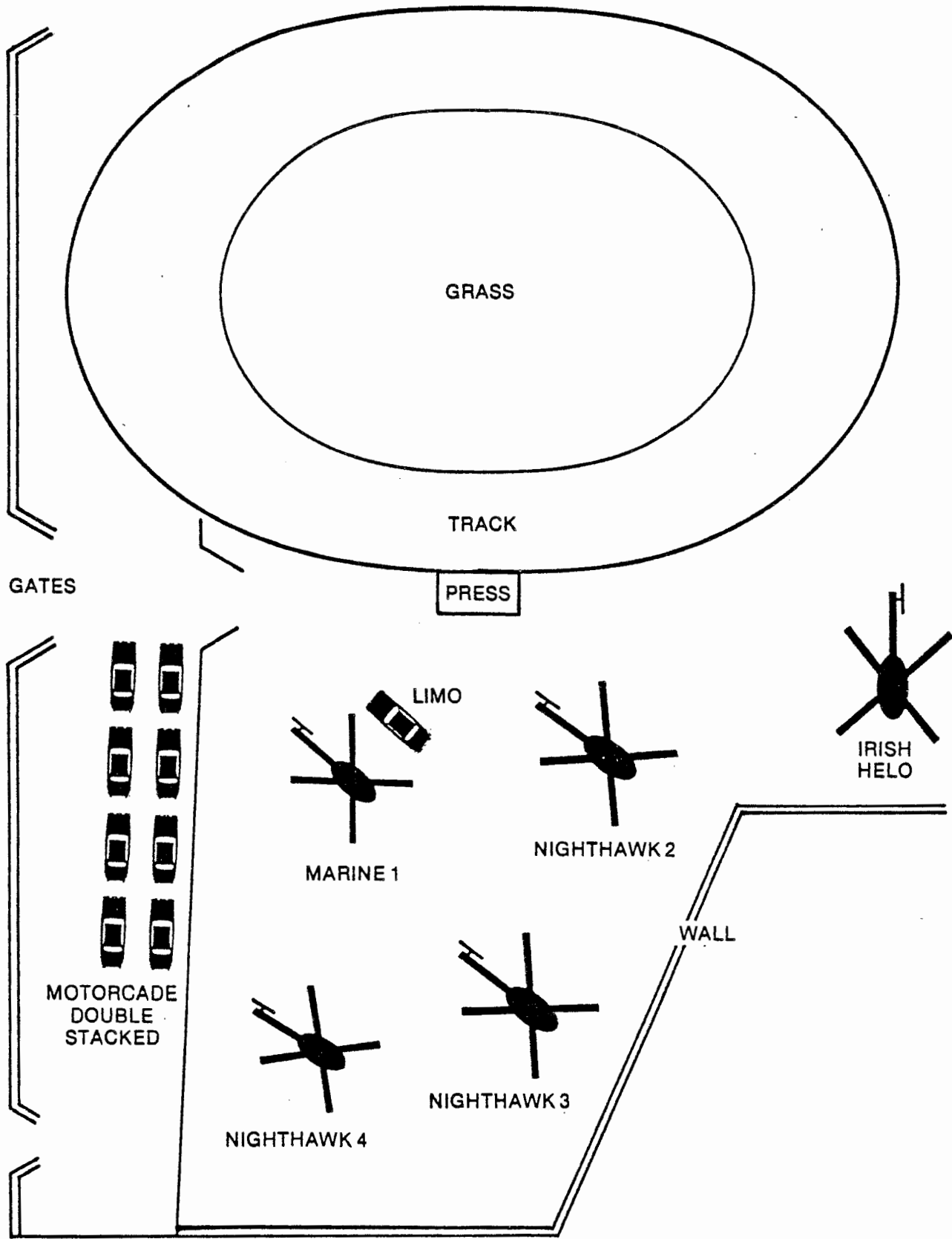

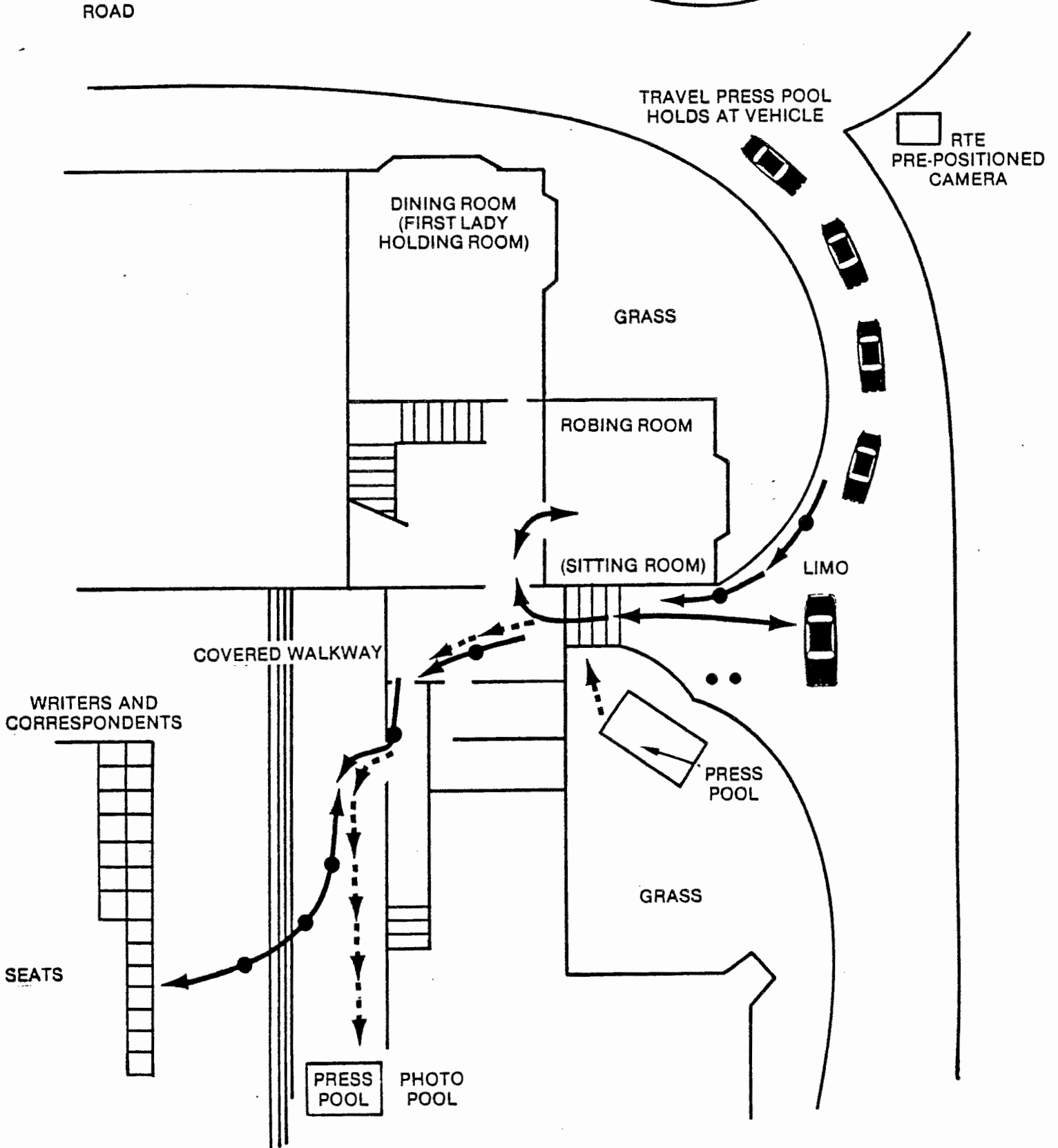

