1. ENTIRE TEXT.

AMBASSADOR EARLY MORNING 15 JUNE TELEPHONED AMAL POLITICAL BUREAU HEAD AKIF HAIDAR. WAYING HIM UP.

- AMBASSADOR INFORMED HAIDAR THAT HIJACKED TWA PLANE HAD RETURNED, THAT THE HIJACKERS HAD ALREADY KILLED ONE AMERICAN, AND THAT AMAL REPRESENTATIVES WERE AT THAT MOMENT TALKING WITH HIJACKERS. AMBASSADOR EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN THAT THE HIJACKERS WOULD START KILLING AMERICANS AGAIN. HE STRESSED THAT IF THIS WERE TO HAPPEN, THAT THERE WOULD BE TREMENDOUS PRESSURE ON THE USG AND ON EVERYONE ELSE. HE SAID HE HOPED THAT AMAL WAS PREPARED AND WILLING TO TAKE STEPS TO STOP ANY FURTHER KILLINGS.
- 4. HAIDAR REPLIED THAT AMBASSADOR'S PHONE CALL WAS FIRST INDICATION HE HAD RECEIVED THAT PLANE HAD RETURNED TO BEIRUT. HE SAID THAT HE HOPED WE REALIZED THAT THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR HIJACKING WERE NOT FROM AMAL; "THEY ARE EXTREMISTS." STRESSED THAT AMAL DID NOT WANT TO BE INVOLVED WITH THIS HIJACKING, AND AMAL MEETING PREVIOUS DAY HAD UNANIMOUSLY DECIDED NOT TO HAVE ANY RELATIONS WITH THE HIJACKERS.
- 5. AMBASSADOR SAID THAT THE HIJACKERS HAD ALREADY KILLED ONE AMERICAN, HAD INSISTED THAT AMAL REPRESENTATIVE COME AND DEAL WITH THEM, AND THAT TWO AMAL REPRESENTATIVES WERE AT AIR-PLANE AT THAT MOMENT, TALKING WITH THEM. ΗE SAID WE WERE NOT SAYING THAT THE HIJACKERS WERE AMAL. 





SUBJECT: TWA HIJACKING -- ITALIAN CONTINGENCY

1. (C) ON THE BASIS OF ORAL INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE TWA HIJACKING WORKING GROUP, POLITICAL COUNSELOR THIS MORNING JUNE 15 MADE A DEMARCHE AS FOLLOWS TO MINISTER QUARONI, DIRECTOR OF MFA SECRETARIAT (MOST RECENTLY AMBASSADOR TO LIBYA):

--REQUEST THAT THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT ALLOW THE AIRCRAFT TO LAND IN ITALY SHOULD IT SO REQUEST.

--THAT APPROPRIATE MEASURES BE TAKEN TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE PASSENGERS AND CREW.

--THAT MEASURES BE TAKEN TO APPREHEND THE HIJACKERS. AND HOLD THEM FOR PROSECUTION OR EXTRADITION.

--FINALLY, THAT THE AIRCRAFT NOT BE ALLOWED TO TAKE OFF.

- 2. (C) QUARONI NOTED THAT DEPENDING ON CIRCUMSTANCES THESE GOALS COULD BE MUTUALLY CONTRADICTORY, BUT HIS GOVERNMENT WOULD DO ITS DUTY. IN THE LAST ANALYSIS, THE OFFICIAL ON THE GROUND WHO IS IN CHARGE MUST MAKE DECISIONS ON THE BASIS OF HIS JUDGMENT.
- 3. (C) ASKED WHETHER THE ROME AND PALERMO AIRPORTS WERE STILL CLOSED TO THE HIJACKED AIRCRAFT, QUARONI SAID THAT THAT HAD BEEN THE DECISION OF THE INTERIOR MINISTER JUNE 14 AND IT STILL STOOD. PALERMO WAS CLOSED TO THE AIRCRAFT BECAUSE OF THE PRESENCE ON THE ISLAND OF SACEUR COMMANDER GENERAL ROGERS, AND ROME BECAUSE OF THE INTENSE NATURE OF THE AIR TRAFFIC.
- 4. (C) POLITICAL COUNSELOR SAID THAT UNDER PRESENT CIRCUMSTANCES THE HIJACKED AIRCRAFT SHOULD HAVE PREFERENCE OVER OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES AT PALERMO, AND THAT SURELY THE AIRCRAFT COULD BE PUT OFF IN A CORNER OF ROME'S IMMENSE FIUMICINO AIRPORT. QUARONI SAID ON THE LATTER PONT THAT THE CIAMPINO MILITARY AIRPORT OUTSIDE ROME SHOULD BE ALL RIGHT, AND HE WOULD ASK THE INTERIOR MINISTRY TO REMOVE THE BAN ON CIAMPINO AND ON PALERMO, BASED ON THE U.S. PRIORITY.
