Everything went fairly well last night but I have a few requests for the future:

1. NO ONE goes upstairs to the Yellow Oval Room before Mrs. Annenberg arrives. Last night, Secretary Haig was alone up there for ten (10) minutes with the President. All early arrivals of the Official Party should go to the Red Room until Mrs. Annenberg is in the Yellow Oval Room.
2. The aides which are assigned to the Foreign guests should move into the State Dining Room IMMEDIATELY after dinner to help escort their guests out to the color rooms. I would suggest that they move in through the far Red Room door so that they can slip through the crowd unobtrusively. They can then lead their guests out the main doors of the State Dining Room.