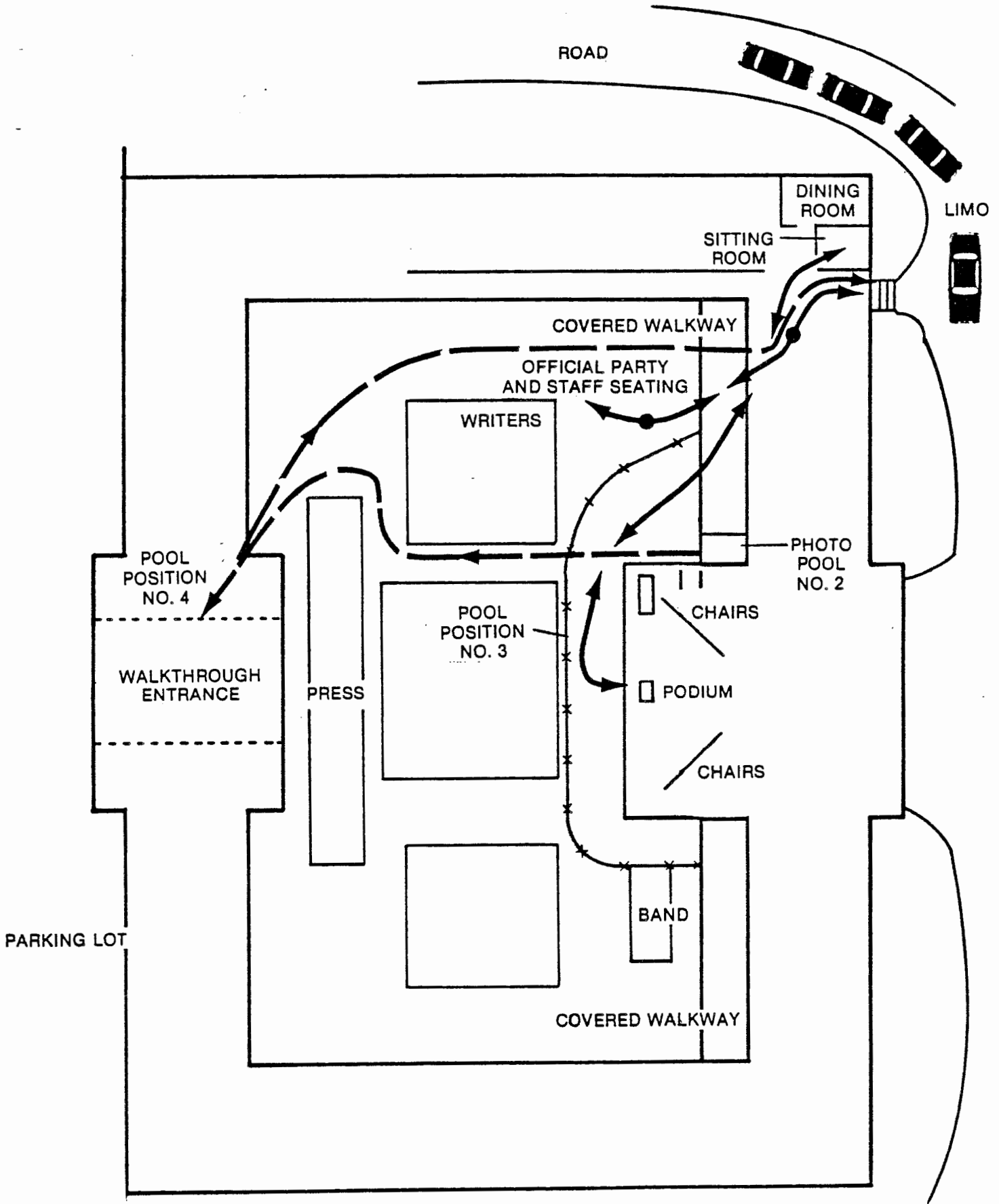

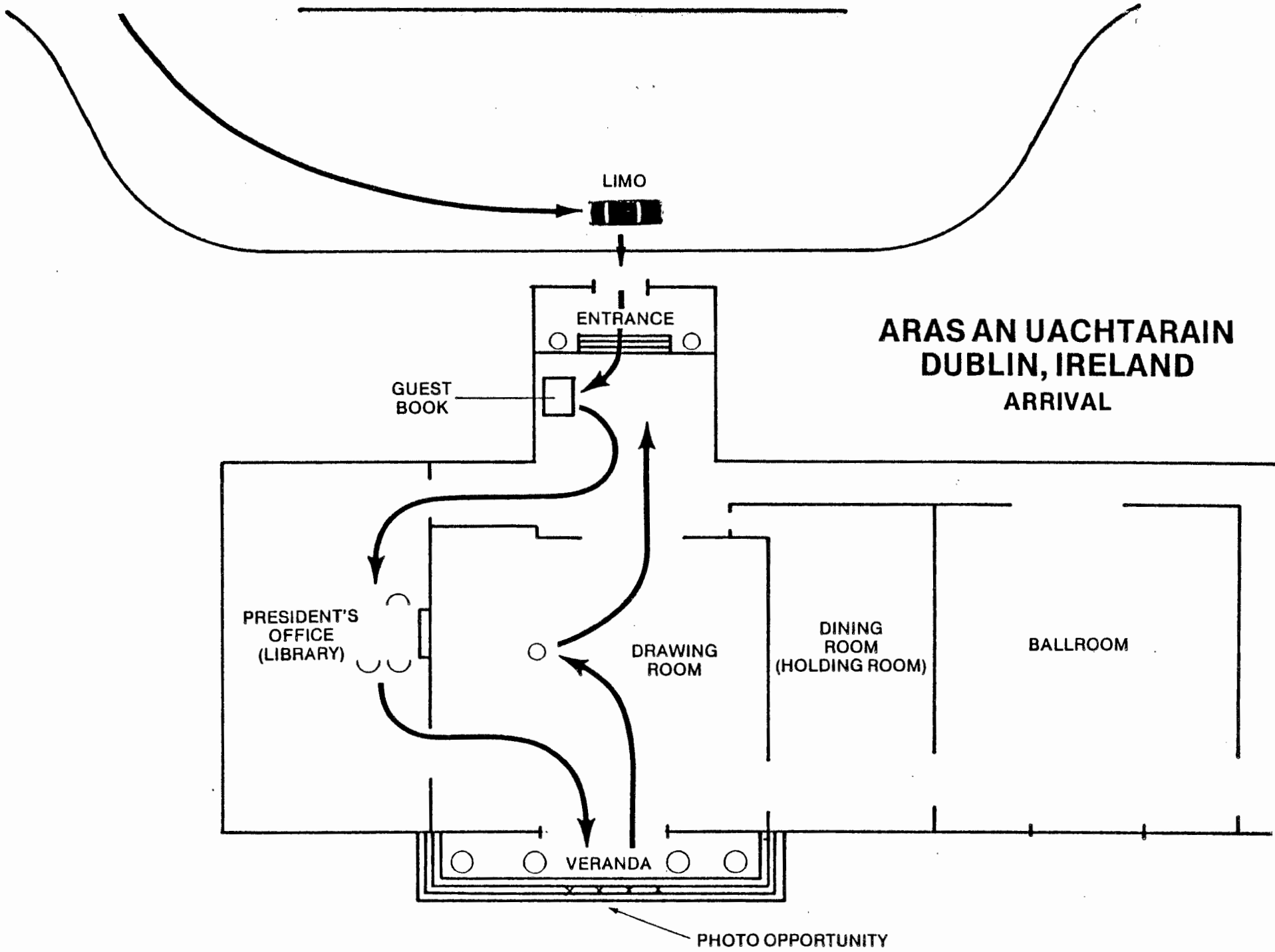

TREE PLANTING CEREMONY**

