THE FOLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF A BACKGROUNDER GIVEN BY SECRETARY HAIG TO U.S. NEWSMEN IMMEDIATELY AFTER HIS APPEARANCE ON THE OCTOBER 11 "MEET THE PRESS" PROGRAM. THE BACKGROUNDER BEGAN AT 5:07 P.M. CAIRD TIME.

(BEGIN TEXT) ALL RIGHT, AS PROMISED, I THOUGHT I WOULD MAKE MYSELF AVAILABLE TO YOU BEFORE WE GET ON THE PLANE, AND WE ARE ON DUR WAY THERE RIGHT AFTER THIS, AS YOU KNOW, THE PURPOSE OF OUR VISIT WAS FIRST AND FOREMOST TO PAY THE RESPECTS OF PRESIDENT REAGAN, THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ON THE OCCASION OF THE FUNERAL OF PRESIDENT SADAT, BUT ALSO TO USE THIS OCCASION; AND THE HIGH-LEVEL AMERICAN DELEGATION WHICH INVOLVED THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, OUR UNITED NATIONS AMBASSADOR JEANNE KIRKPATPICK, THREE FORMER PRESIDENTS AND BIPARTISAN LEADERSHIP OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE, WERE ALL DESIGNED --AND HENRY KISSINGER, AS WELL, I DON'T WANT TO FORGET HIM--WERE ALL DESIGNED NOT ONLY TO DEMONSTRATE THE HEARTFELT LOSS OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE BUT ALSO THE

HIGH LEVEL OF VALUE WE PUT ON THE AMERICAN-FGYPTIAN RELATIONSHIP. AND IT ALSO UNDERLINED TWO FACTORS IN THAT RELATIONSHIP THAT WILL HAVE TO HAVE IN THE POST-SADAT PERIOD SOMEWHAT INTENSIFIED ATTENTION. THE FIRST IS THE PEACE PROCESS ITSELF. AND THE TALKS WE HAD HERE AND THE TALK I HAD LAST NIGHT WITH PRIME MINISTER BEGIN AFFIRMED THE UNEOUIVOCAL DEDICATION OF THE PARTIES TO THE CAMP DAVID ACCORDS AND THE CONTINUATION OF THE PROCESS AS IT PERTAINS TO THE AUTONOMY TALKS, THE TALKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NORMALIZATION OF RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN EGYPT AND ISRAEL, AND THE SINAI WITHDRAWAL PROCESS. PRIME MINISTER BEGIN WAS ESPECIALLY FERVENT IN REASSERTING HIS COMMITMENT TO THE TURNOVER OF THE SINAI ON SCHEDULE DURING APRIL OF 1982. BUTH SIDES WERE SPECIFIC ABOUT THEIR INTENTION TO SEEK A SUCCESSFUL DUTCOME TO THE AUTONOMY TALKS. AND THE ORIGINAL APPROACH OF THE MEETINGS THAT HAVE TAKEN PLACE ALREADY IN THIS REGARD OFFER GREATER PROMISE THAN WE HAVE SEEN HERETOFORE, THAT THEY WILL BE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED. THERE ARE STILL MANY DIFFICULT QUESTIONS TO BE SOLVED. BUT ONE CANNOT TAKE EXCEPTION WITH THE ATTITUDE OF THE PARTIES. NOW WE'RE GOING TO PARTICIPATE IN THOSE TALKS. WE HAVE BEEN DOING IT AT THE AMBASSADORIAL LEVEL; AND AT WHATEVER MOMENT IT APPEARS THAT IT WOULD CONTRIBUTE TO PROGRESS TO EVEN ESCALATE THE LEVEL OF OUR PARTICIPATION WE WILL DO SO.

NOW, THE OTHER ASPECT OF OUR INTENSIFICATION INVOLVES THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE REGION, NOT ONLY WITH RESPECT TO OUR ONGDING ASSISTANCE--ECONOMIC AND MILITARY-- TO EGYPT, BUT ALSO TO THE OTHER THREATENED REGIMES IN THE AREA WHO SHARE OUR VALUES, OR AT LEAST WHO WISH TO MAINTAIN THEIR INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY FREE FROM EXTERNAL MANIPULATION.

THERE, WE HAD TALKS WITH THE PRESIDENT OF THE SUDAN, NIMEIRY; THE PRESIDENT OF SOMALIA, SIAD BARRE; I HAD A DISCUSSION WITH THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER OF OMAN, PRINCE FAHD; AND I ALSO HAD AN INTERESTING BUT SOMEWHAT BRIEFER DISCUSSION WITH THE HEAD OF STATE OF LIBERIA, MR. DOE, WHO IS ALSO THREATENED BY MISCHIEF-MAKING FROM LIBYA. NOW, WE HAVE TWO TEAMS IN THE AREA, A MILITARY TEAM HERE IN EGYPT WHICH IS STARTING DISCUSSIONS TODAY WHICH WILL CONTINUE TOMORROW ON STEPS THAT WE (AN TAKE BOTH IN TERMS OF THE EXERCISE I REFERRED TO IN THE MEET THE PRESS SESSION WHICH WILL TAKE PLACE IN NOVEMBER--WHAT'S THE NAME OF IT? SHINING STAR? BRIGHT STAR? AND, POTENTIAL EARLIER DELIVERY OF CERTAIN MILITARY EQUIPMENT IN OUR
