Considerations

- --Hostages The three U.S. hostages are being held by Hizbollah, probably somewhere in the Bekaa. Although we have no evidence, they may be at the same camp as the mock-up.
- --Murphy Mission Dick will be in the area at least through the end of the week. He is tentatively planning to be back in Damascus the 27th and 28th.
- --Syrian Connections The Syrian Army has surrounded the Hizbollah training camp with tanks and men. Any actions against the camp could affect the Syrian contingents as well.
- --U.S. Posts in the Area Our posts would have immediately to go on heightened alert. Although this is especially true in Beirut, such steps would have to be taken throughout the Arab world and elsewhere.
- --Other Governments We should keep in mind the interests of our allies and also some states in the area. This would mean perhaps talking to a few in advance of any actions, while informing the others immediately as action is taking place. What we say to some select Western Europeans as well as the Israelis, Syrians and Lebanese in this regard will be important. A related issue is what, if anything, and when we say something to the Sovs.
- --The Hill There is also the question of whether anyone on the Hill is informed in advance, as well as preparing a comprehensive plan for phone calls and briefing points.
- -- The Media We would also need a solid package of talking points and Qs and As to use with the media.