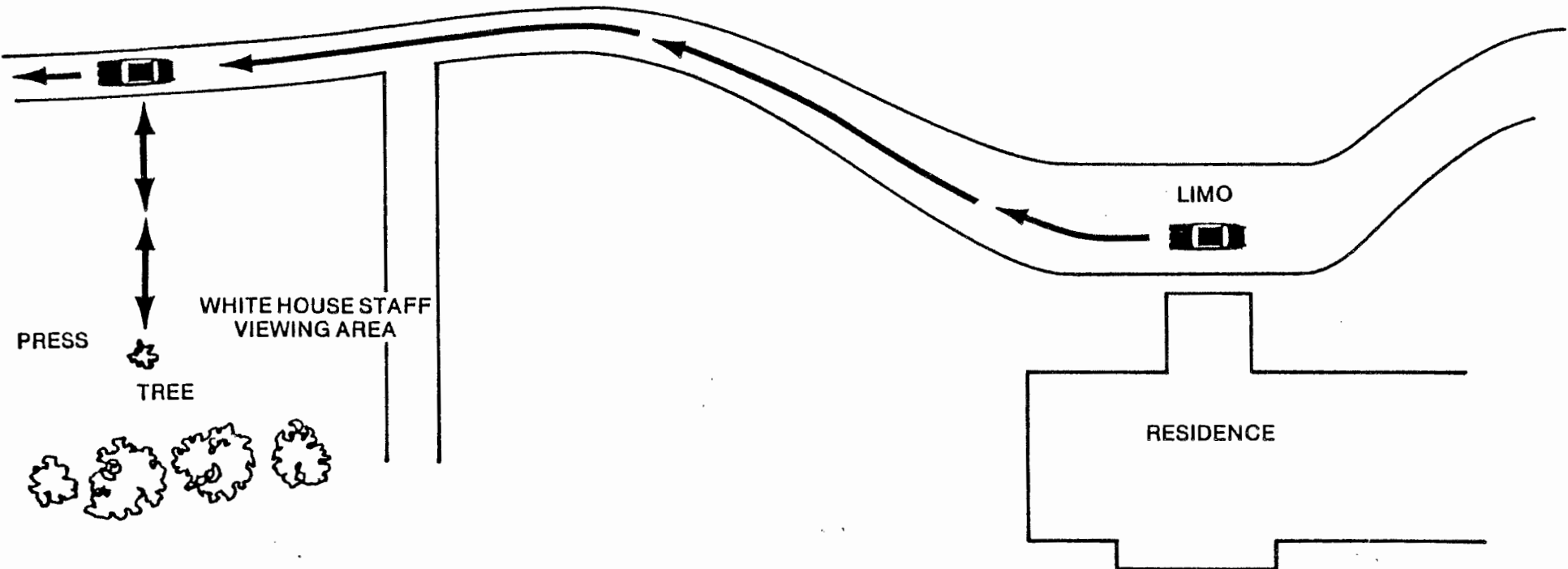
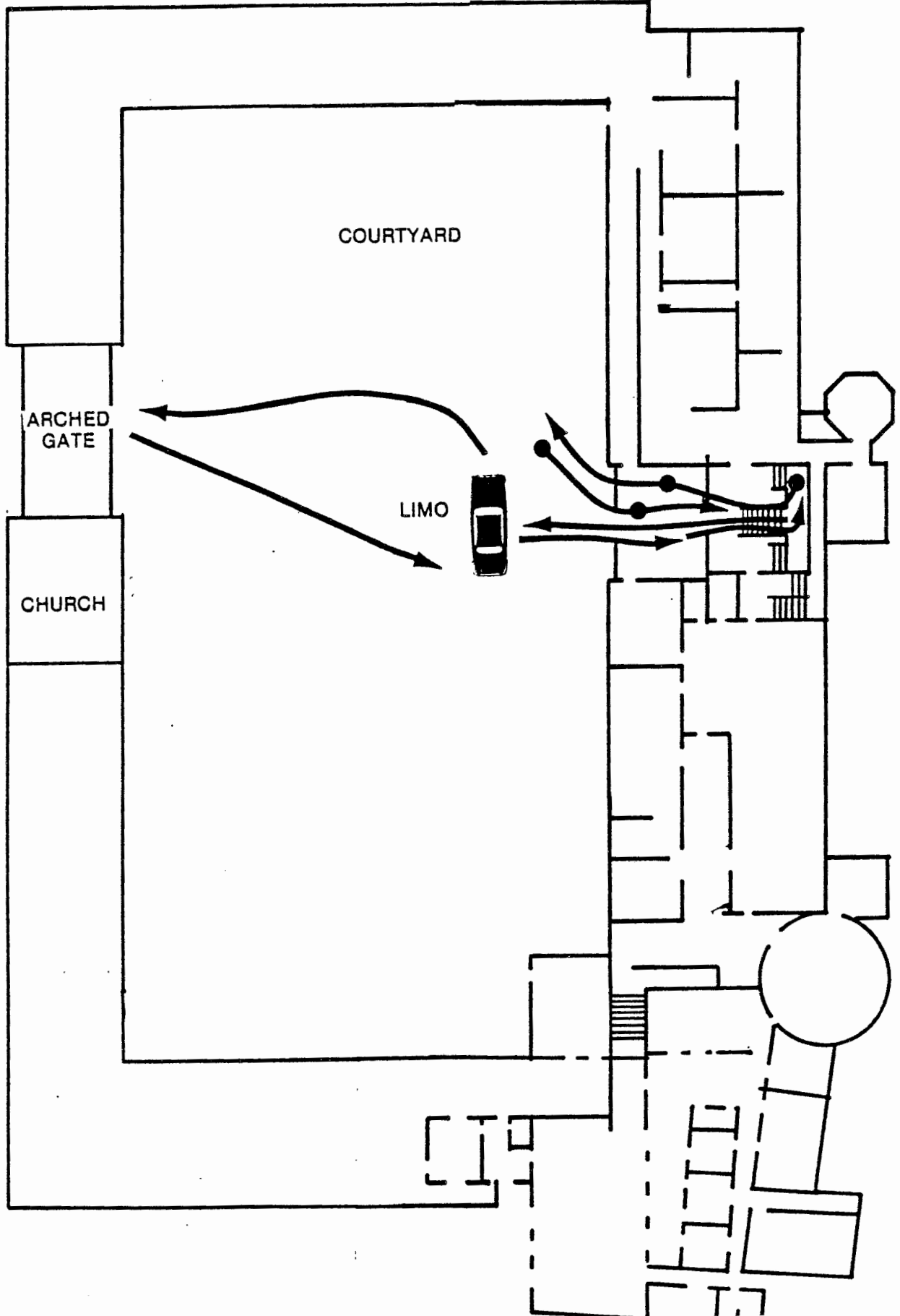

