I LOOK FORWARD TO CONTINUING TO WORK CLOSELY WITH YOU PERSONALLY -- AS WE DID AT WILLIAMSBURG -- IN PURSUIT OF WORLD PEACE, SECURITY AND PROSPERITY. RON
