THE TEN HAVE ALWAYS HELD THAT THEY FULLY RESPECT THE INDEPENDENCE OF IRAN AND THE RIGHT OF THE IRANIAN PEOPLE TO SELPHDETERMINATION OF THEIR OWN FUTURE. NOW THAT THE WAY IS OPEN FOR IMPROVED RELATIONS, THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS MINISTERS OF THE TEN EXPRESS THEIR HOPE THAT RELATIONS BASED ON RESPECT OF INDEPENDENCE AND MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITH IRAN.

IN THIS CONNECTION THE TEN LOOK TO THE GOVERNMENT OF IBAN TO ACCELERATE THE RELEASE OF THE FOUR BRITISH CITIZENS HELD CAPTIVE IN IRAN, AGAINST WHOM IT IS NOTED THAT NO CHARGES HAVE BEEN MADE.