GROUND FLOOR

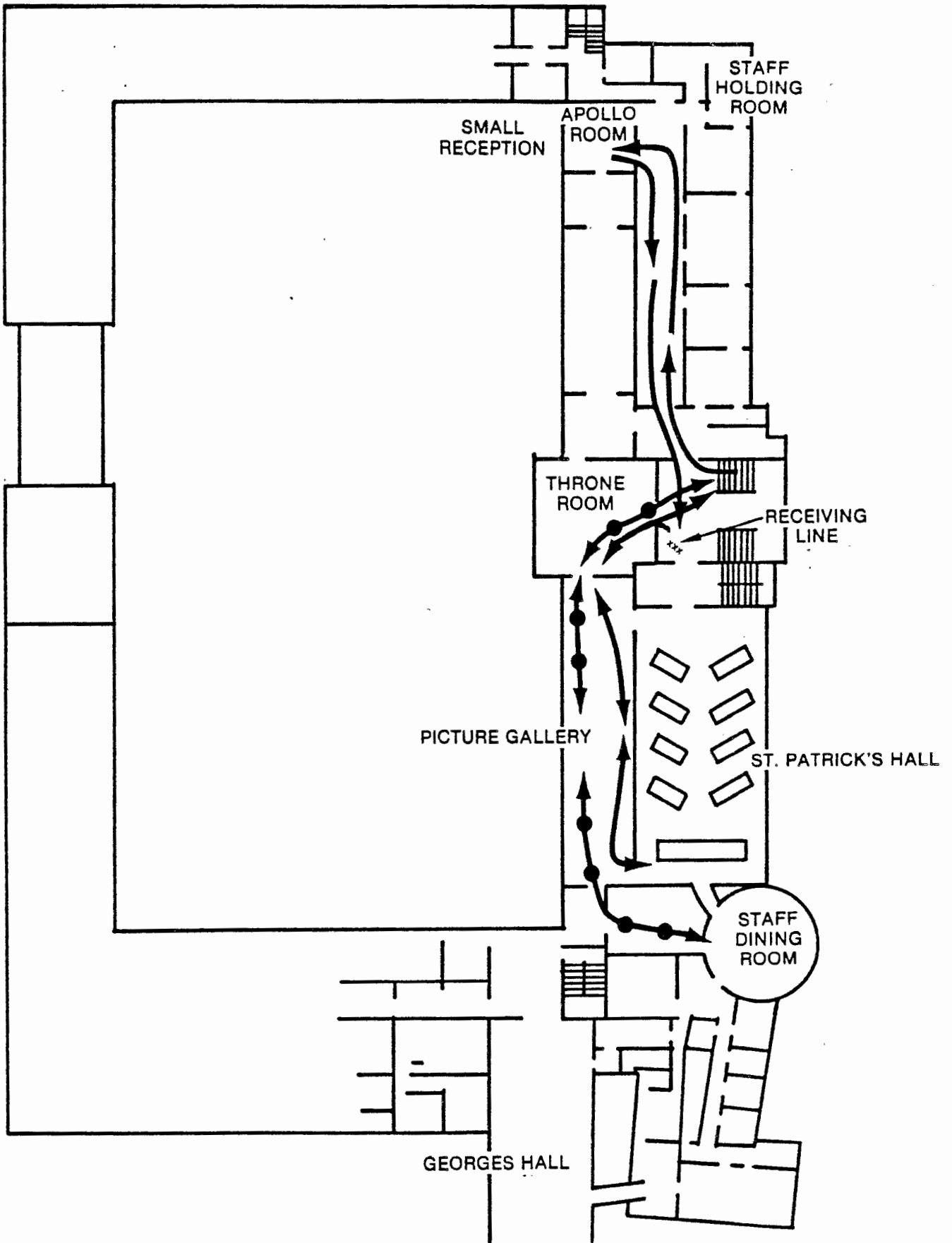

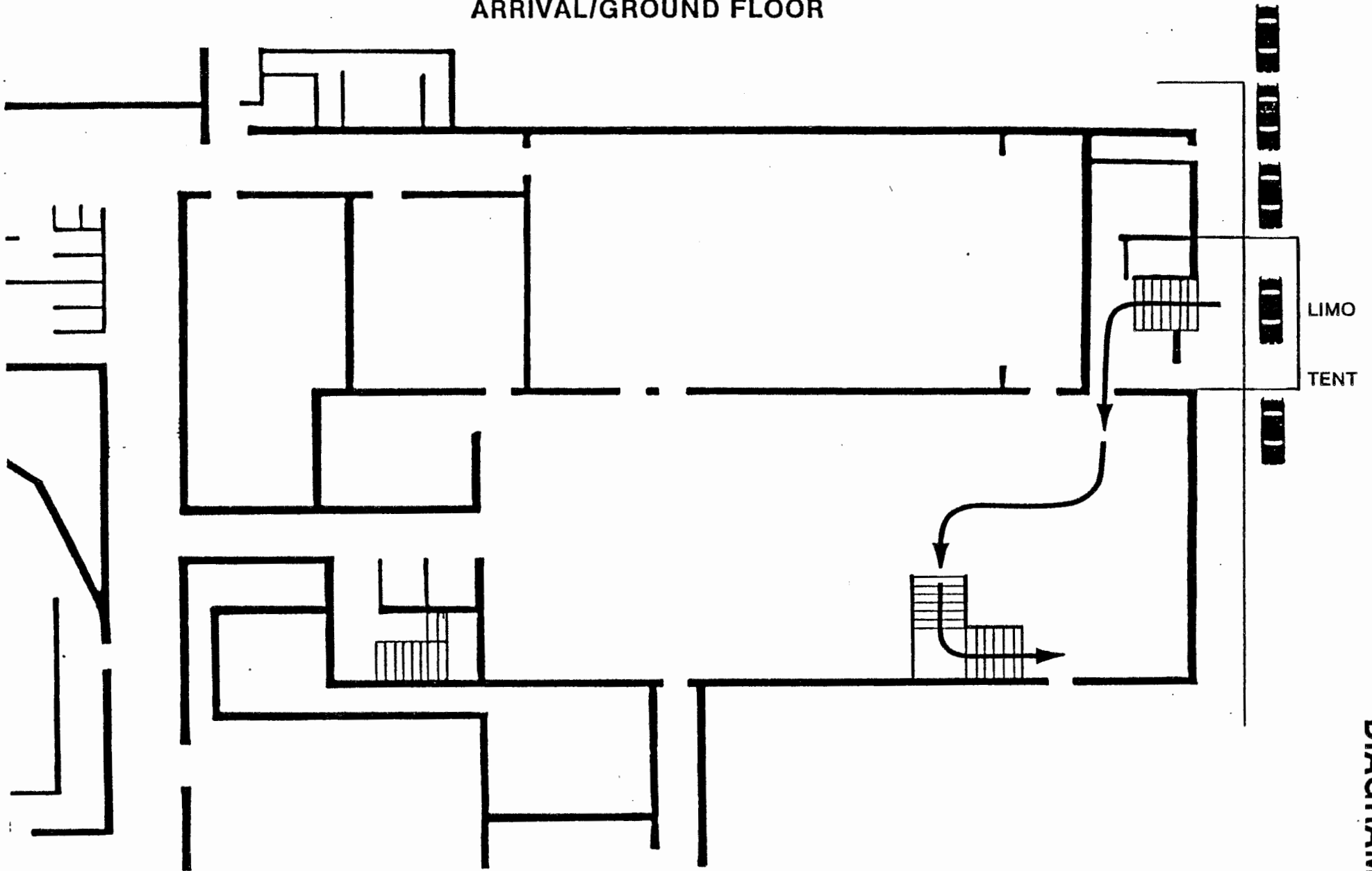

FIRST FLOOR**

