Dear Mr. President:

Upon reading of your planned May trip to Germany in the January 25th issue of the New York daily news, immediately thought to suggest for the second time your visiting the Castle of Hambach (Hambacher Schloss) at Neustadt an der Weinstrasse. This city is the center of German wine production on the Deutsche Weinstrasse, an ancient Roman road.

Scheduling

On May 27, 1832 freedom minded Germans met at the castle and demanded a free government, without monarchy if necessary. Because strongly opposed by the government, this attempt was abortive. But in A D 1848 such minded Germans tried again at Frankfurt.

In A D 1835 my Grossvater Metzger was born in Hambach, then a separate wine village; Grossmutter in Neustadt/Weinstrasse in 1852. Parents in New York City early in the 1880's; self in Carlton Hill, New Jersey in A D 1918.


In A D 1935, after a year of studying German in Rutherford (New Jersey) High School, began corresponding with relatives in the old country. Previously they had been unknown to us.

In large part one happy result of almost a half century of such correspondence was the visit of Mrs. Metzger and me with our German relatives in July 1983. A great time.

Permit me a belated congratulation upon your reelection.
