OURSELVES THE FACT THAT IN THE ARAB WORLD THERE ARE ALSO COUNTRIES THAT SHOW A HOSTILITY THAT CAN UNDERMINE THE PROSPECT OF PEACE AND JUSTICE WHICH INSPIRE US AND WE MUST NOT FURNISH THEM WITH THE PRETEXTS THAT MAKE SUCH ACTION EASIER.

I WANTED TO PUT THESE CONSIDERATIONS OF MINE BEFORE YOU IN THE HOPE OF CONTINUING AND DEEPENING A CLOSE AND EFFECTIVE CONSULTATION ON A QUESTION SO INSTRUMENTAL (STRUMENTALE) FOR THE SAFEGUARDING OF PEACE AND AT A HISTORIC JUNCTURE OF UNIQUE IMPORTANCE.