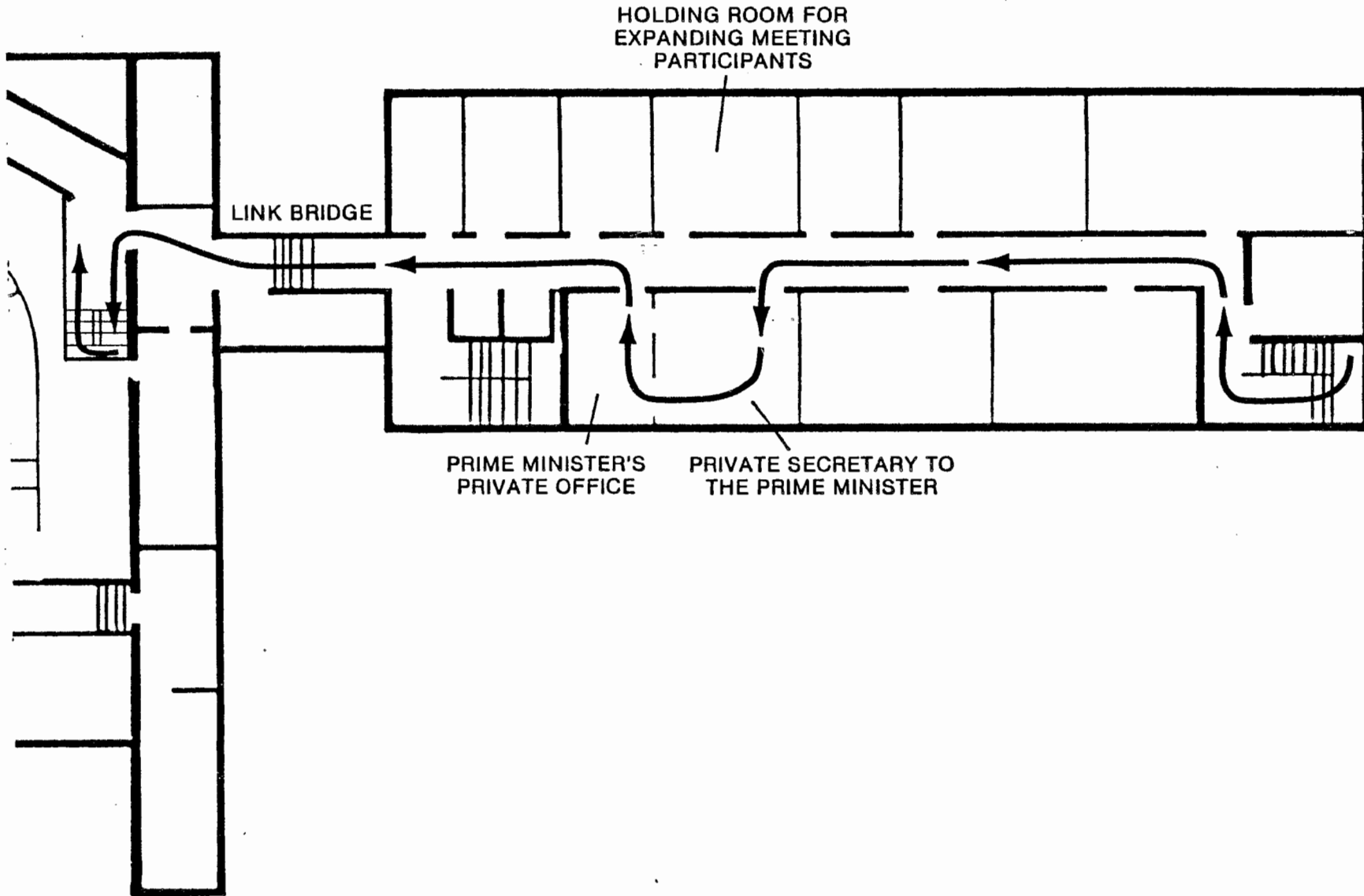

DEPARTURE/GROUND FLOOR**

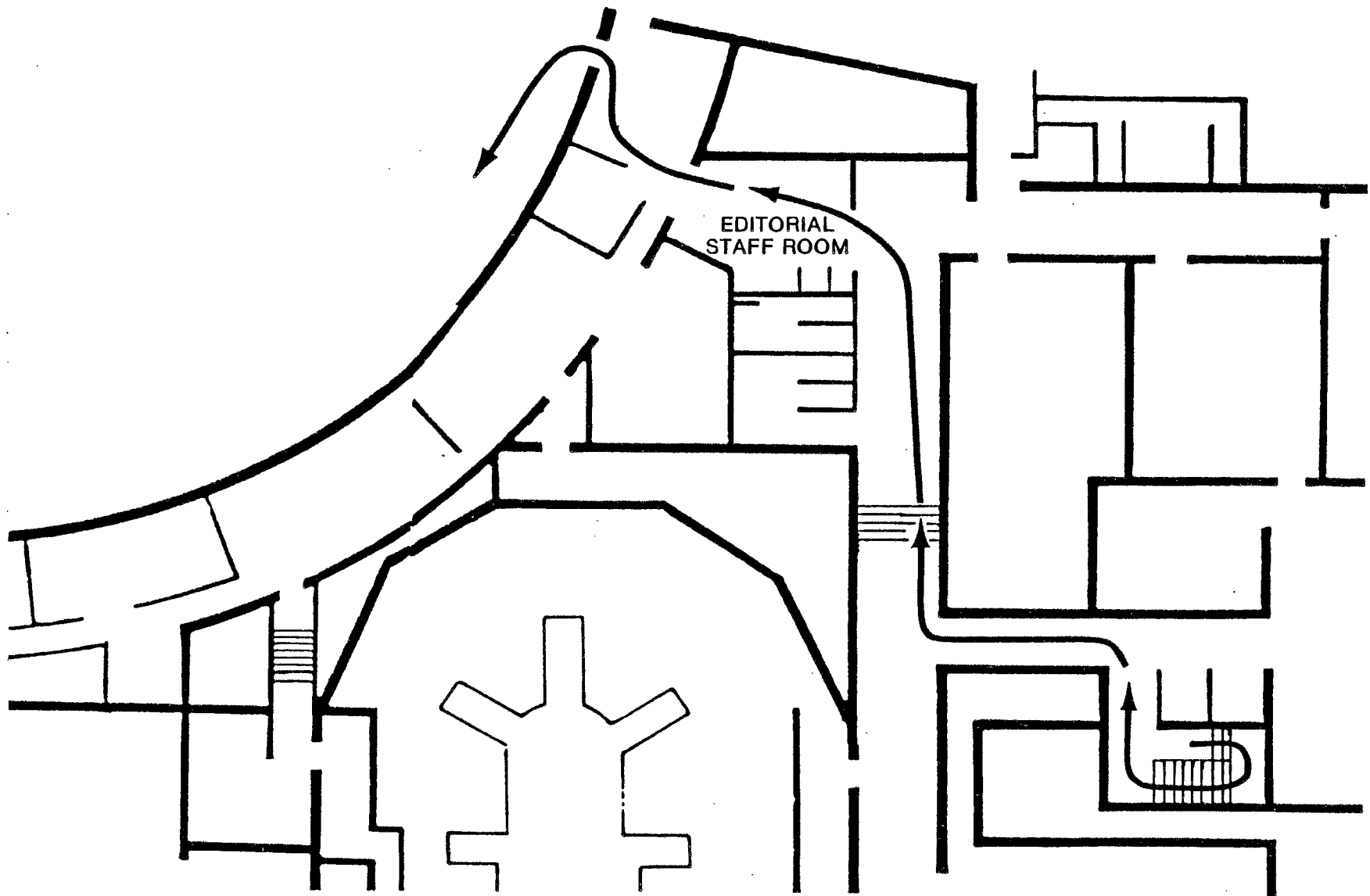

