My earlier memo may not have made clear that Ambassador Kampelman, who has agreed to follow up on earlier Presidential missions undertaken by Walt Stoessel, will have to make five capitals in five days which will be virtually impossible using commercial carriers. Consequently it is requested that EUCOM air support be approved for the period September 9 - 14 and later for a flight from Frankfurt to London on September 20. He will use commercial aircraft at all other times during his mission.
