While you were at Santa Barbara, Jackie and I took a quick week in Italy -- pure vacation! Thanks to our mutual good friend Ambassador Max Rabb, I was a guest at the Prefect of Siena's house for lunch and then a guest to witness the "Palio Day" famous horse race in Siena.

Amidst medieval pageantry (there are ten "families" who each sponsor a race horse) the riders race around the central piazza bareback. The winner gets the "Palio", a banner honoring the Virgin. Anything goes in the race — from bribery to literally attacking other riders. It's a sight to behold, especially with 70 thousand people crammed into the enclave. It has to be seen to be believed. I commented to the Prefect that with your interest in horses, you ought to see this.

As I was leaving, I was presented with a book on the Palio from the Prefect and the Chamber of Commerce which they asked me to give you.



The Kentucky country ham has long been a tradition in our state. Anyone who has attended the Kentucky Derby has enjoyed a beaten biscuit and country ham sandwich.

Commercial County Ham producers are family enterprises. The producers use unique curing processes that make the Kentucky country ham so special. The Kentucky Department of Agriculture, in cooperation with the Kentucky Country Ham Producers Association, has developed a seal program to be used only by persons processing hams in Kentucky.

The seal program is designed to provide a means for the consumers to know that they are receiving a "real" Kentucky cured country ham. The logo will be placed only on federally inspected hams with a consecutive numbering system. This procedure will allow an accurate record to be kept with each ham in the event a problem or complaint arises. The logo has been approved by the USDA Food Safety and Inspection Service and is now ready to be introduced in Kentucky and nationwide. Kentucky country hams are a \$45 million industry to the state. The ham seal program deserves to be properly introduced and initiated. We would consider it an honor to present to you the number one ham of the series. A formal presentation with the individual ham producer, Kentucky Commissioner of Agriculture and ourselves would be a most fitting manner to initiate this program.
