THE PRESIDENT and MRS. REAGAN arrive the State Floor and proceed to the Red Room to greet dais participants.

NOTE

Mrs. Hesselbein will present THE PRESIDENT with the Girl Scouts of the USA Annual Report.

At the conclusion of the presentation, dais participants proceed to their seating in the East Room.

12:05 p.m.

THE PRESIDENT and MRS. REAGAN proceed to the East Room via the Cross Hall.

Luncheon is served in the East Room.

12:40 p.m.

Upon conclusion of the main course, the press will be escorted into the East Room.

12:45 p.m.

MRS. REAGAN proceeds to the podium to welcome the guests and to introduce Jane Freeman. MRS. REAGAN then returns to her table.

Remarks by Jane Freeman.

At the conclusion of her remarks, Mrs. Freeman will invite THE PRESIDENT, MRS. REAGAN, Miss Deshazor, and Miss Brown to join her on the platform.

MRS. REAGAN will be presented with a scroll by Marci Brown.

FRIDAY, MARCH 9, 1984

THE PRESIDENT will be presented with a Citizenship Badge by Stephanie Deshazor.

At the conclusion of the badge presentation, THE PRESIDENT will be proclaimed an Honorary Girl Scout and will be pinned.

Remarks by THE PRESIDENT.

12:55 p.m.

At the conclusion of remarks, THE PRESIDENT will present Miss Deshazor and Miss Brown with the Girl Scouts of the USA 72nd Anniversary Cake.

The cake will be carried into the East Room and up to the platform by the butlers.

Miss Deshazor and Miss Brown will stand on either side of THE PRESIDENT and assist in blowing out the candles. The platform participants will then return to their seats.

The cake will be carried out of the East Room.

The press will be escorted out of the East Room.

1:05 p.m.

Dessert will be served.

1:15 p.m.

At the conclusion of dessert, THE PRESIDENT departs the State Floor via elevator enroute the Oval Office.

MRS. REAGAN proceeds down the Cross Hall to her place in front of fireplace in the Blue Room for the receiving line.

The receiving line will feed from the Cross Hall doors of the East Room, into the Blue Room, past MRS. REAGAN in front of the fireplace, out the south door of the Blue Room to the Red Room and back into the Cross Hall.

I. PURPOSE

The meeting will allow Secretary Dole and Ray Barnhart, the Federal Highway Administrator to be photographed with you as you sign H.R. 4957--Interstate Cost Estimate and Interstate Substitute Cost Estimate legislation.

This legislation will allow the Federal Highway Administration to apportion \$2 billion in Interstate construction funds, \$330 million in Interstate transfer funds for highway and transit projects, and \$150 million in emergency relief highway funds.

I. PURPOSE

To continue discussions with Senate Republicans regarding the FY '85 budget.

II. BACKGROUND

Thursday's meeting with the Senate Republicans produced general agreement that development of a deficit reduction package was the best politics in order to confront Congressional Democrats. In addition, it was clear that agreement on all parts of a 3-legged package was essential if Senate Republicans are to be able to pass any major domestic spending cuts or revenue measure.

There is general agreement on all elements of the package except defense. It was agreed that OMB and the Department of Defense would flesh out the numbers on various proposals concerning the Defense budget. Everyone agreed that the legislative process was moving and that if an agreement could be reached -- the sooner the better.
