PROPOSED PRESS STATEMENT

The President asked Philip C. Habib, former Under Secretary of State, to travel to the Middle East as his emissary to consult with and seek the views of the leaders of Lebanon, Syria, and Israel. Ambassador Habib will be exploring ways to reduce tensions produced by recent developments surrounding the situation in Lebanon. The leaders of these three countries have agreed to receive Ambassador Habib.

- Q. When is Ambassador Habib leaving?
- A. The Secretary wants to consult with Ambassador Habib before he leaves Washington. We will let you know his departure plans later.

- Q. Will Habib be carrying a U.S. plan?
- A. He is going to the Middle East to explore ways to de-fuse the situation. He will want to hear what the leaders say before advancing ideas.
- Q. Will Habib be available to the press before departing?
- A. No.
