SUBJECT: PRC and Taiwan Reactions to the Arms Sales Package

I think that there is more positive than negative in both the Taiwan and PRC reactions to our proposals.

-The PRC has dropped its demand for our making a reference to an eventual end to arms sales to Taiwan.

-Lilley says that Taiwan is prepared to accept what we have offered the PRC, although the prospect of a joint communique scares them

The Vice President called me for my reaction, which is as stated above. He also feels quite positive about the PRC response.

State is at work over the week-end, and will have some options for us to look at on Monday.

In sum I would say that we are not out of the woods yet, but the underbrush is thinning out.
