The President believes that this is an appropriate moment to receive first hand Ambassador Habib's views and to discuss with him the future of his continuing mission in the context of efforts peacefully to resolve the crisis involving events in Lebanon.

- A. He will be arriving in Washington on Thursday. His schedule at this time is flexible and I cannot tell you exactly when he will return to the Middle East.
- Q. How would you characterize the progress of his mission?
