Citations should identify items clearly, specify their file locations, and end with reference to the Gerald R. Ford Library. Most citations will concern items from manuscript collections and should contain these elements:

Type of document; names of sender and recipient or title of document; date; folder title; box number; collection title; Gerald R. Ford Library.

Some Library collections have confusingly similar titles, e.g. the Ron Nessen Files and the Ron Nessen Papers, but the distinction is important. The Files were acquired as part of President Ford's donation of his historical materials; the Papers were acquired later, by donation from the individual named. Also, the common abbreviation for the White House Central Files is "WHCF".
