

The panel would identify potential areas for cooperation that complement the R&D priorities of each country, draw upon the comparative advantages of each partner, and promise tangible pay-offs to leverage economic growth. The target date for initiating activities in the program would be six months to one year from the date of the announcement. All research projects would be jointly supported and draw upon each country's domestic R&D resources.


