I understand your concern of setting a precedent by giving the Egyptians 22 seats at the State Dinner for President and Mrs. Sadat. However, I believe this can simply be explained to other governments by saying that the number of 14 was expanded only to include the children.

At the request of the Egyptian Government, the children will be listed as Official Party on our programs to come after their Mother and before the Foreign Minister in protocol order. They will, of course expect the children to be on toe markers at the White House Arrival Ceremony and included in other ceremonial functions. Please note that this is consistent with our treatment of children in past visits; i.e., the Thatcher and Lopez-Portillo visits.

The purpose of our memo of July 15 was to give you as much information as we had as soon as possible.

The presentation ceremony will be announced by a Social Aide with a microphone in the Red Room door to the south.

Upon the termination of the medal ceremony, Mrs. Reagan will escort Mrs. Sadat into the Green Room and the Chief of Protocol will escort the President and President Sadat to the Oval Office.

After presentation Mrs. Annenberg will escort PRESIDENT REAGAN and President Sadat to the Oval Office.
