I understand your concern of setting a precedent by giving the Egyptians 22 seats at the State Dinner for President and Mrs. Sadat. However, I believe this can simply be explained to other governments by saying that the number of 14 was expanded only to include the children.

At the request of the Egyptian Government, the children will be listed as Official Party on our programs to come after their Mother and before the Foreign Minister in protocol order. They will, of course expect the children to be on toe markers at the White House Arrival Ceremony and included in other ceremonial functions. Please note that this is consistent with our treatment of children in past visits; i.e., the Thatcher and Lopez-Portillo visits. *OK*

10:00 a.m. MRS. REAGAN descends the elevator and proceeds to the Arrival Ceremony on the South Lawn via the Diplomatic Reception Room. She greets President and Mrs. Sadat as they arrive.

10:20 a.m. Following the Arrival Ceremony, THE PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN, President and Mrs. Sadat proceed through the Diplomatic Reception Room and up the elevator to the State Floor. They then take their places for the receiving line in front of the Blue Room in the Cross Hall. The order from west to east is THE PRESIDENT, President Sadat, Mrs. Reagan, Mrs. Sadat. Mrs. Annenberg will introduce guests to THE PRESIDENT from his left.

The remaining invited guests will wait until the PRINCIPALS have had time to take their places, then they will proceed up the west staircase outside of the White House leading into the Red Room, going in front of the Blue Room past the PRINCIPALS, proceeding into the Green Room, then into the Blue Room for refreshments. (Juice, coffee and pastries).

At the termination of the receiving line presentation of medals (10 minutes).

MEDAL CEREMONY

At the conclusion of the receiving line at approximately 10:35 a.m., the doors to the Blue Room will be opened by Social Aides and the President will escort President Sadat and Mrs. Sadat and Mrs. Reagan through the Blue Room toward the southern windows. There, President Sadat will present the medals to the President and Mrs. Reagan facing north. The presentation ceremony will be announced by a Social Aide with a microphone in the Red Room door to the south.

Upon the termination of the medal ceremony, Mrs. Reagan will escort Mrs. Sadat into the Green Room and the Chief of Protocol will escort the President and President Sadat to the Oval Office.

After presentation Mrs. Annenberg will escort PRESIDENT REAGAN and President Sadat to the Oval Office.

MRS. REAGAN will invite Mrs. Sadat, Mrs. Haig, Mrs. Ghorbal, Mrs. Atherton and Mrs. Ghali into the Green Room for coffee.

The remaining guests will depart the Diplomatic Reception Room.

MRS. REAGAN will escort Mrs. Sadat to the North Portico and the remaining guests will also be escorted as they depart Diplomatic Reception Room.
