

The Tunisian Minister of Defense is leading his delegation to next week's U.S.-Tunisia Joint Military Commission. He had asked to meet with Bud on November 12 or 13, but a meeting cannot be arranged.

A meeting with the Vice President would be extremely beneficial to our efforts to restore the traditional warmth of U.S.-Tunisian relations:

- demonstrate Tunisia's access to U.S. political leadership.
- provide an opportunity for frank but positive political dialogue, including "personal" message for Bourguiba.
- demonstrate to the media that crisis is behind us and that we are working cooperatively to protect mutual interests.
