#### US-BRAZIL SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY COOPERATION

Support for Brazilian scientific and technological cooperation has long been an instrument of US foreign policy. During the 1960's and early 1970's, joint activities administered by our technical agencies and US assistance programs (AID and military) contributed significantly to Brazil's scientific infrastructure, and trained the majority of the current generation of Brazilian scientists and engineers. However, the historically close relationship with the US scientific community has weakened during the past decade, and Brazil turned increasingly to Europe and Japan for partners in joint R&D ventures and the advanced training of Brazil's next generation of scientists and engineers.

The unique opportunities that Brazil's natural endowments -- climate, ecosystems, natural resources -- offer for US researchers have long been recognized. Today, Brazil's current excellence in many fields of scientific endeavor -- e.g, mathematics, geology, physics, telecommunications, synthetic fuels and agriculture -makes it feasible to design a cooperative program in which the public and private sectors of both countries could gain scientifically and technically. In recognition of these scientific opportunities and the foreign policy benefits of enhanced collaboration, the United States and Brazil signed an intergovernmental agreement for scientific and technical cooperation in February 1984. This agreement was just ratified by the Brazilian Senate and thus, has not yet been implemented.

DESCRIPTION OF INITIATIVE: President Sarney's visit and President Reagan's desire to express his commitment to Brazil's new democracy make this a fitting time for the two leaders to announce a Presidential initiative in science and technology. This would underscore President Reagan's support of President Sarney's emphasis on science and technology as a key element in stimulating economic growth. It would highlight an area of common interest and need, and defuse the perceptions of rivalry and mistrust that color other bilateral issues, i.e., informatics and nuclear proliferation. A joint partnership-investment approach to scientific and technological cooperation would demonstrate the US's desire to establish a new, mature relationship with Brazil as we face the challenges of the 21st century.

The statement would highlight Brazil's world-class stature in science and technology and underscore the mutual benefits to be derived from enhancing our science and technology partnership.

The two Presidents would direct their respective Science Advisors to establish together a blue ribbon panel of eminent US and Brazilian scientists, engineers, and R&D policymakers to determine priority areas for cooperation and design a management framework to facilitate collaborative ventures and private sector participation. The panel would identify potential areas for cooperation that complement the R&D priorities of each country, draw upon the comparative advantages of each partner, and promise tangible pay-offs to leverage economic growth. The target date for initiating activities in the program would be six months to one year from the date of the announcement. All research projects would be jointly supported and draw upon each country's domestic R&D resources.



#### US-BRAZIL SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY COOPERATION

Support for Brazilian scientific and technological cooperation has long been an instrument of US foreign policy. During the 1960's and early 1970's, joint activities administered by our technical agencies and US assistance programs (AID and military) contributed significantly to Brazil's scientific infrastructure, and trained the majority of the current generation of Brazilian scientists and engineers. However, the historically close relationship with the US scientific community has weakened during the past decade, and Brazil turned increasingly to Europe and Japan for partners in joint R&D ventures and the advanced training of Brazil's next generation of scientists and engineers.

The unique opportunities that Brazil's natural endowments -- climate, ecosystems, natural resources -- offer for US researchers have long been recognized. Today, Brazil's current excellence in many fields of scientific endeavor -- e.g, mathematics, geology, physics, telecommunications, synthetic fuels and agriculture -makes it feasible to design a cooperative program in which the public and private sectors of both countries could gain scientifically and technically. In recognition of these scientific opportunities and the foreign policy benefits of enhanced collaboration, the United States and Brazil signed an intergovernmental agreement for scientific and technical cooperation in February 1984. This agreement was just ratified by the Brazilian Senate and thus, has not yet been implemented.

DESCRIPTION OF INITIATIVE: President Sarney's visit and President Reagan's desire to express his commitment to Brazil's new democracy make this a fitting time for the two leaders to announce a Presidential initiative in science and technology. This would underscore President Reagan's support of President Sarney's emphasis on science and technology as a key element in stimulating economic growth. It would highlight an area of common interest and need, and defuse the perceptions of rivalry and mistrust that color other bilateral issues, i.e., informatics and nuclear proliferation. A joint partnership-investment approach to scientific and technological cooperation would demonstrate the US's desire to establish a new, mature relationship with Brazil as we face the challenges of the 21st century.

The statement would highlight Brazil's world-class stature in science and technology and underscore the mutual benefits to be derived from enhancing our science and technology partnership.

The two Presidents would direct their respective Science Advisors to establish together a blue ribbon panel of eminent US and Brazilian scientists, engineers, and R&D policymakers to determine priority areas for cooperation and design a management framework to facilitate collaborative ventures and private sector participation. The panel would identify potential areas for cooperation that complement the R&D priorities of each country, draw upon the comparative advantages of each partner, and promise tangible pay-offs to leverage economic growth. The target date for initiating activities in the program would be six months to one year from the date of the announcement. All research projects would be jointly supported and draw upon each country's domestic R&D resources.
