



President Salih of Yemen has indicated that he will be unable to accept the President's invitation to come to Washington on April 23 for an official working visit. Meanwhile, King Hussein has informed us that his schedule will not permit a March 18 visit.

The NSC staff strongly recommends that UAE President Sheikh Zayed, whose official working visit had originally been approved for late February, be invited to fill the March 18 slot vacated by Hussein. We recommend in turn that Hussein be invited for an April 23 OWV.
