

Dear Mr. Chairman:

I have read your letter of July 7 and reviewed the requests contained therein. While the requests pertain to events which took place almost three years ago, I have refreshed my recollection to the best extent possible.

Based upon that recollection, a search of any files I might have from that period and a review of documents sent to you by other Administration officials in response to these same or similar questions, I wish to advise you that to the best of my knowledge and recollection at no time during the period involved did I have any direct or indirect knowledge of, or any participation whatever in, any transactions involving material prepared for President Carter. I also wish to advise you that a review of files presently in my possession discloses that I have no records except personal non-substantive memorabilia from the period of time in question.
