Dear Mr. President:

Along with the more than 2,500 of my constituents whose signatures are enclosed, I implore you once again to cancel your planned visit to the German military cemetery at Bitburg.

As you are certainly aware, the plans for the Bitburg visit have caused great distress to American World War II veterans and concentration camp survivors and their relatives. Cancelling the visit now would not be caving in to special interests; rather, it would be a courageous way for you to demonstrate your sensitivity for the feelings of these Americans.

In this, the 40th anniversary year of the end of the holocaust, it is imperative that our President not take any action that might be construed as pardoning those who perpetrated one of humankind's most heinous acts. Unfortunately, because SS members are among those buried at the Bitburg cemetery, your presence there could be taken as bestowing such forgiveness. On behalf of all of my constituents, but especially those who fought for the United States in World War II, or who lost family members or are themselves survivors of the concentration camps, I ask you to cancel this visit.





SCHUMER MEETS WITH STUDENT ACTIVISTS DISTURBED BY PRESIDENT'S
PLANS TO VISIT NAZI CEMETERY

Students Believe President's "Decision Shows Lack of Sensitivity
to Millions of Victims of Holocaust"

Congressman Charles Schumer will deliver a letter and petitions addressed to President Reagan requesting that he reconsider his decision to visit a German War Cemetery. 2500 signatures were gathered by five students: Melanie Faher, Meyer Elnadav, Beit Ridary, Larry Siegel, and Michael Tessler, representing Brooklyn College; The Albert Einstein College of Medicine; New York University; Yeshiva College and Stern College of Yeshiva University. The petitions and letter were presented to Congressman Schumer at his district office on Kings Highway in Brooklyn, on Friday, April 19th. The students met with the Congressman to share their concerns and express thanks for his support.

Congressman Schumer is an outspoken critic of the President's plans to visit a German Military Cemetery. He and 15 other Congressmembers wrote to the President urging him to amend his schedule to include a stop at a Concentration Camp. To date, the President has refused to cancel his visit to the Bitburg Cemetery. This burial ground includes the tombstones of SS Nazi soldiers who were responsible for carrying out the systematic mass murders of Jews during World War II.