GROUND FLOOR ARRIVAL

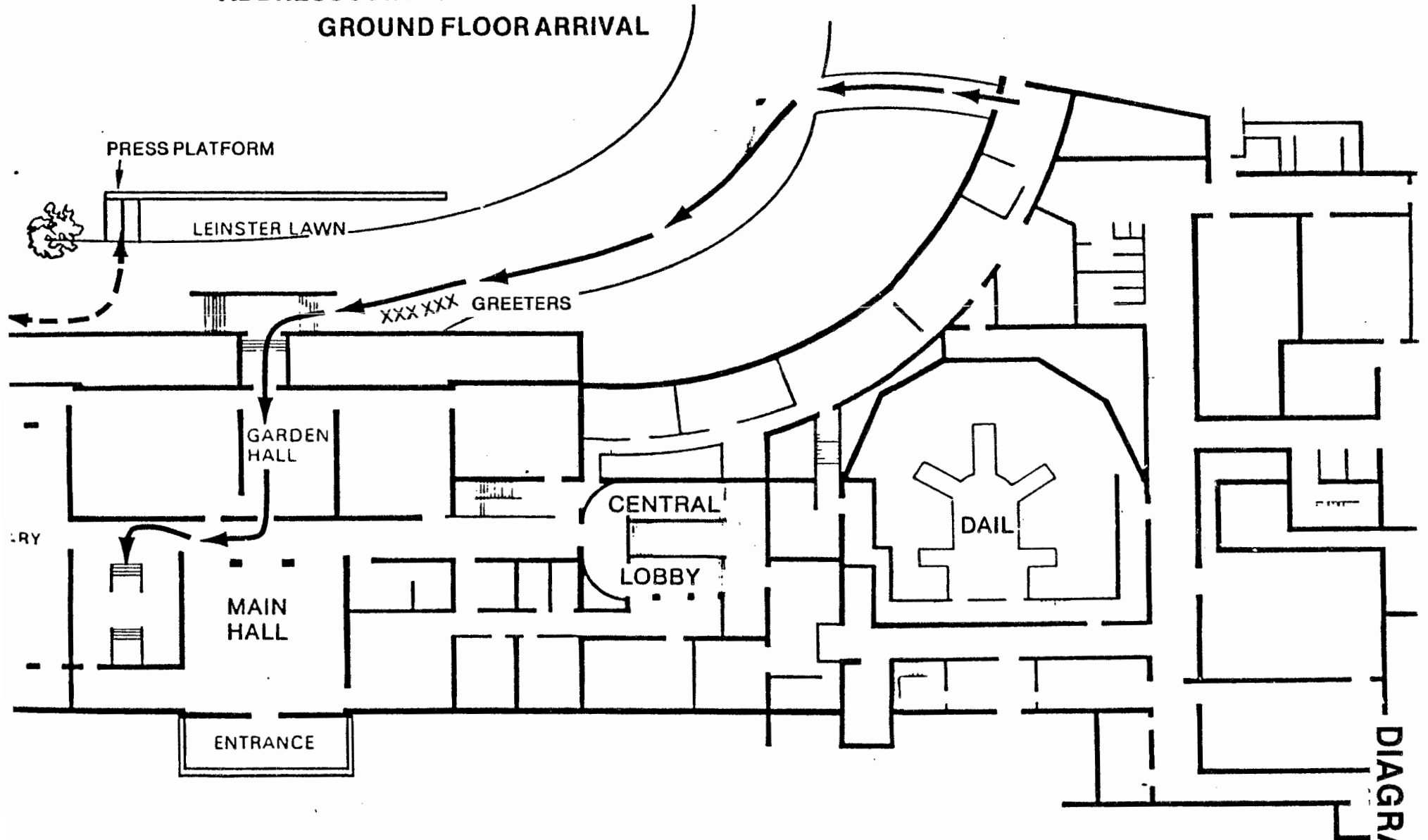

FIRST FLOOR

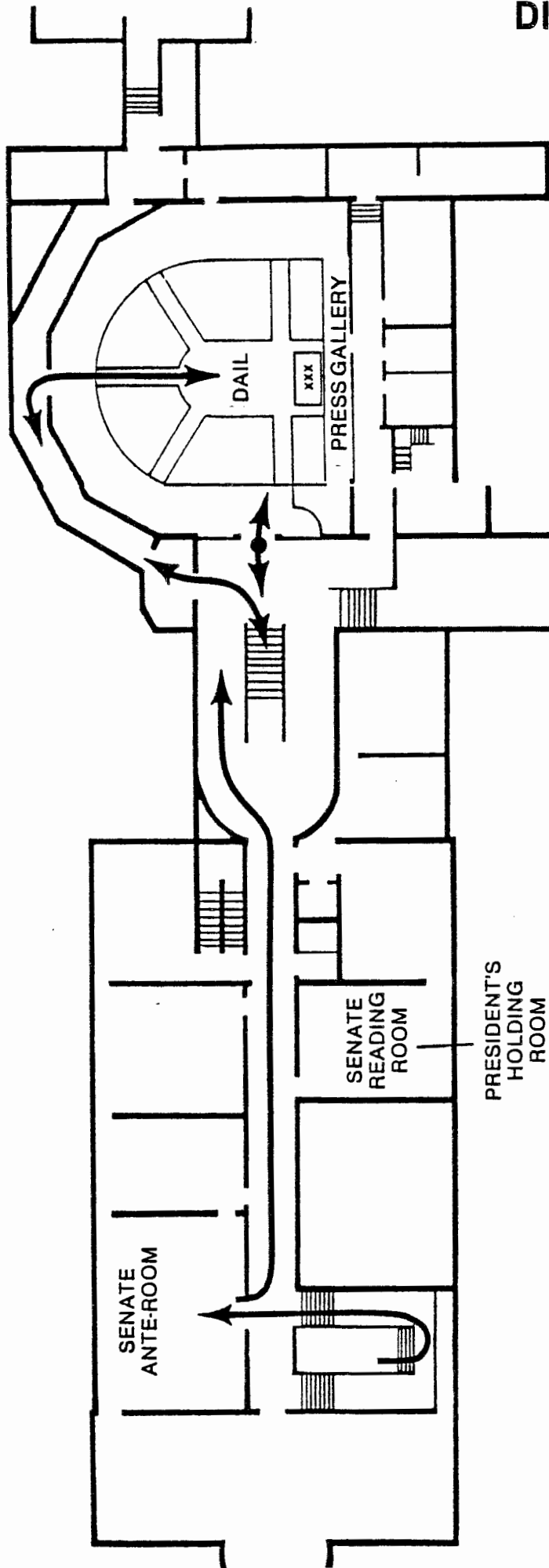


