President-Gromyko Meeting: Revised Talking Points

Attached at TAB I are talking points for the President, revised in light of Secretary Shultz's meeting yesterday and Gromyko's speech today.

To facilitate your quick review, I have attached at TAB II a copy with the new material highlighted in the President's initial points. The following topics have been added to the contingency talking points: Gromyko's nuclear freeze proposal (stressed in his UN speech), the non-first-use of nuclear weapons proposal, and a rebuttal to Gromyko's charge that we have "demolished" all that is positive in the relationship (pages 3,4 and 13).

I do not believe the points done earlier for the private session need revision.
