SUBJECT: Drug Abuse in the United States

DATE: 11:00am-12:30pm, May 4, 1987

PURPOSE: To bring State Department's Narcotics Coordinators up-to-date on drug abuse trends and demand reduction programs in the United States.

- o The Narcotics Coordinators are responsible for drug control programs in U.S. Embassies around the world. They are typically very knowledgeable about drug abuse issues, so this panel can be rather sophisticated in its presentation.
- o Panelists should attempt to provide information which the Narcotics Coordinators can use in their dealings with their host government, both in expressing the commitment of the United States to ending drug abuse and in providing useful ideas which the host government may apply to their own situation.
