

On March 20, 1983, at 7PM, local time, Kenneth Charles Trinchitella, age 16, of 8415 Grand Haven Ave, Upper Marlboro, MD 20772, established four (4) United States Aviation Records. He became the first person on record to fly his initial solo flight at night; the youngest licensed United States Pilot; the youngest night qualified United States Pilot and the youngest pilot on record to qualify for night flight. Kenny accomplished this feat in a Cessna 150 at Hyde Field in Clinton, MD.

These records have been certified by Mr. Milton Brown of the National Aeronautical Association (NAA), Mr. Wildon Britton and Mr. Howard Hess of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).