DIAGRAM 5

ADDRESS JOINT SESSION OF PARLIAMENT - THE DAIL

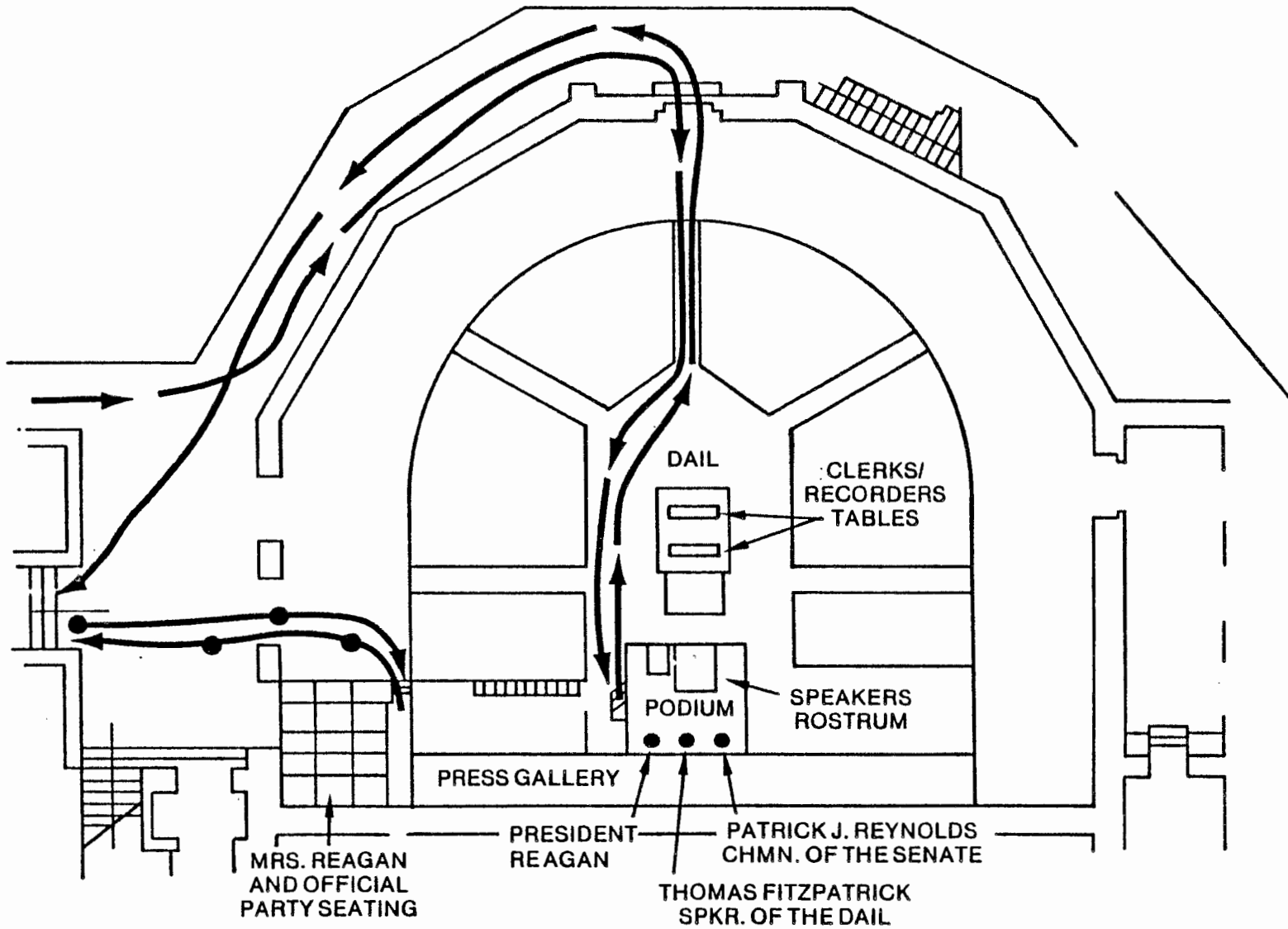

GROUND FLOOR DEPARTURE

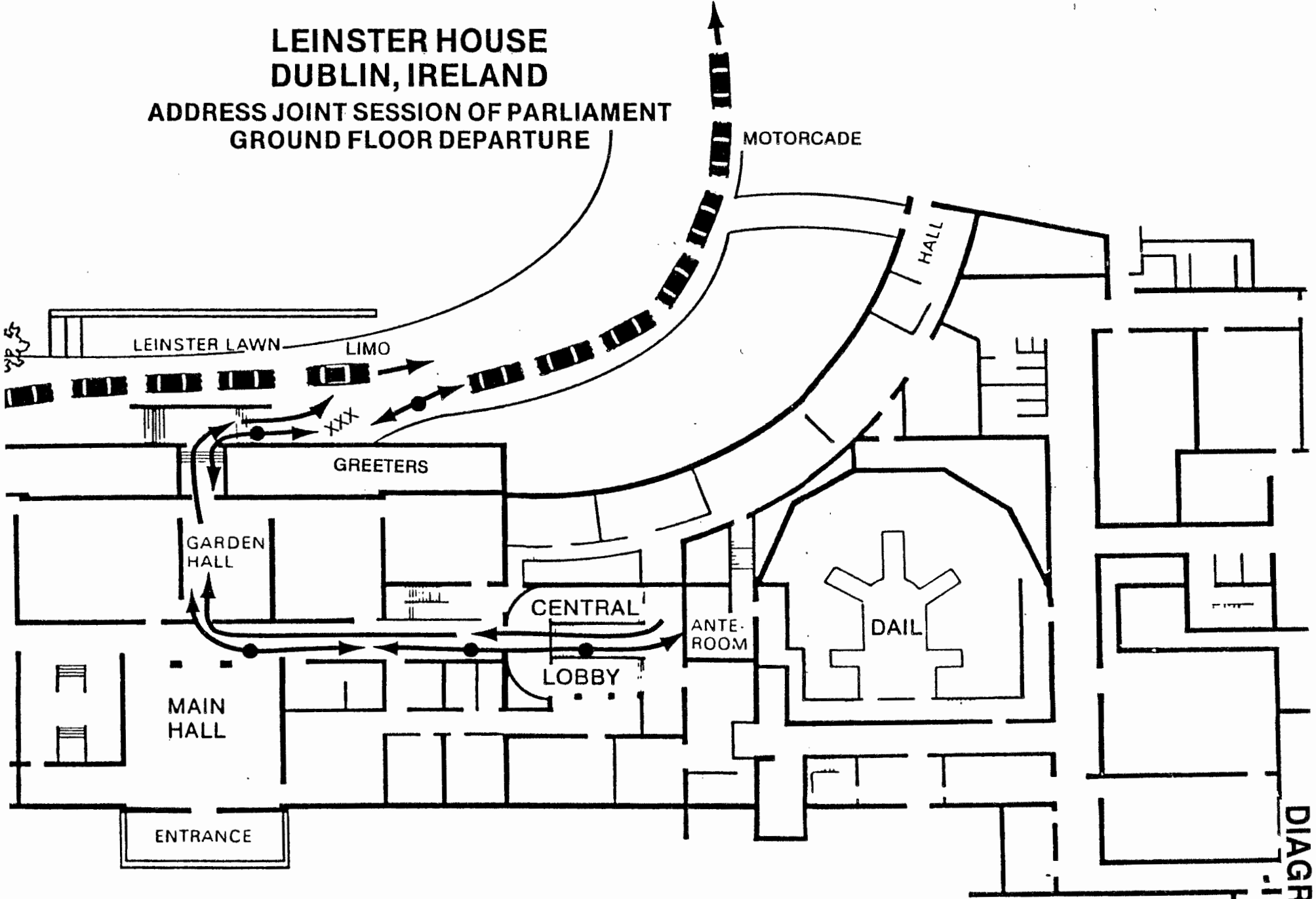
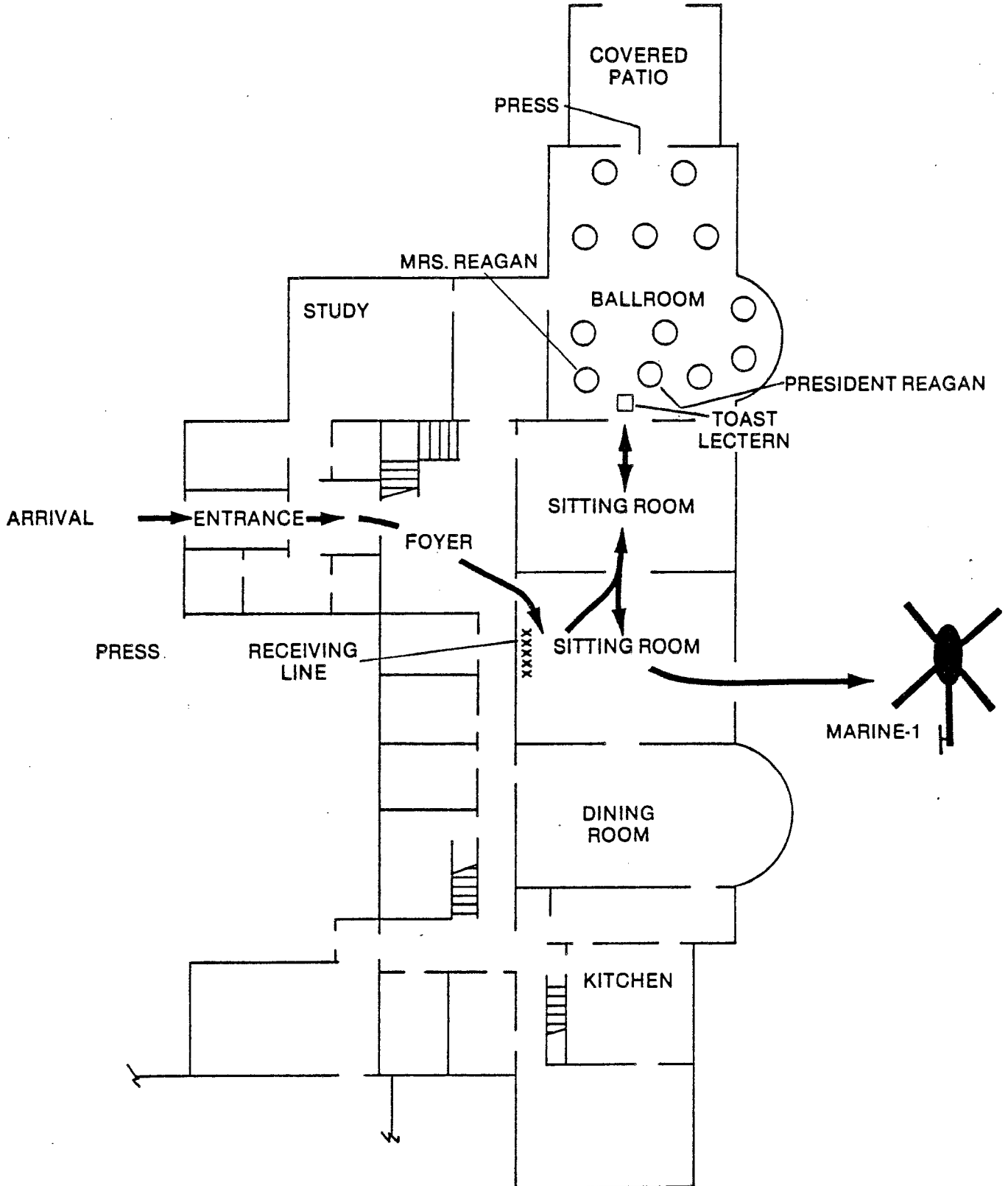
